

**ORDER**

**SECTION 35, THE MINING ACT, R.S.O. 1990**

**ORDER NO. W-K-115/09**

The SURFACE and MINING RIGHTS of the area outlined in red on the attached sketch, situated in Dibble Lake Area (G-0522), in the Kenora Mining Division, containing 176 hectares more or less, are hereby WITHDRAWN from prospecting, staking out, sale or lease.

This area is WITHDRAWN while the Ministry of Natural Resources prepares the area for a prescribed burn.

Saving, excepting and reserving hereto and herefrom, all other lands patented, sold, leased or otherwise alienated by the Crown at the date of this Order.

Any alienated lands lying within the limits of this withdrawn area that revert to the Crown subsequent to the date of this Order will automatically be considered to be withdrawn as part of this Order.

This order comes into effect upon signing.


