SECTION 35, THE MINING ACT, R.S.O. 1990

ORDER NO. W-LL-F1519 A

The MINING RIGHTS of the areas outlined in red on the attached sketch, situated in the Camp Lake (G-3764) and David Lake (G-3765) Areas, Sault Ste. Marie Mining Division, containing 229.46 hectares more or less, are hereby WITHDRAWN from prospecting, staking out, sale or lease.

This area is WITHDRAWN in preparation to be regulated as provincial parks or conservation reserves as approved in the Ontario's Living Legacy Land Use Strategy.

Saving, excepting and reserving hereto and herefrom, all other lands patented, sold, leased or otherwise alienated by the Crown at the date of this Order.

Any alienated lands lying within the limits of these withdrawn areas that revert to the Crown subsequent to the date of this Order will automatically be considered to be withdrawn as part of this Order.
