

ORDER

SECTION 35, THE MINING ACT, R.S.O. 1990

ORDER NO. W-S-61/02

The SURFACE AND MINING RIGHTS of the lands identified as Park on Ontario Lands on the attached sketch, located in the townships of Canton (G-3414), Leroche (G-3437), Cynthia (G-3421), Belfast (G-3408), Joan (G-3433), Clement (G-3072), Vogt (G-3460) and Hobbs (G-2914), containing 5848.8 hectares more or less, are hereby WITHDRAWN from prospecting, staking out, sale or lease in accordance with the terms of this order.

To complete the agreement reached to settle the Temagami land claim, the lands are being withdrawn to prevent adverse alienation while the Province of Ontario considers the creation of a waterway park or other appropriate legal designation.

Saving, excepting and reserving hereto and herefrom, all other lands patented, sold, leased or otherwise alienated by the Crown at the date of this Order.

Any alienated lands lying within the limits of this withdrawn area that revert to the Crown subsequent to the date of this order will automatically be considered to be withdrawn as part of this order.

This order comes into effect upon signing.

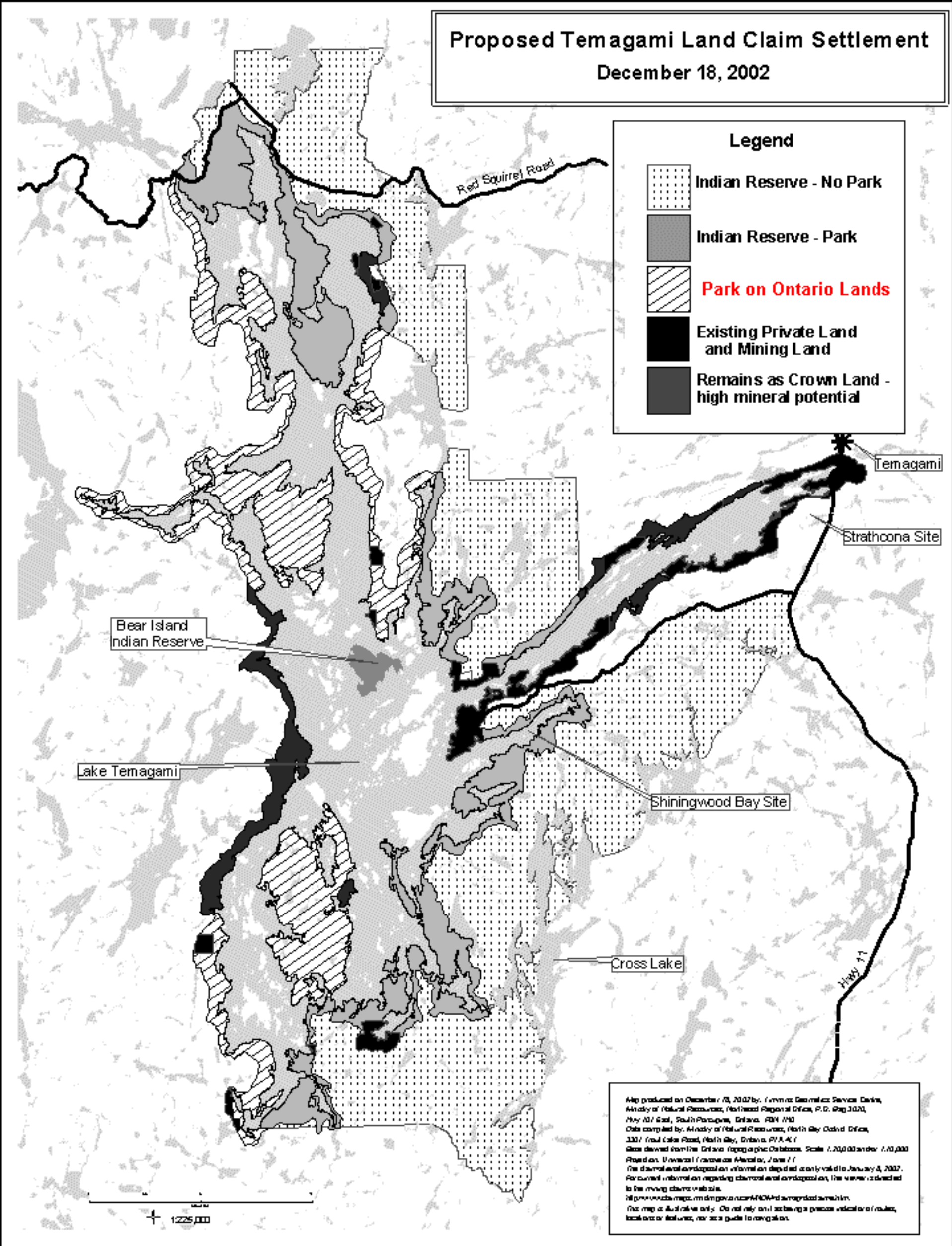
