

ORDER

SECTION 35, THE MINING ACT, R.S.O. 1990

ORDER NO. W-SO-65-03

The SURFACE and MINING RIGHTS of the area outlined in red on the attached sketch in the Summit Lake ANSI, in North and South Canonto Township (M-0068) Southern Ontario Mining Division, containing 829.57 hectares, more or less, are hereby WITHDRAWN from prospecting and staking out, sale or lease.

This land is withdrawn as it has been identified as a provincially significant Area of Natural and Scientific Interest (ANSI) by the Ministry of Natural Resources, through the Madawaska Highlands Land-Use Planning Process.

Saving, excepting and reserving hereto and herefrom, all other lands patented, sold, leased or otherwise alienated by the Crown at the date of this Order.

Any alienated lands lying within the limits of this withdrawn area that revert to the Crown subsequent to the date of this order will automatically be considered to be withdrawn as part of this order.

This order comes into effect upon signing.


