

ORDER

SECTION 35, THE MINING ACT, R.S.O. 1990

ORDER NO. W-SSM-16-04

The SURFACE and MINING RIGHTS of the area outlined in red on the attached sketch, situated in Wlasy Township, in the Sault Ste. Marie Mining Division, containing 4.2 hectares, more or less, are hereby WITHDRAWN from prospecting and staking out, sale or lease.

The area is withdrawn so that the Ministry of Natural Resources (MNR) can replace land area that they are removing from within the Ranger North Conservation Reserve. The MNR is to remove a gravel pit area from within the Reserve and replace it with an equal amount of area from adjacent Crown Land.

Saving, excepting and reserving hereto and herefrom, all other lands patented, sold, leased or otherwise alienated by the Crown at the date of this Order.

Any alienated lands lying within the limits of this withdrawn area that revert to the Crown subsequent to the date of this order will automatically be considered to be withdrawn as part of this order.

This order comes into effect upon signing.
