

**ORDER****SECTION 35, THE MINING ACT, R.S.O. 1990****ORDER NO. W-TB-69/16**

The **SURFACE RIGHTS** of the area outlined in red on the attached sketch, situated in Thunder Bay and Sault Ste. Marie Mining Division, containing 83,000 hectares, more or less, are hereby **WITHDRAWN** from prospecting, staking out, sale or lease.

This area is withdrawn during the assessment of the hydro transmission line corridors under the Environmental Assessment Act and the public land disposition review and approval process by the Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry.

Provided that this withdrawal order does not affect pre-existing mining rights and tenure such as mining claims, mining leases or mining licences of occupation in the area withdrawn except that if any such pre-existing mining rights and tenure revert to the Crown subsequent to the date and time of this Order, they shall automatically be considered to be withdrawn by this Order.

This order comes into effect upon signing.

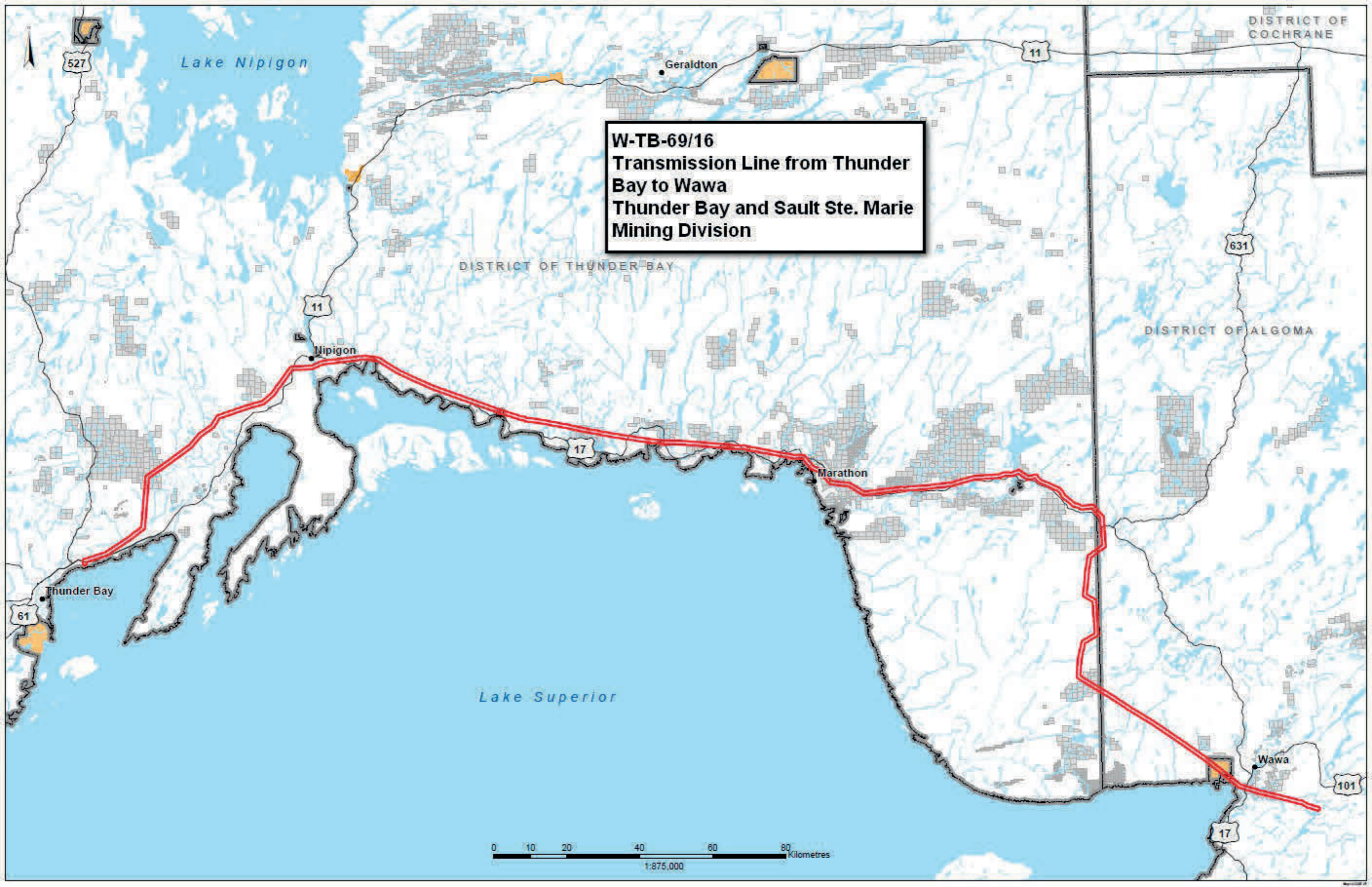
