In 2001, these two claims were staked and recorded by myself, Marc Ciccarelli of Thunder Bay, Ontario. The claims are located in the southwest corner of Macgregor Township, Thunder Bay District South.

Access to the claims is from the Copenhagen Rd., at a point just north of the Hi-way 11/17 intersection with Copenhagen Rd.

Assessment work of manual surface stripping is continuing to reveal the Agate and Quartz veins in the Upper Gunflint Formation, Anemikie Series.

The previously worked areas (shown on maps as location A, B, C) were all further stripped to expose more of the Agate and Quartz veins and determine where the thickest veins originate. Location D is a new discovery since the last work report, and is presently being surface stripped. This new location has red and yellow Quartz veins cutting through the same rocks bluish-grey cherty rocks as found in the other outcrops. Location D also has some very nice Smokey and Amethyst Quartz veins that run horizontally between the delaminated layers of bedrock.

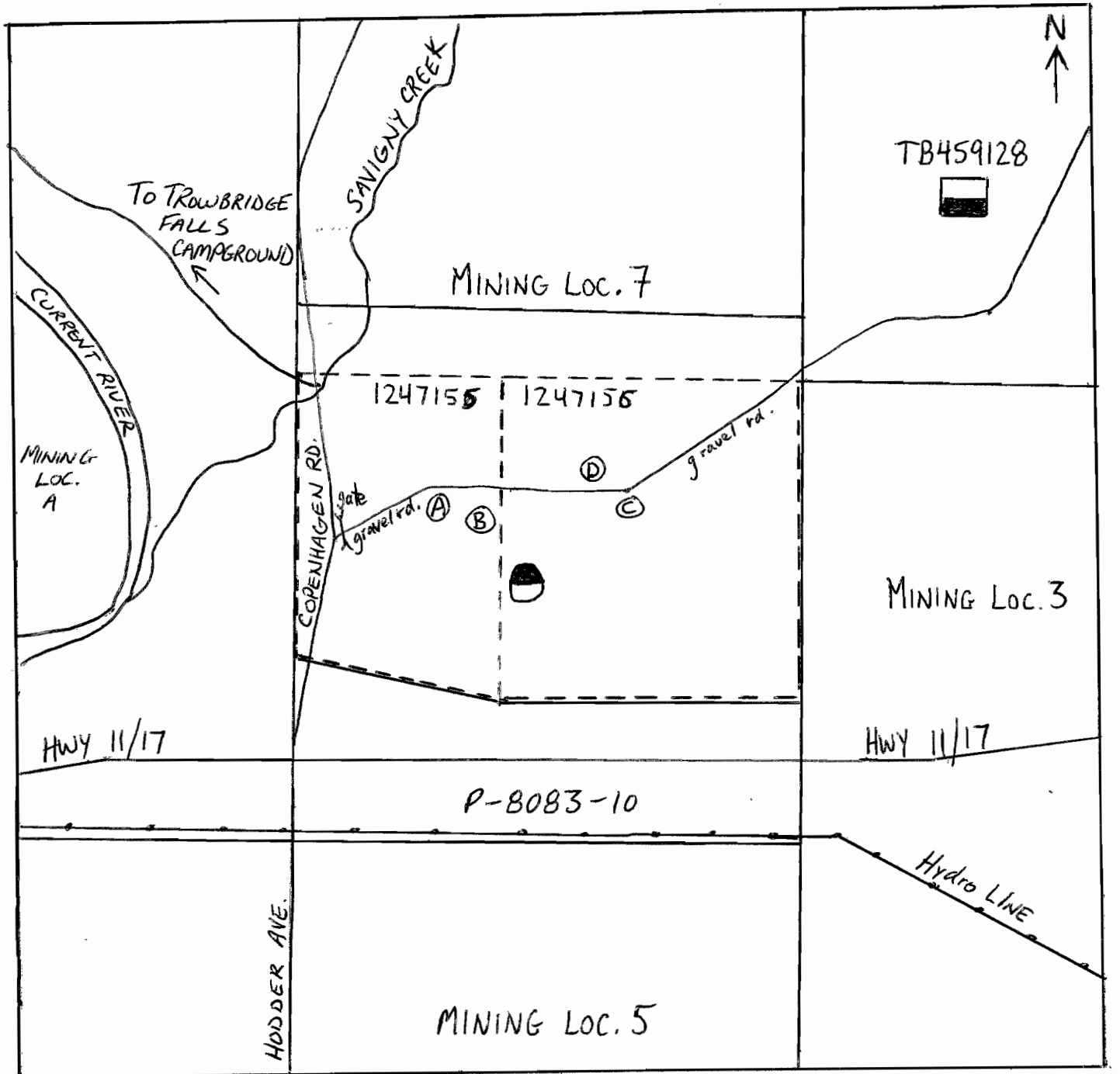
I have included photos that show some of what is found at each of the workings.

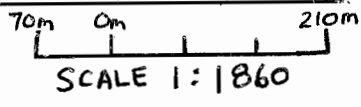

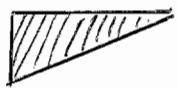
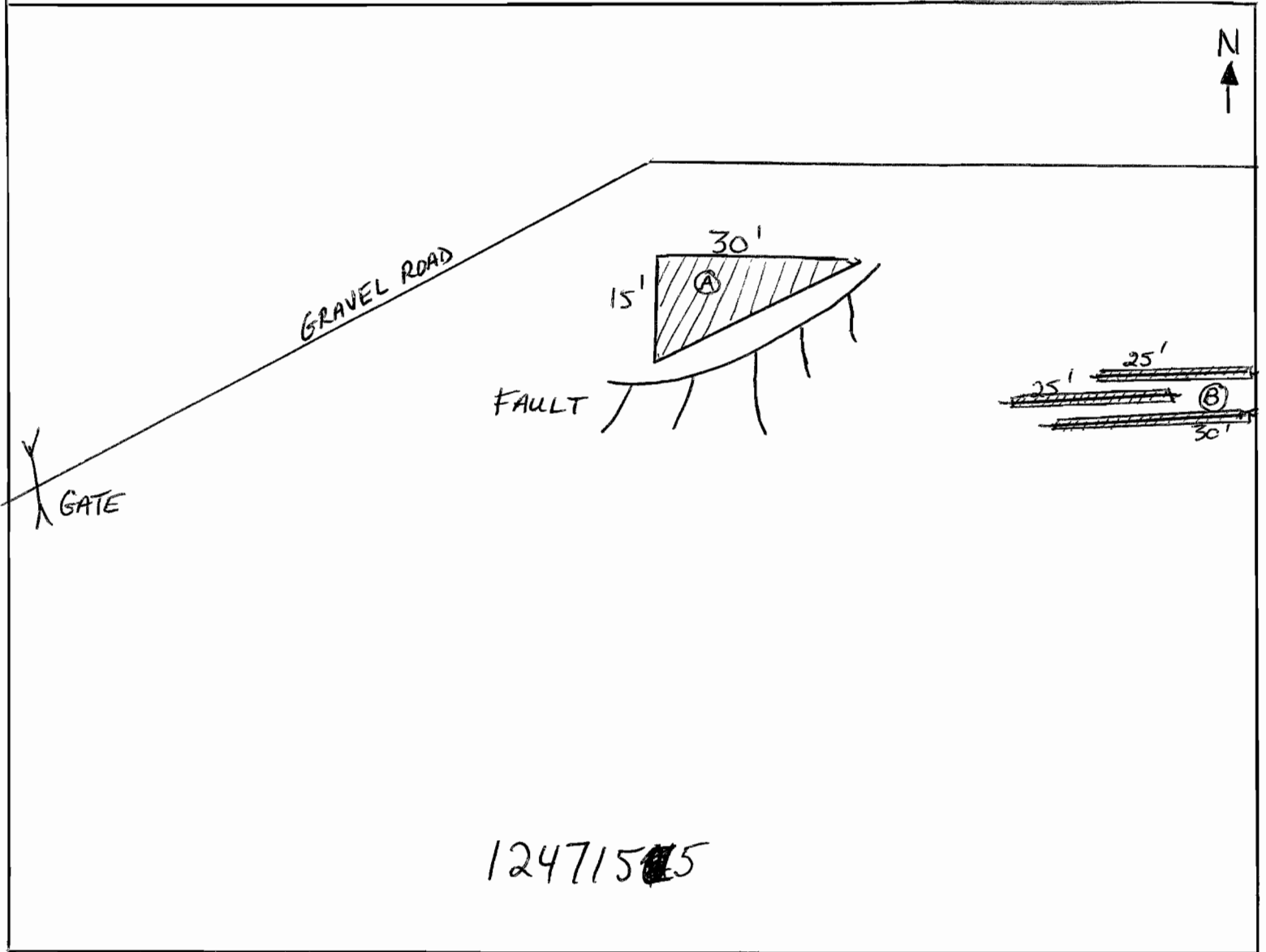
**SURFACE STRIPPING LOCATIONS**

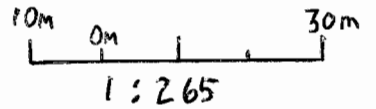
BLOW-UP OF CLAIM 124715



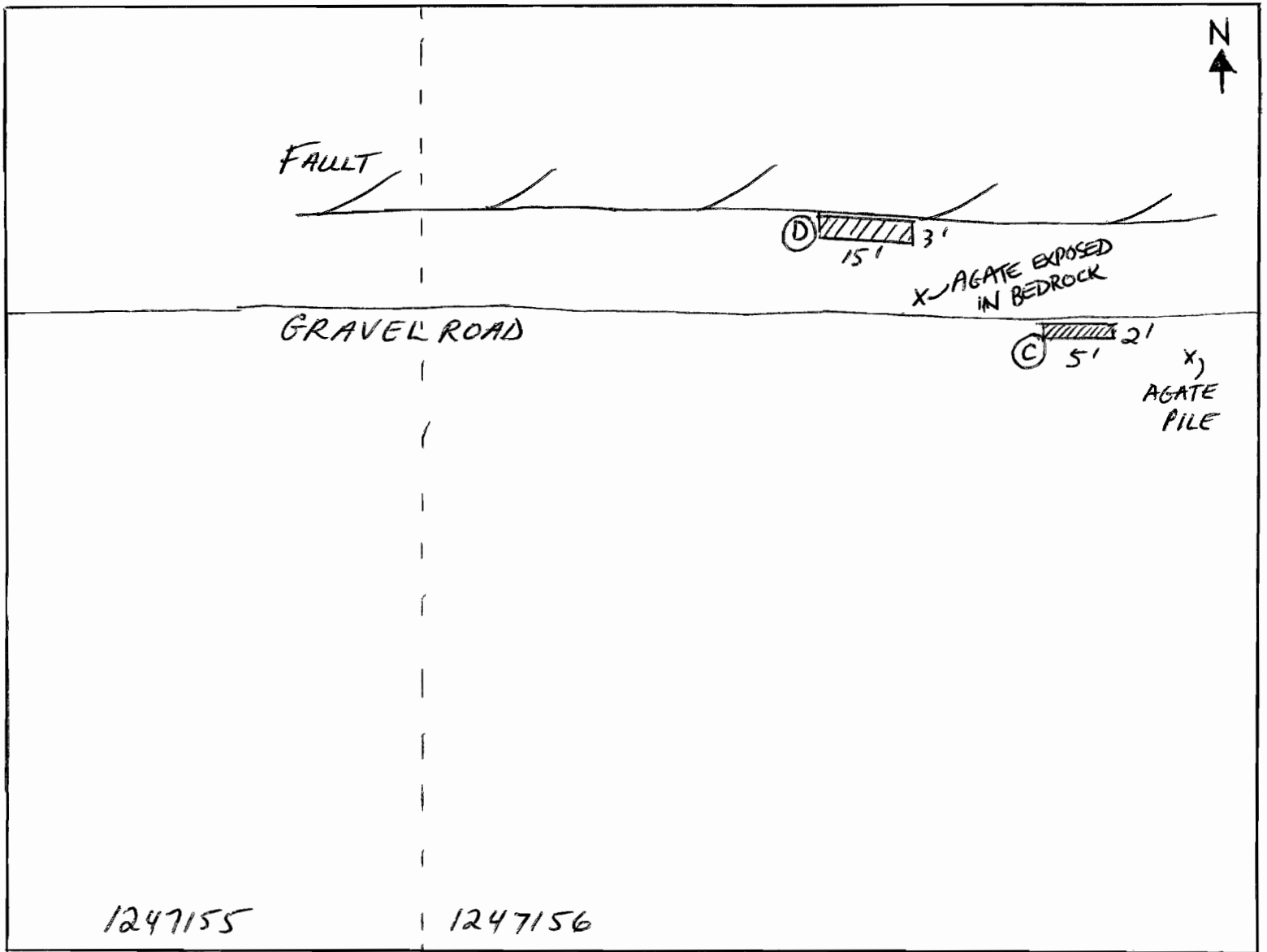
LOCATION (A) WAS STRIPPED DEEPER

AND LONGER ON QUARTZ, AMETHYST VEINS



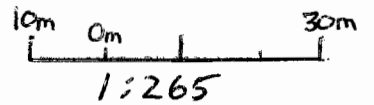


STRIPING LOCATIONS

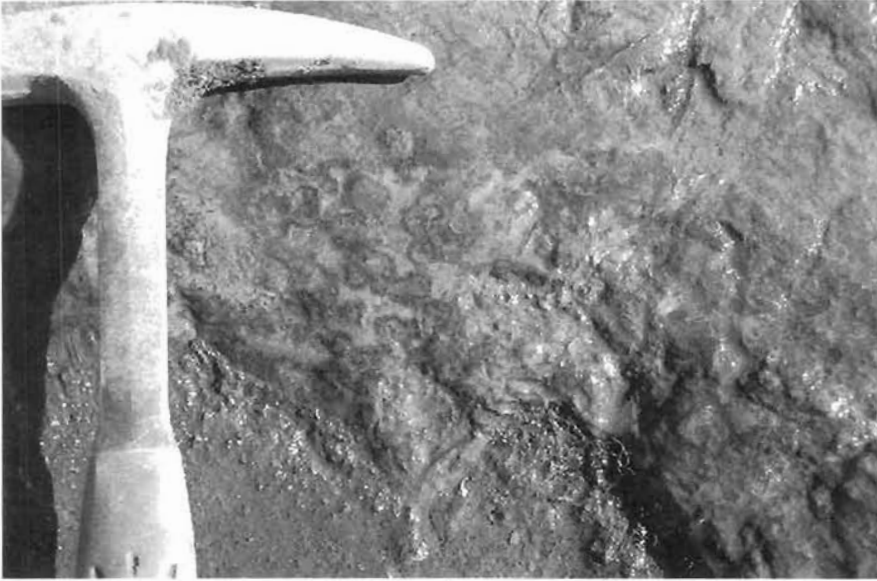
