This report covers the prospecting work carried out Sept. 5 2005, on claim 1229485 located south of Sauve Lake in Cassels Township.

A two-unit claim was staked in September of 2002 to cover a portion of the volcanics, which are an extension of the Link Lake shear zone. This is recorded in the name of Brian Youngs.

The claim is located to the north cast of the town of Temagami in the Sudbury mining division. 
These were taken to the lab in Swastika and results will be forwarded to be added to this report.
