

## Previous Work History

O.G.S. Report #62

Geology of the Elk Lake Area

This property has a work history of dating back prior to 1909 under the Cleaves claim. Then under the Beacon Consolidated between 1909 and 1914 a shaft and a large amount of drifting and cross cuts were developed. In 1963 Solomino mines worked the property with silver found to grade from 3 to 5 thousand oz. to the ton. This can be verified in the report filed at the resident Geologist office Kirkland Lake. Under the Solomino mines report.

### <u>Geology</u>

The area of Elk Lake is over lain by a sill of Nipissing Diabase that is thought to be up to 650 ft in thickness and has been intruded by aplite dikes of various widths. The Diabase in the area that is being worked is from medium to fine grained.

## **Topography**

The beacon project is on the top of a fairly high ridge that extends north ward from Willet Township in the south, on the west side of the Montreal River to the village of Elk Lake. The terrain is mainly covered with mature forest that has been harvested in some areas, the outcrops are covered with sandy loam top soil of varied thickness with swampy ground in between.

#### Work Project

In the spring prospecting was carried out on the south portion of claim 3013864 and claim 4202752.

On August 04 & 05 2005 a tracked excavator was contracted on an hourly basis for stripping in the area that has been previously worked by myself and prior to that Solomino and the Beacon Mine. The findings would indicate that the pit that had higher grade silver that was found by Solomino Mines is part of a larger system. This pit is about 10 metres north of a breccia or shear zone that was found with this latest stripping. The zone contains four veins that range from 1cm to 10 cm in width with minor chalcopyrite silver and cobalt. Silver and cobalt were the only minerals assayed, the larger of the veins trends eastward and the outcrop dips down into the swamp this vein has chalcopyrite showing on the west end but near the swamp the mineralization is completely oxidized to a depth unknown. The shear zone is approx. 5 to 6 metres in width trending east at 90 degrees and dips sharply in over the burden in the swamp area of unknown depth.

The second area stripped was done on an area just west of the Beacon shaft this was completed to try and follow the vein that the shaft was sunk on the vein was found but there was no apparent mineralization showing in the vein or the wall rock stripping was halted washing and cleaning was completed.

#### Recommendations

With the stripping and washing that was completed in 2005 on the area I feel that the next phase will be to start a diamond drill program to test the vein system with 4 short drill holes of 50 to 60 metres in length under the showing and to put one hole under the swampy area to test for a cross fault, in conjunction with this we will also move to the east side of the swamp and see if we can find if the zone extends to the east towards the old Patricia mine property. This work program will be initiated in the spring of 2006 as soon as the weather permits. This will be done with a tracked excavator and a diamond drill from Englehart
