

Claim # 4242905

On Friday September 7th 2012 Alan Onchulenko and Peter Gehrels Left Thunder Bay and Traveled 48 km East to East Loon Road to the access road of 4km to Anderson Lake. We arrived on the Claim and started work for 830 am. The goal was to identify as many of the 50 old pits as we could and mark and clear trails into the ones that were further from the road. We were able to identify most of the pits that the Bjorkmans' had mapped out in 2005. We flagged them and brushed lots of them out with the chain saw and made three short trails to access the ones that were further off the main road. I have made and attached a map of the work area. In total we worked for 9 hours before returning to Thunder Bay.

On 26/05/13 Alan Onchulenko and I (Peter Gehrels) left Thunder Bay and traveled 48 km to the East Loon Road where traveled 4 km by quad to Anderson Lake. We started work at 745 am and the goal for the day was to identify and sample two other Pegmatite MO bearing areas to the East of the Main showing . We spent 8 hours and were able to find both zones with a number of old pits on each. Included is a map of the areas we visited and sampled.
