SUMMARY

The property is located in the Factor Lake Area 40 kms. west of Atikokan and just north of highway 11.

An old logging road has the best access to the property. It heads north from highway 11 and cuts through the southwest portion of claim 4215428.

The property lies along the Quetico Fault.

The purpose of this program of mechanical stripping and sampling is to determine what caused the six channel anomalies from an airborne survey flown in the eighties.

Typical sulfides in the area are iron pyrite, chalcopyrite and arsenopyrite.

I was able to expose some quartz and quartz carbonate on three of the pits.

My next step will be to get some help in to give me guidance for what to do next.

Also do more sampling to try and get better assay results.

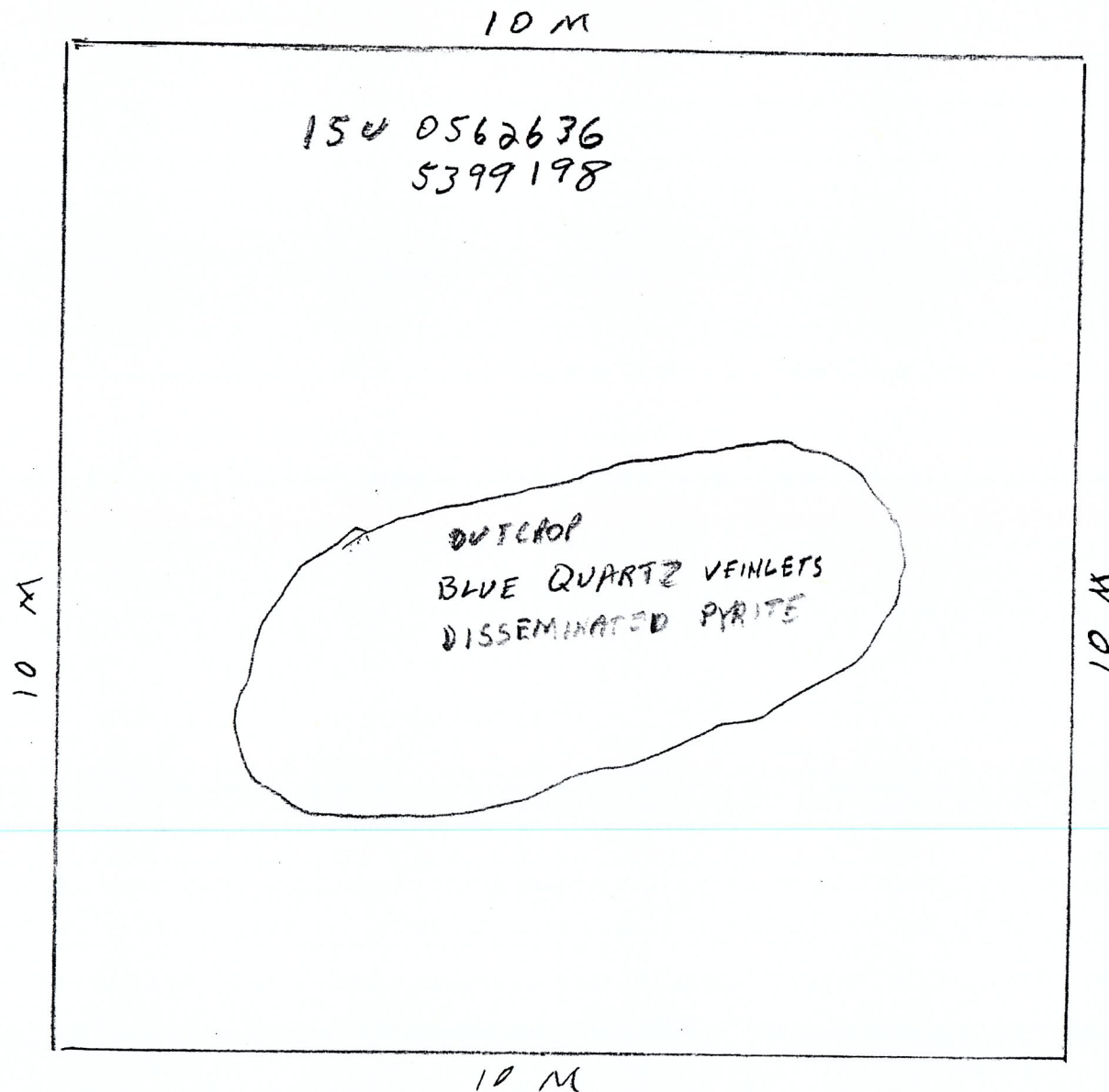
