




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LOCATION AND ACCESS

Aylmer Township is located north of Lake Wanapitei, Sudbury Mining Division. Access to the mining claims in Aylmer Township is via Highway 545 North of Capreol and onto the Portelance Road. You travel north for 18 km after the turnoff for the Wanapitei First Nation. You then leave the Portelance Road and turn south over the bridge of the Wanapitei River onto the Poupore Road. You travel south on the Poupore Road for 11 km to 13 km to the gravel pit on the edge of the east branch of the Wanapitei River. You turn south towards lake Wanapitei on the North River Park Road for 2 km to the middle of the claim.





Job: Aylmer

Date: October 3, 2015

Picked up Jim and Tom in Capreol. Travelled up to map and prospect on claim 4219156 in the area of the falls on the east bench. Gervais is cutting the western side of the road north of the chutes. The bedrock in this area appears to be flat lying mudstone with the main joints close to N/S. Gervais has a backhoe digging in the gravel pit on 4216908. The bedding in the gravel is interesting so we will pan the various levels at a later date.
