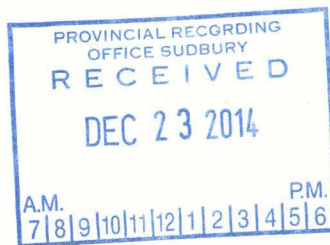


ACCESS TO CLAIM #1197239 AND 1197258

KM 0KM NORTHBAY JUNCTION OF HIGHWAYS 17 AND 63 . PROCEED ONTO HIGHWAY 63 NORTH  
KM 29.2 KM. YOU WILL SEE THE FISH HATCHERY ROAD ON YOUR RIGHT. CONTINUE UP HYW 63  
KM 30.4 KM YOU WILL SEE FOREST ACCESS ROAD ON THE RIGHT. CONTINUE ON HYY 63  
KM 31.5 KM TURN RIGHT ON ROAD TO TWENTY MINUTE LAKE AND INDIAN LAKE.  
AS YOU DRIVE DOWN ROAD YOU WILL SEE A LARGE GRAVEL PIT ON YOUR LEFT. KEEP DRIVING  
A SHORT DISTANCE THERE IS A ROAD ON YOUR LEFT. A SHORT DISTANCE THERE IS A VERY SHORT ROAD  
GO PAST IT AND TAKE THE NEXT ROAD ON YOUR LEFT. DRIVE DOWN THAT ROAD KEEPING TO THE  
RIGHT YOU WILL REACH A LARGE CLEARING. FROM WHERE YOU PARK GO STRAIGHT AHEAD, A ATV  
TRAIL THAT IS WELL FLAGGED WILL BRING YOU RIGHT TO THE NORTH END OF TRENCH.

21 JUNE 2014 9:AM TO 5PM 24 MHRS 72 KLMS

GEORGE KEALEY, RICHARD LAFOUNTAIN AND JAMES CRIPPS WENT OUT TO MINERAL CLAIM.

WE DID SOME SCREENING FROM CENTER AREA AND SIDE OF HILL. WE FOUND LIGHT BLUE SOME SMALL PIECES OF AMETHYST. WE ALSO TOOK SOME OVERBURDON OFF THE NORTH END OF THE TRENCH USING CHIZELS AND RAILWAY SPIKES WE EXPOSED A SMALL SEAM OF AMETHYST.

4 JULY 2014 10:AM TO 2:00 PM 12MHRS 72 KLMS

GEORGE KEALEY, JAMES CRIPPS, AND RICHARD LAFOUNTAIN WENT OUT TO MINERAL CLAIM AND FOUND THAT SOMEONE HAD BEEN OUT TO THE CLAIM AND REMOVED THE AMETHYST WE HAD EXPOSED THE LAST TIME WE WERE OUT. IT WAS OBVIOUS THAT WHOEVER DID IT USED A PROSPECTORS PICK AND WALKED OFF WITH SOME TOOLS. WE DID SOME SCREENING ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE HILL AND FOUND A FEW AMETHYST CRYSTALS, THEN WE GOT SOME HEAVY RAIN AND WENT HOME.

15 SEPT 2014 8:30 AM TO 4:PM 17 MHRS 72 KLM

GEORGE KEALEY AND JIM CRIPS WENT INTO THE MINERAL CLAIM AND TOOK A SLAB OFF THE NORTH EDGE OF THE TRENCH AND EXPOSED A SEAM OF AMETHYST THAT HAD GROWN INTO EACH OTHER AND WERE COATED WITH HEMATITE. THEN WE DID SOME SCREEN, FOUND A FEW SINGLE AMETHYST CRYSTALS.

18 OCT 2014 9:AM TO 5:00PM 24 MHRS 72 KLMS

GEORGE KEALEY, RICHARD LAFOUNTAIN AND JAMES CRIPPS WENT TO THE MINERAL CLAIM. JIM DID SOME SCREENING AT THE SOUTH END OF THE TRENCH. RICHARD AND I REMOVED SOME OVERBURDEN AT THE NORTH END OF TRENCH. THEN USING SOME CRACKS IN THE ROCK, SOME LARGE CHIZELS, RAILWAY SPIKES AND A SLEDGE WE TOOK THREE NICE SLABS OFF. EXPOSED SOME SMALL HEMATITE COATED AMETHYST.

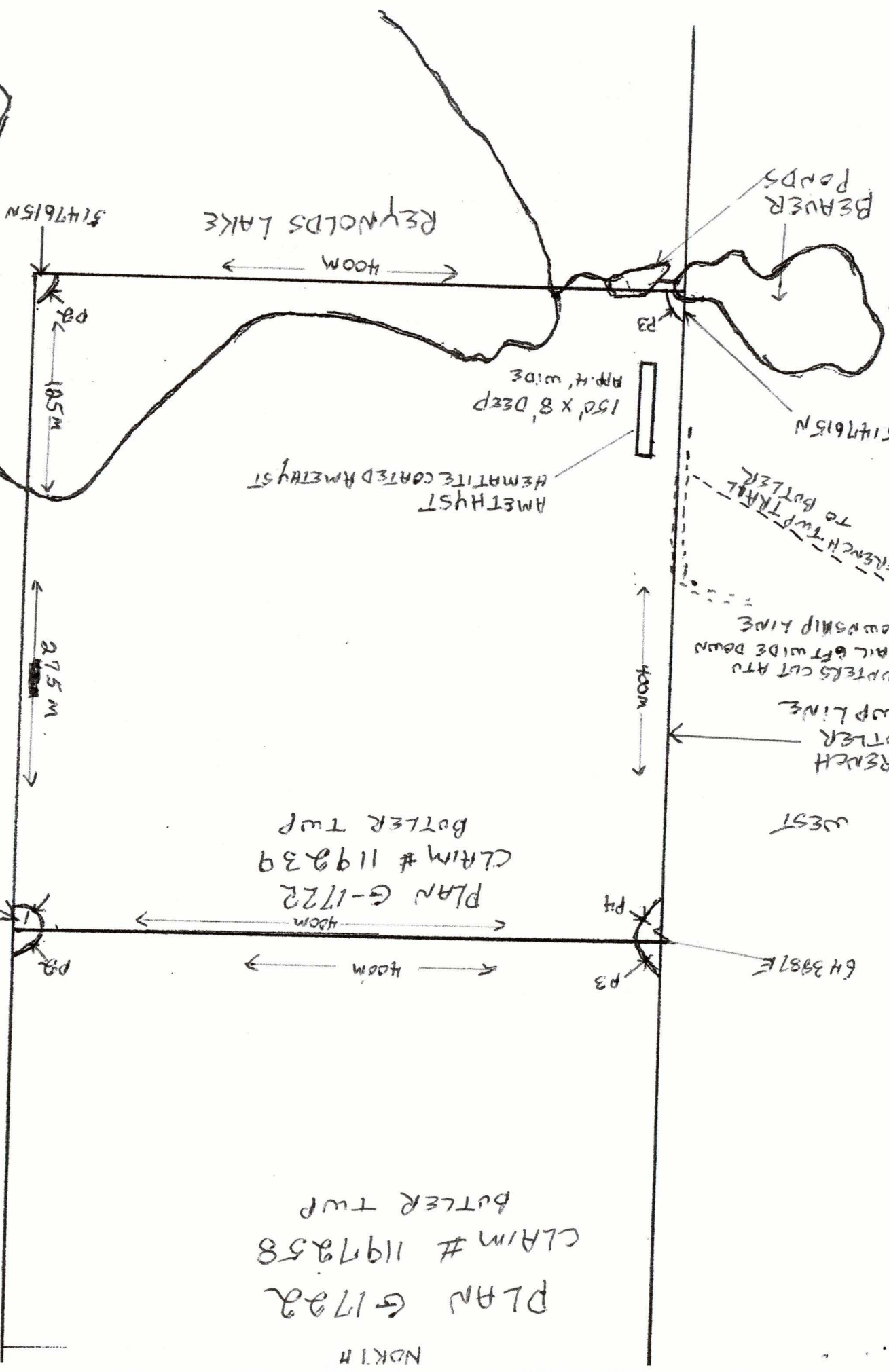

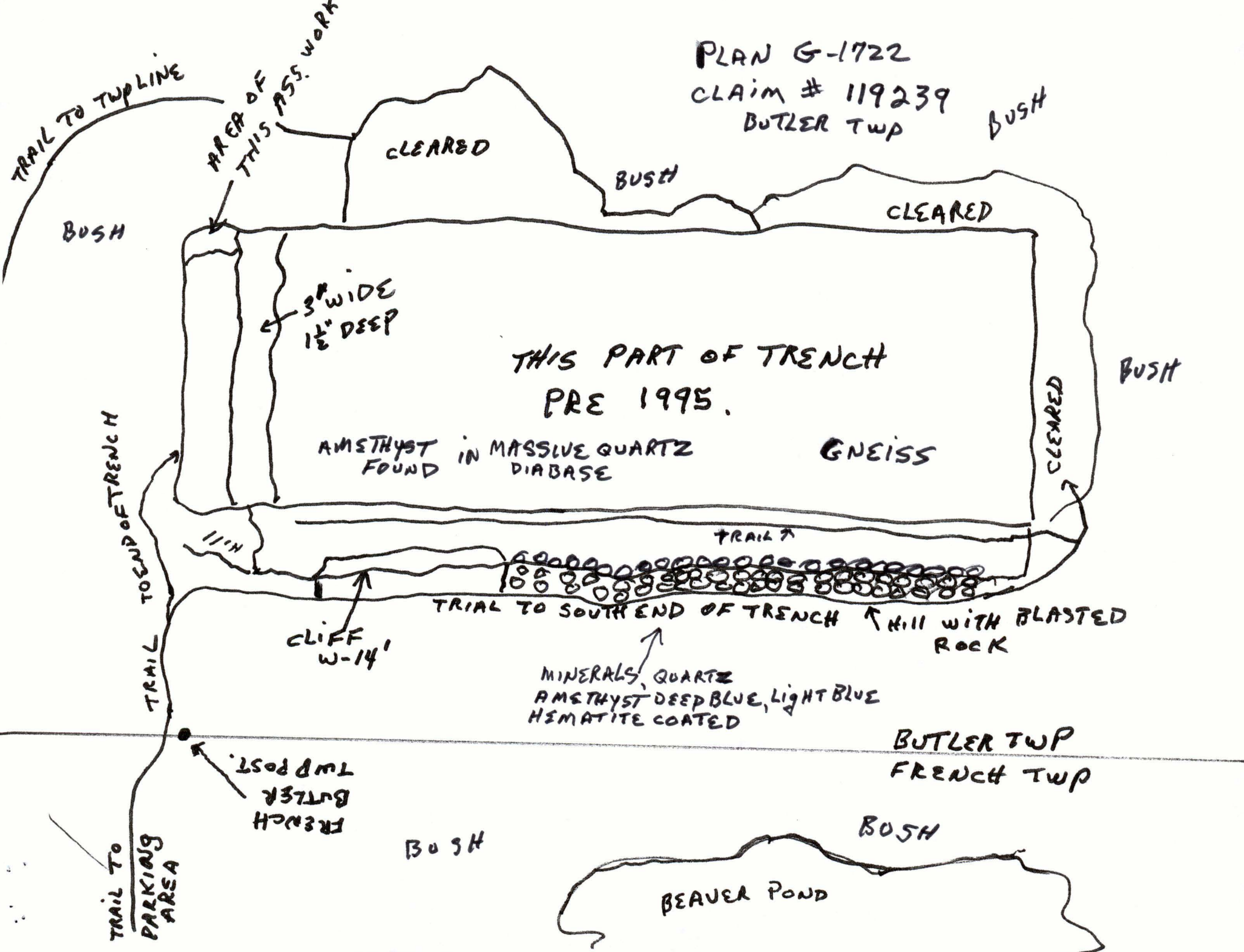
