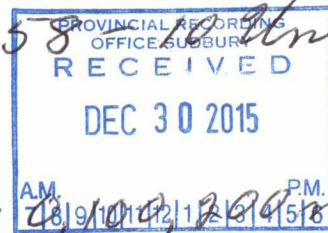


Prospecting on Claim 4275058



Day #1 Nov 3/15

Gil Allaire prospected on Lines 100, 200, 300 north

All 3 lines had no outcrops and all 3 lines were sand & gravel small pine trees about 12 years old near Monahan creek there is large pine trees.

Douglas prospected on Lines 300, 400, 500 north. Line 300, 400N had no outcrops there was sand and gravel small pine trees, larger pine trees near Monahan creek but on line 500N at 50M north a outcrop was located it was about 50M long by 30-40M wide crossing line 500N. The rock outcrop was andesite pillow lava volcanics with little shearing on the outcrop with little pyrite present. The rest of line 500N was sand & gravel small pine trees. no sample taken

Day #2 Nov 4/15

Douglas prospected on Lines 600, 700, 800N there was no outcrops found the lines they are all sand and gravel small pine trees with large pine trees near Monahan creek both sides of creek.

Day #2 Nov 4/15

Gil Allaire prospected on Lines 1200, 1300, 1400 North all three lines was sand & gravel with small pine trees and some spruce trees was present also. Large pine & spruce trees near Monahan creek area.

Day #3 Nov 5/15

Douglas prospected on Lines 900, 1000, 1100 north all 3 lines was sand and gravel small pine trees but near Monahan creek there is large pine trees on all three lines.

Day #3 Nov 5/15

Gil Allaire prospected on Lines 1500, 1600 north there was no outcrops found both lines had small pine and spruce trees with large pine and spruce trees near the Monahan creek area, The lines had sand and gravel and some swamp areas also. Gil Allaire had to leave his truck on the claim broken brake line.

The east side of the property was not finished prospecting because of the large creek and nowhere to cross the creek lots of flooded areas also on this claim #4275058 - 10 units so we decided not to do the rest of this claim

Report on Claim #4275058 - 10 units

This claim is interesting because there is andesite pillow lava volcanics which rapes around the large ultra mafic which is the large Mc Cool hill area. All the claims which rapes around the ultra mafic or along the contact of the ultra mafics is a important area to be looking for gold ^{or} lead, zine, copper, all the claims in this whole area needs lots of good geophysics done on all the claims. Then drilling would be carried out on the IP survey weaker conduction found along the ultra mafic contacts. Is where the gold lead, zine, copper would be found. The volcanics are very important to be found in this area near the ultra mafic. In the early years about 40-50 years ago John Mainville just drilled mag high which was the ultra mafic. They where just looking for asbestos at that time because they had there mine in Munro Twp which was a large open pit operation back in the 1950, 1960 it close down in the late 1960.

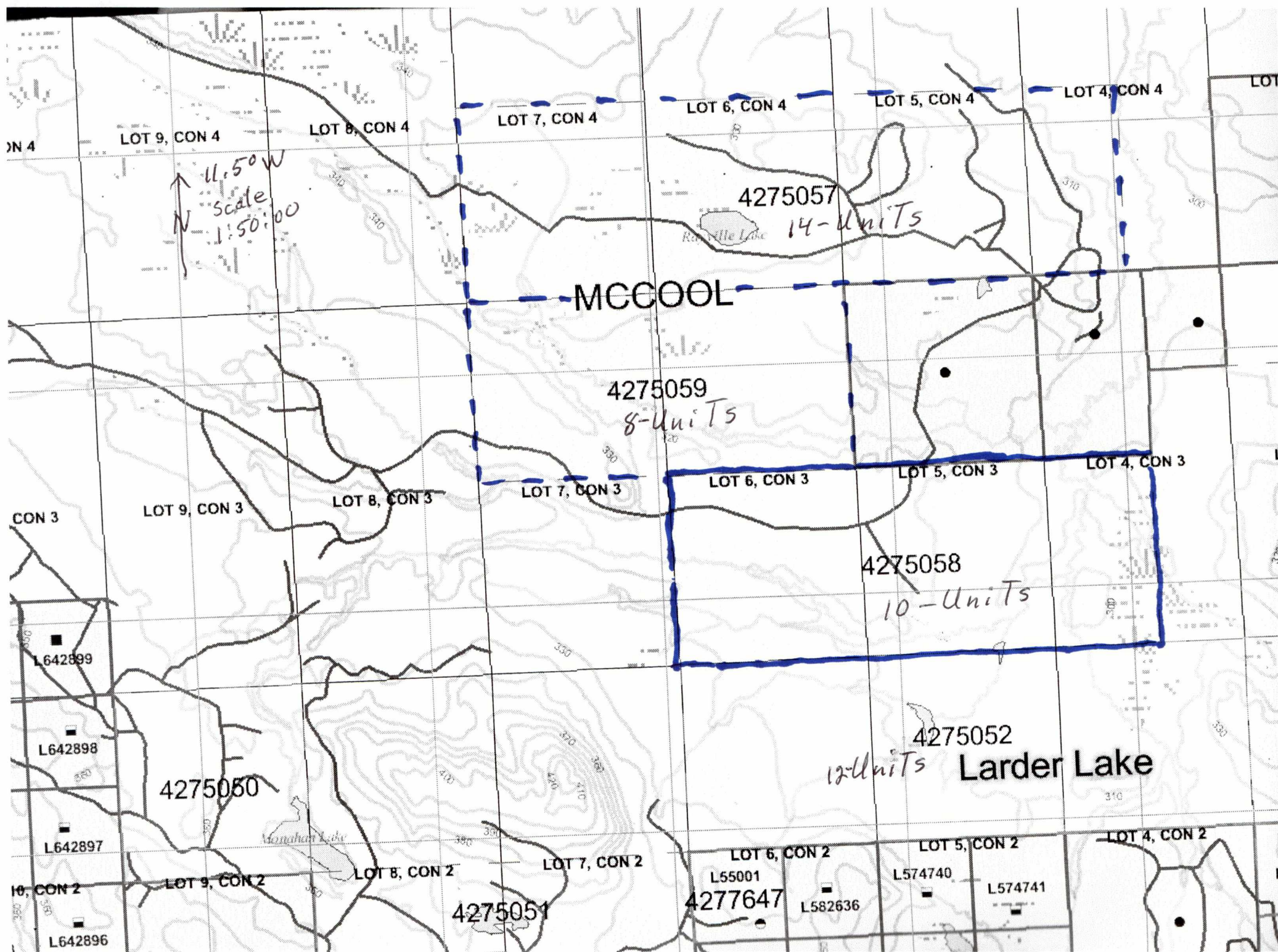

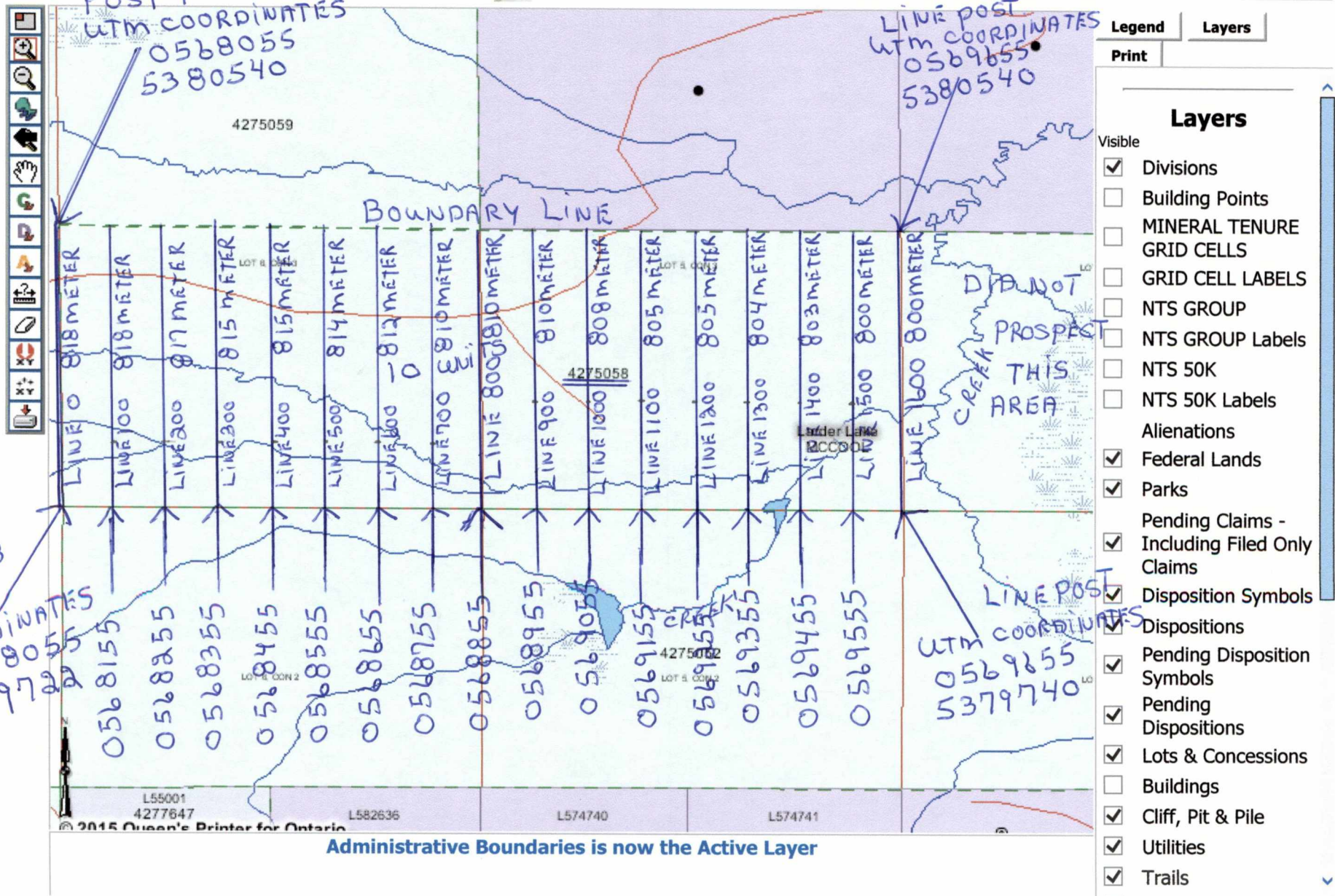

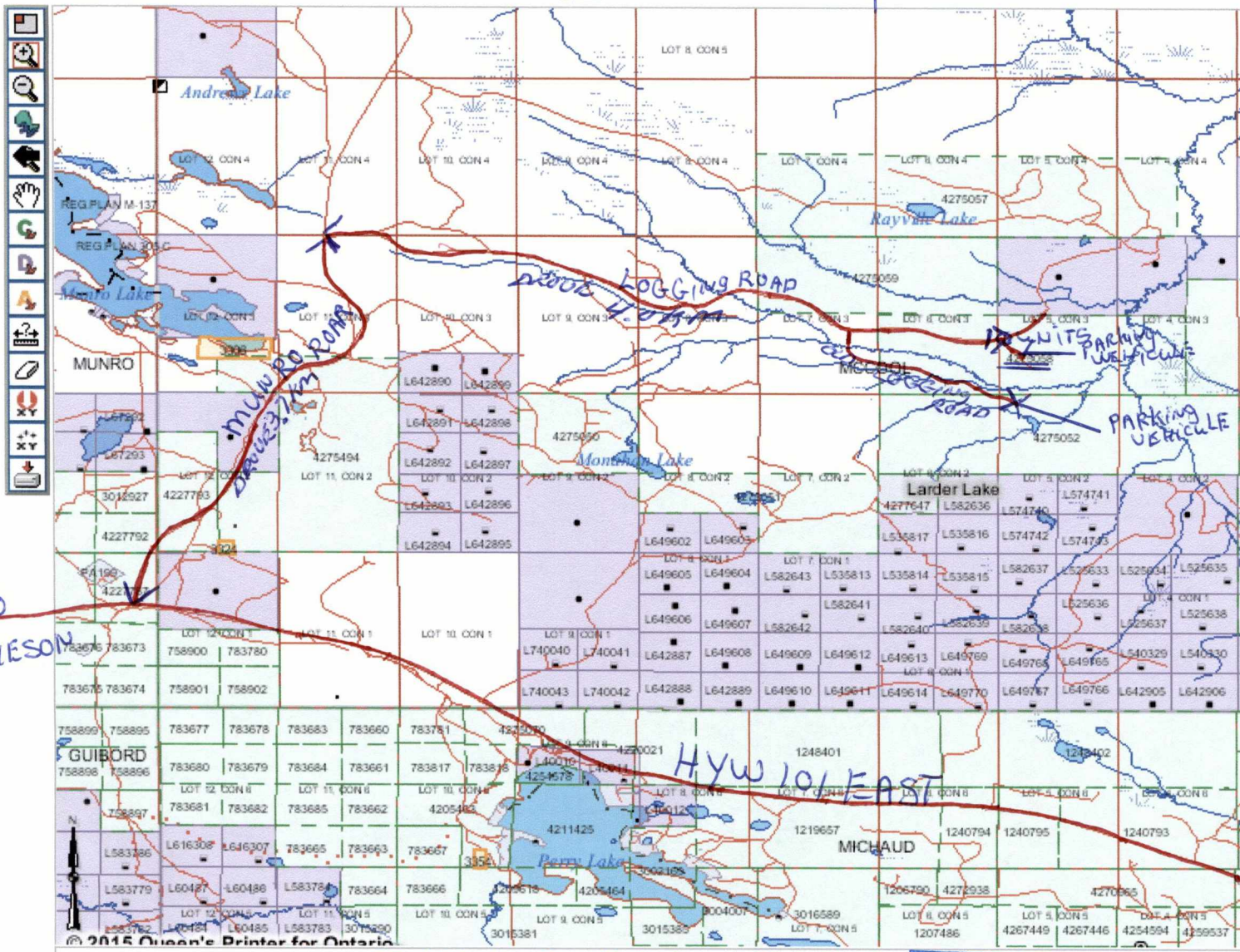
