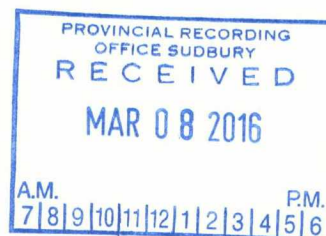

INTRODUCTION

Claim 4275123 consists of 6 contiguous units in Valin township and was staked on June 8, 2014 by Mario Pilon and recorded in Patti Overton's name. Keith Windsor and Garry Windsor have been doing the prospecting and sampling work on the claim under an agreement with Ms Overton. In 2015 the claim was transferred to Keith Windsor and Garry Windsor.

The work includes travel from New Liskeard and Timmins to the claim and prospecting for quartzite outcrops, with high purity silica. Trail cutting to some of the locations and selecting and sending samples out for assay were also performed. We also checked out access routes for prospective buyers.

LOCATION AND ACCESS

Claim 4275123 is accessible from the north by the Sandy Lake/ Extender road entrance on the south side of highway 560, 9 kilometres west of Shining Tree . At 11.5 kilometres in, turn south at the fork and continue for another 54.5 kilometres. The name of the road changes to 'Fryer Road' at the bridge.

Post #3 of the claim is situated at coordinates UTM zone 17 499399 Easting and 5228641 Northing and is near the road.

PROPERTY DESCRIPTION

The 6 unit claim is located on a forested hill of massive quartzite which shows in various knobs and outcrops. The claim has flat areas adjacent to the logging road access that could be used for open pit mining equipment and stockpiles of quartzite. There does not appear to be any people living in that area. The east side of the claim includes part of Nault Lake, a water source.

PROSPECTING AND SAMPLING REPORT

Claim 4275123 was staked June 8, 2014 after a number of samples were taken. One of the samples was taken on June 6, 2014. It later assayed at 98.0% SiO₂.

This assay is included in the following pages as CAO2232-SEP14. It is not added as a cost.

The following pages are the Daily Logs which detail the dates we travelled to the claim, the assessment work and associated costs. Also included in this section are the sample assay results.

The costs are detailed on the MNDM form 241 included in the report as Attachment 1.

CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The claim is an excellent source of silica suitable for smelting purposes. The deposit is a quartzite hill covered by the 6 unit claim. Assayed samples at the base and at the top of the hill indicate a depth of at least 30 metres of quartzite with silica purity in the range of 92% to 98%. A rough volume calculation would be in the millions of tonnes.

There is a flat area on the northwest end of the claim which would be suitable for mining operations and stock piling.

The area is well drained so the material mined would be dry, and there are water sources on the east side of the claim for any requirements.

Access to the Capreol area is south on the Fryer and Portelance roads. Access to highway 580 is north on the Sandy Lake road. From there the mined material can be hauled west to the railroad at Ostrom and from there direct to the proposed smelter north of Capreol. Alternatively east on 580 and north on the Grassy Lake road to Timmins if a smelter is built there.

Exploration drilling and analysis should be done to determine grades and reserves.

PROSPECTING QUALIFICATIONS

Garry Windsor has been prospecting for over 25 years. He has staked claims, cut lines, sampled, blasted, and negotiated options and production agreements. He has used VLF and EM methods.

Keith Windsor has been prospecting since 1993. He has attended a prospecting course in 1994 at the School of Mines and another related seminar in Kirkland Lake. He has also taken a blasting course in Kirkland Lake. His experience includes staking, line cutting, and sampling, including soil sampling for diamond indicators.



Garry Windsor drove from Timmins Ontario to the Moose Mountain Minesite located northwest of Capreol Ontario via Chelmsford to check the road width, condition and distance beginning at the Portelance Road and ending at Moose Mountain. While prospecting for silica along the Fryer Road and Portelance Road from the Elk Lake Highway right through to Capreol there was no time to explore the final link to the Moose Mountain Minesite, the possible location of the Ring of Fire Smelter.

It is costly but very important for us as prospectors to know all about access as it is key to our efforts to locate a source of high grade silica flux. If access not suitable for hauling large quantities of flux, rail may have to be considered.

Garry took photos of the two bridges encountered on the Moose Mountain Road and measured the distance and sized up the road condition. It appears that the road would be congested and rail will now be looked at. Assessing the access is more important than sampling and assaying as it is the first consideration however in this case it was quite costly due to distance.

Keith Windsor travelled to Valin Township from New Liskeard Ontario via pickup truck and Garry Windsor travelled there from Timmins Ontario via hwy. 144.

The purpose of the trip was for two reasons, the first was to prove that the claim was numbered with the proper numbered tags at a request from Michelle Watkins, Provincial Mining Recorder. 

Keith Windsor and Garry Windsor performed assessment work for Patti Overton recorded holder of staked mining claim number #4275123. The purpose of this trip was to strip and collect a sample from a location discovered Sept. 27. This outcrop was tight and too difficult to obtain a sample without proper tools. Also to assess the northern part of the property for access and quarry operability by walking the contours to determine if there is room to stock pile and if the topography lends itself to road construction to higher levels. Samples for assay were also taken from this untested north eastern location on the claim. Keith Windsor stripped and collected a sample from the area located Sept. 27 and Garry walked the edge of the outcrop to the north eastern limit of the property and then climbed the contours and collected samples returning to the starting point. Certain of the samples collected will be assayed by S.G.S. Labs in Lakefield Ontario.
