

Preamble

We went up to Aylmer Township to prospect and map on claim 4203306 but unfortunately, there was no snow in Sudbury but 3-4" of snow at the claim north of Sudbury. We were able to determine that the outcrop of interest is quartz breccia and on a very steep hill that will require rope assistance in the summer to map and sample. Unknown to us, Gervais Lumber had made a new cut road into the bottom area of the claim and into claim 4216910. Despite the snow, we were able to expose some outcrop that was grey wacke. We will map the new road with GPS and identify any outcrop in the spring.

LOCATION AND ACCESS

Aylmer Township is located north of Lake Wanapitei, Sudbury Mining Division. Access to the mining claims in Aylmer Township is via Highway 545 North of Capreol and onto the Portelance Road. You travel north for 18 km after the turnoff for the Wanapitei First Nation. You then leave the Portelance Road and turn South over the bridge of the Wanapitei River onto the Poupore Road. You travel on the Poupore Road for 11 km to 13 km to access the claims in difference areas.




Jim, Tom and I went up to the property to do mapping and prospecting on an area of claim 4203306. There was about 3 inches of snow that didn't help in our work. We worked on a large quartzite showing just off the Poupore Road. The showing is basically a very steep hill that could require ropes to sample better. A short distance away, Gervais Lumber has made a new road across a swamp into the area where we have been searching for the discovery location. The rock is very dark and fine grained with minor sulphides. It appears to be sedimentary but will require more mapping and sampling.


