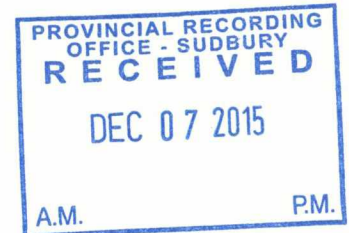

## LOCATION AND ACCESS

Aylmer Township is located north of Lake Wanapitei, Sudbury Mining Division. Access to the mining claims in Aylmer Township is via Highway 545 North of Capreol and onto the Portelance Road. You travel north for 18 km after the turnoff for the Wanapitei First Nation. You then leave the Portelance Road and turn South over the bridge of the Wanapitei River onto the Poupore Road. You travel on the Poupore Road for 11 km to 13 km to access the claims in difference areas.

**Date:** October 23, 2015

Picked up Jim and Tom and went up to do mapping and prospecting on 4203306 and up into 4216908. From our start off point at the northern stripped area of the quarry, we made a northerly traverse 700 meters north then 100 meters west and back south 700 meters. The start off point was in quartzite with jointing west but most of the traverse was in laminated wacke or arkose with the jointing normal from the start at due north. As most lines are removed we started off at GPS 0517209, 5190249.

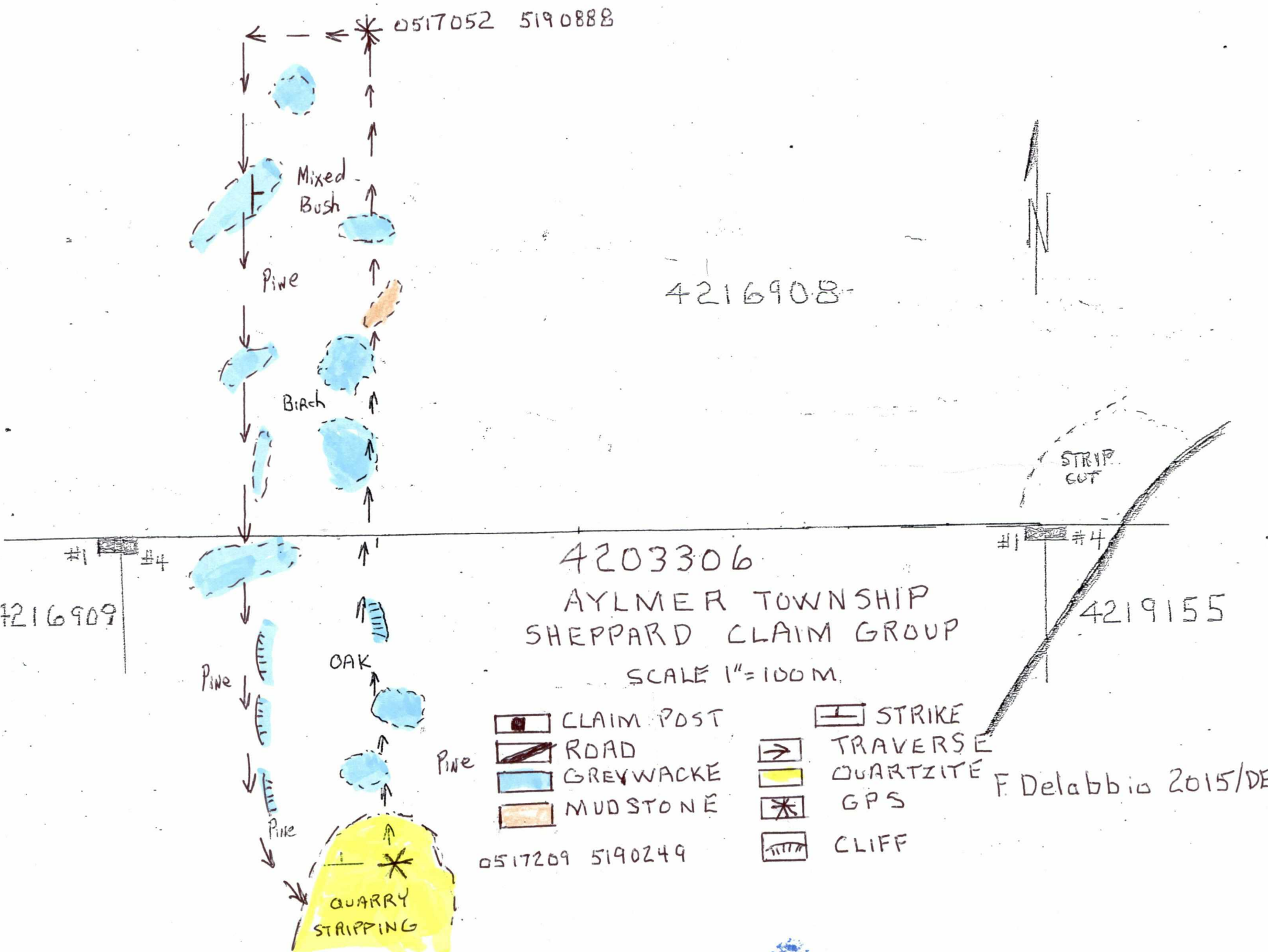

## **PREAMBLE**

We continue to do prospecting and mapping this block of claims to locate more quartzite and or quartz breccia which appears to be host to the chalcopyrite and bornite located in the center of claim 4203306. Most of the prospecting to date has only yielded locations of sediments namely grey wacke, laminated wacke and mudstone. We have expanded the quartzite mainly on 4203306 with some additional areas still to be prospected.
