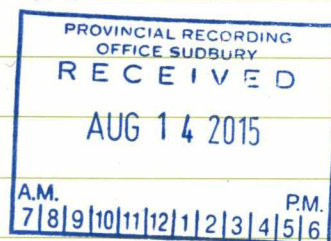

DAY TO PICK UP 5 GRAB SAMPLES FROM
MY CLAIM #4242292.

I DROVE 3 KILOMETRES FROM MY
RESIDENCE IN TOWN TO HIGHWAY 622, THEN
TRAVELLED NORTH WEST FOR 25 KMS. TO
THE HARDTACK ROAD, AND PROCEEDED
NORTHEASTERLY UP THE HARDTACK ROAD
FOR 3 KMS. FROM THERE I WENT 1.5 KMS.
BY ATV TO VARIOUS TARGET AREAS ON 2
TRAILS WHICH I HAD CUT.

I WALKED ALONG RIDGES AND COLLECTED
5 GRAB SAMPLES. THEY WERE ASSAYED IN
LATE FEBRUARY 2015. SIX SAMPLES WERE
ASSESSED BUT ONLY 5 WERE FROM THE
CLAIM #4242292.

JUNE 27, 2015 - I STARTED CUTTING
A THIRD ATV TRAIL TOWARDS THE CENTRE
OF THE CLAIM FOR 14 VARIOUS MORNINGS
UNTIL JULY 20.

JULY 21, 22, 23 - ACQUIRED 17 MORE
GRAB SAMPLES

JULY 24 - I TOOK THE SAMPLES TO
ACTLABS IN THUNDER BAY TO BE ANALYZED

SITE DESCRIPTION:

THE CLAIM AREA CONSISTS MAINLY OF SHALLOW SOILS WITH 2 MAIN RIDGES RUNNING IN A NORTHERLY DIRECTION, ONE RIDGE IS LOCATED BETWEEN #2 POST AND #1 POST. THE OTHER RIDGE RUNS NORTH THROUGH THE CENTRE OF THE CLAIM. BETWEEN THE RIDGES ARE ONE BIG SWAMP - BLACK SPRUCE, CEDAR, TAMARACK - NEAR #4 POST. SMALLER RAVINES LIE TO THE SOUTH EAST.

NEAR THE CENTRE OF THE CLAIM IS A SMALL LAKE DRAINING EASTERLY INTO FINLAYSON LAKE.

TIMBER TYPES ARE MAINLY POPLAR AND BIRCH ON THE RIDGES WITH SMALLER AMOUNTS OF JACK PINE, BALSAM, INTERSPERSED WITH A FEW OLD WHITE PINE. SWAMP SPECIES ARE BLACK SPRUCE PRIMARILY, WITH LESSER QUANTITIES OF TAMARACK AND CEDAR. THE FEASIBLE AREA FOR LOGGING WAS CUT 25 YEARS AGO. THE UPCOMING REGENERATION IS JACK PINE, POPLAR, BIRCH, BALSAM, AND HARDWOOD BRUSH. THERE ARE STILL SOME VISIBLE OLD SKIDDER TRAILS - SOME OF WHICH I UPGRADED FOR ATV USE.

THERE IS EVIDENCE OF PREVIOUS PROSPECTING SEVERAL YEARS AGO - BLAZES.

ENCLOSED IS A WORK MAP OF CLAIM #4242292 WHICH ALSO ILLUSTRATES GEOLOGICAL CONTOUR LINES OF THE AREA.

BELOW, AS WELL, IS A DESCRIPTION OF EACH SAMPLE SITE.

#1 - SMOKEY QUARTZ WITH RUST, ROSE QUARTZ, PEPPER FLECKS, HEAVY IRON

#2 NORTH SIDE OF BIG RIDGE RUNNING NORTH AND SOUTH, GREENSTONE, SLIGHT IRON LAYERED.

#3 SOUTH SIDE OF LOW RIDGE RUNNING NORTHEAST, SMOKEY QUARTZ WITH RUST, PEPPER SPOTS ASSOCIATED WITH IRON

#4 SOUTH SIDE OF BIG STEEP RIDGE RUNNING NORTH, A FEW BROKEN SMALL SLABS, GREENSTONE WITH IRON STREAKS, SLIGHT PURPLE

#5 WEST SIDE OF BIG RIDGE RUNNING NORTH, STEEP SLOPE, GREENSTONE, IRON, WITH PURPLE SPOTS.

#7 FACE IS 15 FEET HIGH, SMOOTH, 60° SLOPE
DIAGONALLY HORIZONTAL STREAKS, EXTENSION
OF RIDGEBACK AT SAMPLE #11, SMALL
SCATTERED FRAGMENTS ON TOP OF RIDGE
WITH SMALL SECTIONS OF OPEN BEDROCK,
RIDGE RUNS NORTHEAST TO A MAJOR DROP
TO A GRASSY SWALE. ROCK IS LIGHT GREY

DEPTH IS 10 FEET, 30° SLOPE, NO FACE,
SCATTERED OUTCROPPINGS

#10 ROLLING 30° SLOPE FOR 150 FEET
DOWN THE DROP TO A GRASSY SWALE-
SMALL FACE 3 FEET HIGH AND 30 FEET LONG
RUNNING NORTH, DARK GREY WITH RUST
NOTICEABLE WEIGHT, VERY SHALLOW SOIL
TIMBER - CEDAR 90%, WHITE PINE 10%
NATURAL REGENERATION EXCEPT FOR
TALL WHITE PINES. FEW SCATTERED PURPLE
AND YELLOW FLECKS, VERY SMALL

#11 SCATTERED FRAGMENTS 2" TO 6" DN
TOP OF SMALL RIDGEBACK RUNNING
NORTH EAST TO #7, DARK GREY WITH
MANY LITTLE SPARKLES, TINY QUARTZ
PIECES SHOWING IN MINIATURE CRACKS.
SMOOTH FACE 7 FEET HIGH 45° SLOPE
SHALLOW SOIL.

TIMBER - BIRCH 40% SPRUCE 20%
BALSAM 20%, POPLAR 10%, WHITE PINE 10%
ALL 30 YEAR OLD NATURAL REGENERATION
EXCEPT FOR WHITE PINE MONARCHS

#12 SMALL OUTCROP WITH 2" QUARTZ VEIN DN
TOP OF SHALLOW RAVIDGE RUNNING NORTHERLY
GRAY AND RUST WITH FINE QUARTZ VEINING.
MEDIUM SOIL DEPTH - 2 FEET.

TIMBER - POPLAR 20% BIRCH 30%
BALSAM 10%, BRUSH 40%, THIRTY YEAR
OLD REGENERATION

SAMPLES #13 TO #19 ARE ALL IN THE SAME SHALLOW TROUGH. RAVINE RUNS NORTH EAST AND ALL SAMPLES WERE TAKEN ON THE NORTH WEST SIDE OF THE RAVINE, WHICH IS MORE TOPOGRAPHICALLY ABRUPT.

#13 GRAY ROCK, VERTICAL STREAKING AND FRAGMENTS IN FACE 7 FEET HIGH ON SOUTH SIDE OF SHALLOW RAVINE RUNNING NORTH EAST. SHARP FRAGMENTS 8" TO 15" VERY SHALLOW SOIL.

TIMBER - POPLAR 70%, BIRCH 20%, BALSAM 10%
PREDOMINANTLY IRON PRESENCE WITH SCATTERED SILVER COLOURED FLECKS.

#14 LIGHT GRAY AND GREEN COLOURED ROCK. SMOOTH FACE WITH VERTICAL CRACKING AND SPARSE FRACTURED ROCK. SMOOTH BEDROCK OUTCROP ABOVE FACE. FACE IS 8 FEET HIGH AND ROUNDED. VERY SHALLOW SOIL.

TIMBER - JACK PINE 20%, BALSAM 10%, BIRCH 10%, POPLAR 60%. ALL 30 YEAR OLD NATURAL REGENERATION

#15 SMALL FRAGMENTS 4" WITH RUST AND GRAY, NOTICEABLE WEIGHT AS WELL AS QUARTZ PIECES 2" WITH RUSTY PINKISH STAINING AND TINY SILVERY COLOURED SPECKS TWO INCH STRIP OF QUARTZ IS ON TOP OF FACE. FACE IS 12 FEET HIGH WITH 70%
SLOPE.

QUARTZ SEAM IS RUNNING NORTH EAST ON TOP OF FACE. FACE IS DARK GREENISH GREY WITH VERTICAL STREAKS AND A LIGHT AMOUNT OF SHARP FRAGMENTATION.

TIMBER - JACK PINE 20%, BALSAM 10%, BIRCH 10%, POPLAR 60%, SAME AS SAMPLE #14. ALL NATURAL REGENERATION

#16 FACE IS 10 FEET HIGH 75° SLOPE AND CONTINUOUS FROM SAMPLE #15. SLATE COLOUR WITH LIGHT FRAGMENTATION AND A SMALL PATCH OF SMOKEY QUARTZ. VERTICAL STREAKS AND TO A LESSER EXTENT SOME HORIZONTAL SCRATCHING. VERY SHALLOW SOIL ON TOP OF FACE.

TIMBER - JACK PINE 20%, BALSAM 10%, BIRCH 10%, POPLAR 60%, SAME AS SAMPLES #14 AND #15. ALL NATURAL REGENERATION 30 YEARS OLD.

#17 FACE IS DARK GREY, 5 FEET HIGH WITH 45° SLOPE. VERTICAL STREAKING AND SHALLOW CREVICES, TWO FRACTURED ROCKS 12" AT BASE OF FACE. A HORIZONTAL VEIN OF QUARTZ WHICH IS ONE FOOT HIGH IS CONNECTED TO THE QUARTZ SHOWINGS IN SAMPLES #15 AND #16. FROM HERE, THE TERRAIN DROPS OFF AT 50° SLOPE FOR 80 FEET TO A BLACK SPRUCE SWAMP. SMALL SCATTERED BLACK AND BROWN FLECKS SPARSELY POPPED IN THE QUARTZ WITH AN IRON PRESENCE TO A MINOR DEGREE WITH YELLOWISH SPECKS

#18 FACE IS 5 FEET HIGH, 60° SLOPE

SLATE GREY, WITH IRON PRESENCE, RUST
FINE LIGHT COLOURED VEINING, SOME SILVERISH
SPECKS AND TINY BRONZE AND TARNISHED
YELLOWISH PARTICLES. FACE HAS VERTICAL
STREAKING AS WELL AS CRACKS FROM 1" TO
12" WIDE AND 2" TO 20" DEEP. SAMPLE HAD
NOTICABLE WEIGHT.

TIMBER - BALSAM 50%, POPLAR 20%,
BIRCH 20%, JACK PINE 10%. ALL NATURAL
REGENERATION 30 YEARS OLD. SHALLOW SOIL

#19 FACE IS 20 FEET HIGH WITH 60° SLOPE.
SMOOTH WEATHERED, LIGHTLY SCATTERED
PIECES 12" TO 15" IN SIZE. VERY SHALLOW SOIL.
ON TOP OF FACE ARE SCATTERED BEDROCK
OUTCROPPINGS IN PATCHES OF 150 SQUARE
FOOT SECTIONS.

TIMBER - JACK PINE 40%, BALSAM 40%,
BIRCH 20%, ALL NATURAL REGENERATION
30 YEARS OLD.

ALL SAMPLES #20, #21, #22, #23, AND #24
WERE TAKEN FROM THE EAST FACE OF A
SHALLOW RAVINE WHICH RUNS NORTH.

#20 SMALL SCATTERED PIECES LIGHT
GRAY WITH RUST. FACE IS 5 FEET HIGH
AND 10 FEET LONG. A FEW BOULDERS ON
TOP OF THE FACE.

TIMBER - BALSAM 60%, BIRCH 20%
BRUSH 20%. ALL NATURAL REGENERATION
30 YEARS OLD. SHALLOW SOIL.

#21 FACE IS FRACTURED, 20 FEET HIGH,
AND 75° SLOPE. DIAGONALLY VERTICAL
STREAKING WITH 1/4" WIDE QUARTZ STRIPE.
SLATE GRAY WITH 2" HORIZONTAL QUARTZ
VEIN. SLATE GRAY WITH RUST AND GOOD
WEIGHT. SHALLOW SOIL.

TIMBER - BIRCH 20%, BRUSH 80%

#22 FACE IS 12 FEET HIGH WITH 75° SLOPE,
FRAGMENTED PIECES 2" TO 10". A SHORT
QUARTZ VEIN 2" WIDE, AND A SMOKEY
QUARTZ POCKET 2 1/2 FEET IN DIAMETER.
SAMPLE IS MOSTLY RUST WITH SOME DARK
GRAY AND HEAVY. SHALLOW SOIL.

TIMBER - SPRUCE 10%, BIRCH 30%,
BALSAM 40%, BRUSH 20%. ALL NATURAL
REGENERATION 30 YEARS OLD.

#23 FACE IS 10 FEET HIGH WITH 80° SLOPE,
FRACTURED FRAGMENTS 3" IN SIZE
DARK GREY WITH RUST AND HEAVY
QUARTZ POCKET 4 FEET IN DIAMETER
WITH BROWN IRON STAIN AND A FEW TINY
SILVERISH COLOURED SPECKS.

TIMBER - SPRUCE 10%, BIRCH 30%,
BALSAM 40%, BRUSH 20%. ALL NATURAL
REGENERATION 30 YEARS OLD. SHALLOW
SOIL.

#24 END OF FACE. GROUND TAPERS
GRADUALLY TO THE SOUTH. FACE HERE
IS 8 FEET HIGH WITH 45° SLOPE.
FRAGMENTS ARE 3" TO 6", DARK GREY
HEAVY, STRONG IRON PRESENCE WITH
SILVERISH SPECKS. ONE SIDE OF SAMPLE
IS FLAT WITH SMALL SHALLOW POCK MARKS
POCK MARKS ARE 2 MILLIMETRES IN DIAMETER
AND 1 MILLIMETRE DEEP. BOTTOM OF POCK
MARKS IS COLOURED REDDISH BROWN - AN
APPEARANCE SIMILAR TO MEASLES.

BALSAM 40%, BRUSH 20%. ALL 30 YEAR OLD
NATURAL REGENERATION, SHALLOW SOIL.

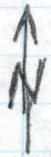

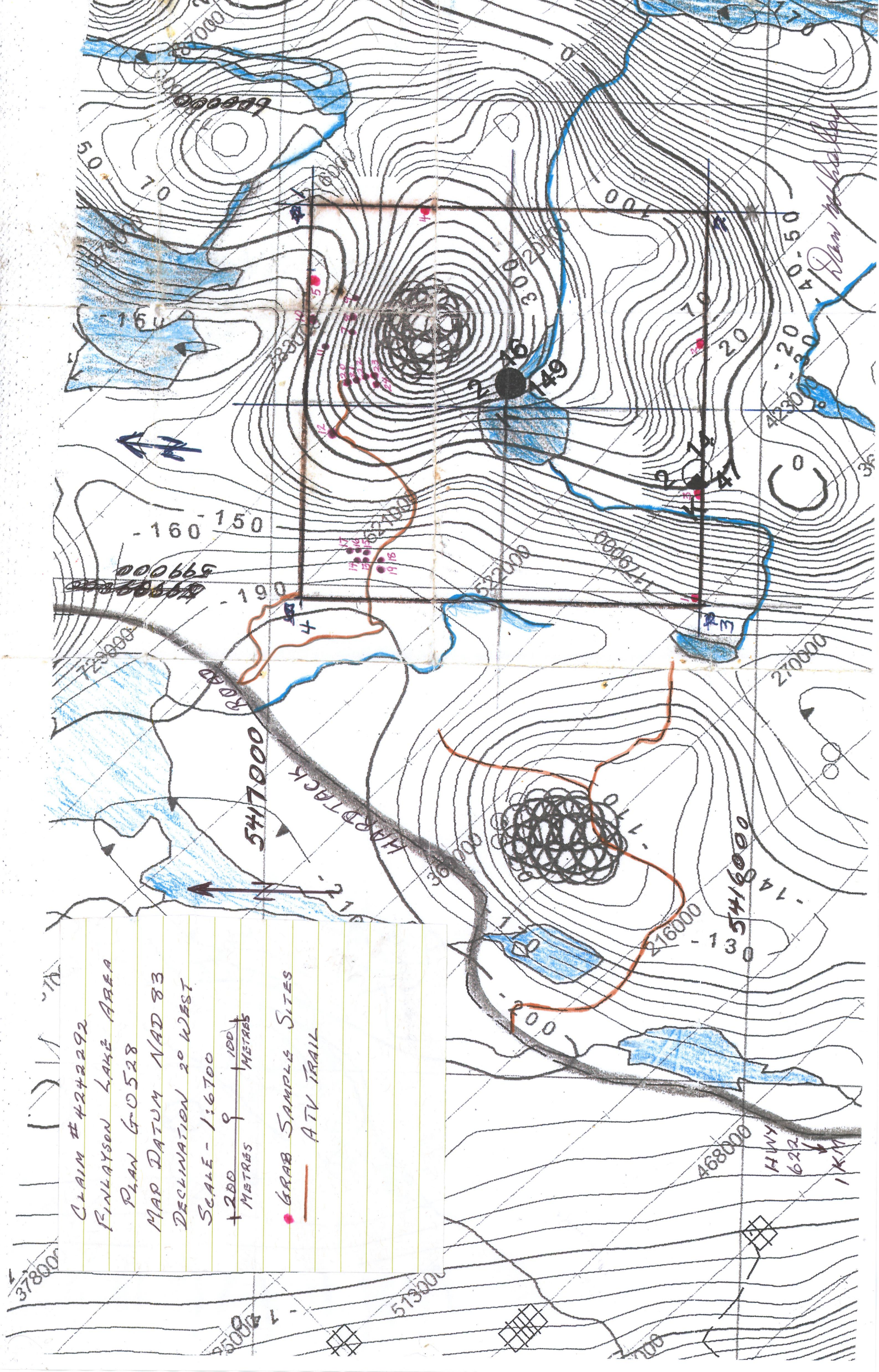
PINLAYSON LAKE AREA

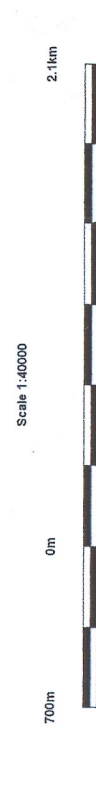

ATV TRAIL



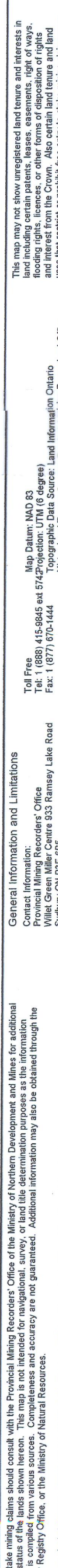

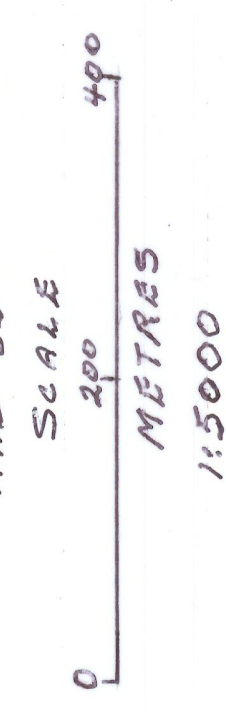

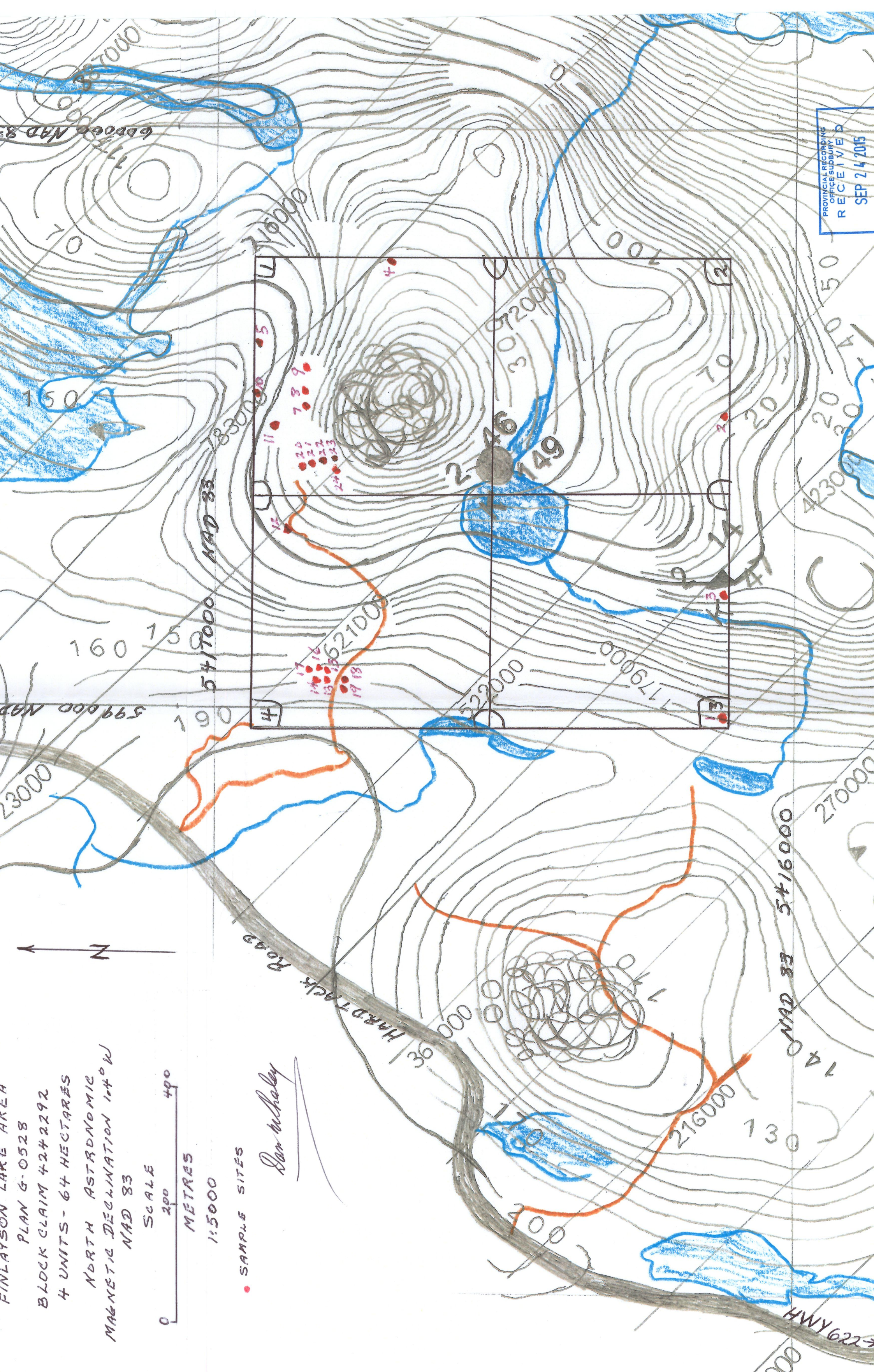


FINLAYSON LAKE AREA
