**1)Location:Claims (block of 3) No.1118377
Southern Ontario Region, Algonquin Mining District
District of Muskoka, Township of Monck, Lot 25, Con. XIII,

**The author has been working in industrial minerals since 1978 ,with the
government of Quebec till 1981 and as a consultant in the U.S. ,Canada and Mexico
for the last 13 years as well as internationaly for 6 years. The author as also been a
shareholder in Piertal and in Georedex Granit. The last 6 years have been with
Canamex Granit and Manex Granit. The bulk testing was conducted by Canital
Exploration in Winnipeg and consisted of removing a bulk sample of 1000 cubic
meters.**

**3) Exploration work to date consists of sampling and testing the stones for cutting and
finishing. Tests have shown the stone to be suitable. This work was recorded
June 25,1993.**

**4)The regional geology is Grenville Geological province in the Ontario
Gneiss Belt. The site is part of a syenitic gneiss, it is fine to medium grain,
banded black and brick colour granit. The orange and black syenitic gneiss is present
on the west side of the property covering 85% of the surface,it is unfractured with
scarce widely spaced vertical joints 20 to 40 meters apart and horizontal jointing 2 to 5
meters apart. Overburden is almost non existent inches here and there, nearly 100%
outcrop on the 85% westerly section the easterly 15% is a deciduous forested area
with overburden and the rock type is a migmatic gneiss.**

**5) The stone is usable on 85% of the property , restrictions are due to environmental
factors,constraints due to noise levels and aesthetics are on the extreme westerly and
southerly part of the site where the operations would become visible from the road and
cottages 3 or 4 Km away. Proximity of houses to the south, 350 meters away, is also a
factor rendering the south part less suitable. Estimated reserves are of 7000 to12000
cubic meters per year for 100 years or more.**

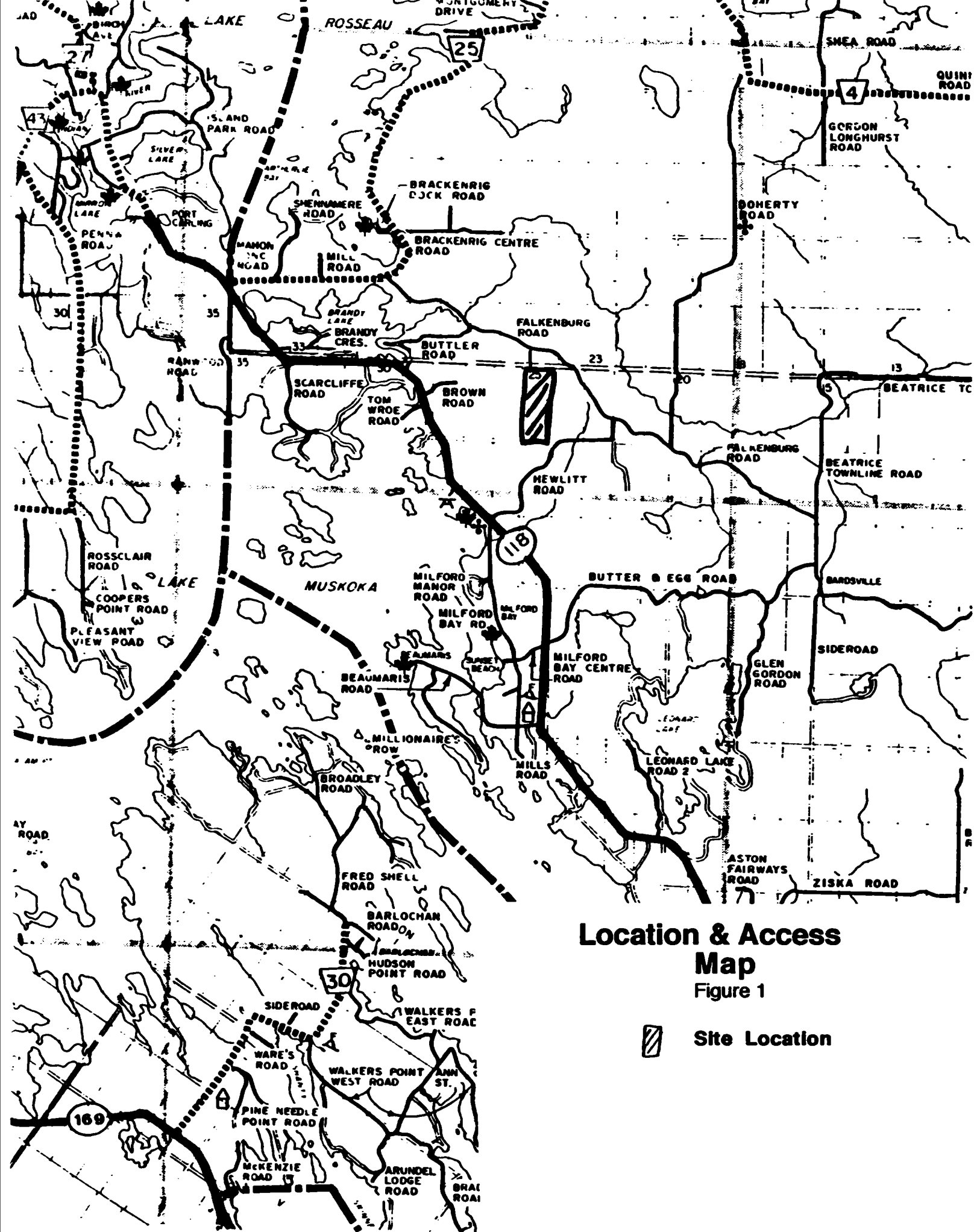
6) Material presently stockpiled in Winnipeg, only 9 blocks totalling approximately 25 cubic meter have been extracted.

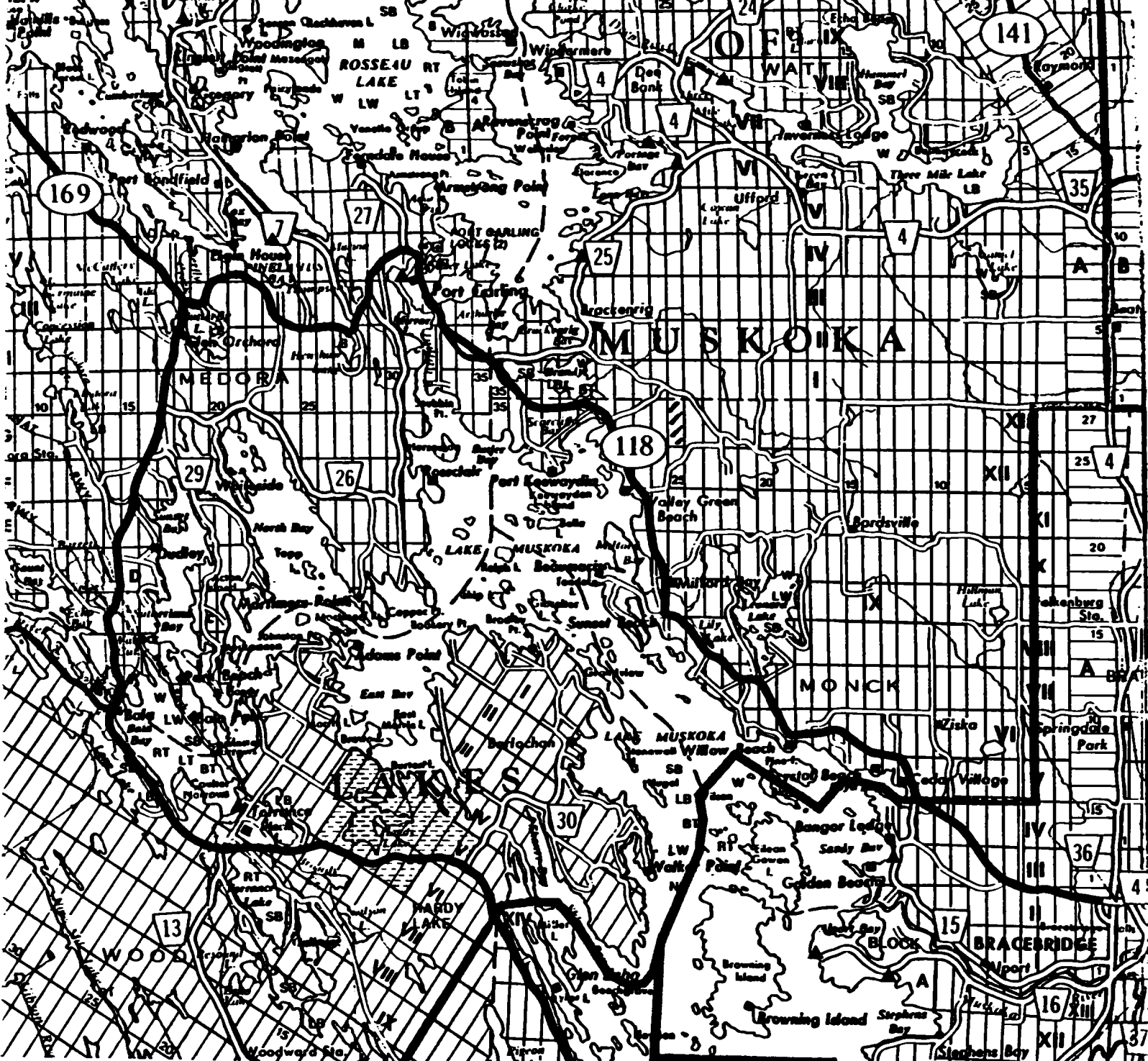
The tests of last year were done by Canital Exploration and have shown the material suitable at 0,5 to 1,5 meters below the surface, the stone does take and hold a finish (polished, flamed and sand blasted) and does hold together well during cutting and finishing. The stone is also of a uniform brick orange and black colour and the gneissic texture is of a very uniform banding, the stone seems suitable for construction and possibly monument, the required large volumes are also available.

7) A bulk sample to permit the marketing of tiles, slabs and blocks was under taken last summer. The stone is continuing it's marketing under the name "El Tigre" and was introduced to producers internationaly. Interest in the colour and the volume was quite good but concerns have to be put to rest on the uniformity and quarrability of this stone, problems of weathering on the surface stone have been observed as deep as 1 to 1,5 meters near the contact of the body but average in the 0,75 to 1 meter range overall. The stone shows potential in construction, monument and landscaping markets and is being introduced to potential clients such as producers and architects. Future steps involve on going marketing and plans are being made to complete the 1000 cubic meter bulk sample under our advance exploration permit in 1995. Unfortunately problems encored due to the shooting at the loader while the quarry master was driving it have cost us severely, with an early shut down and demobilisation and an inadequate bulk sample to pursue testing, costing and marketing. We now have to take extra precautions and extra costly steps. A break of a one year period will be taken from quarrying the site, during this period test will be done with new technologies and techniques, in other sites of ours, in the hope of reducing noise. Also after this cooling of period we will reattempt the opening of the quarry and try again, to enlist local people in training programmes, so that our labour force would be locally based. We will also not attempt any quarrying until there are leaves on the trees and cease all activities in fall when the leaves are down. We hope these measures will diminish friction and permit us to establish what we suspect to be an excellent site.

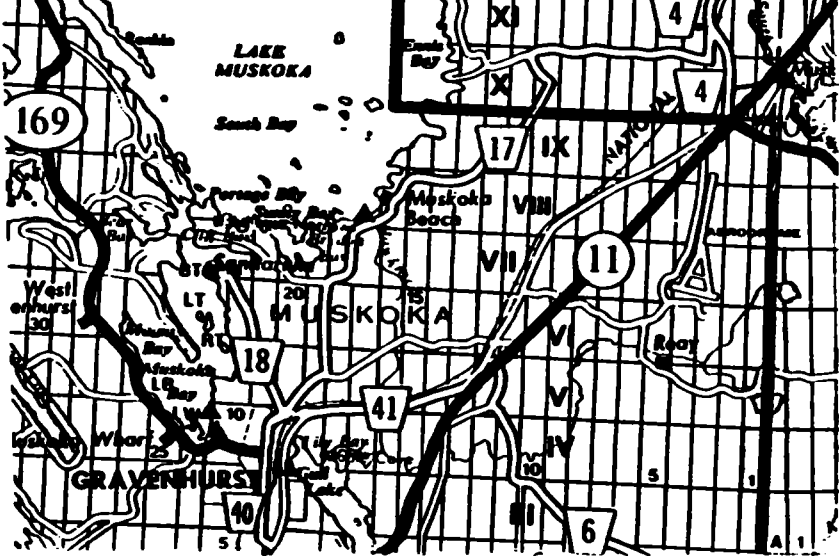









Claims Map

 Southern Ontario # 1118377



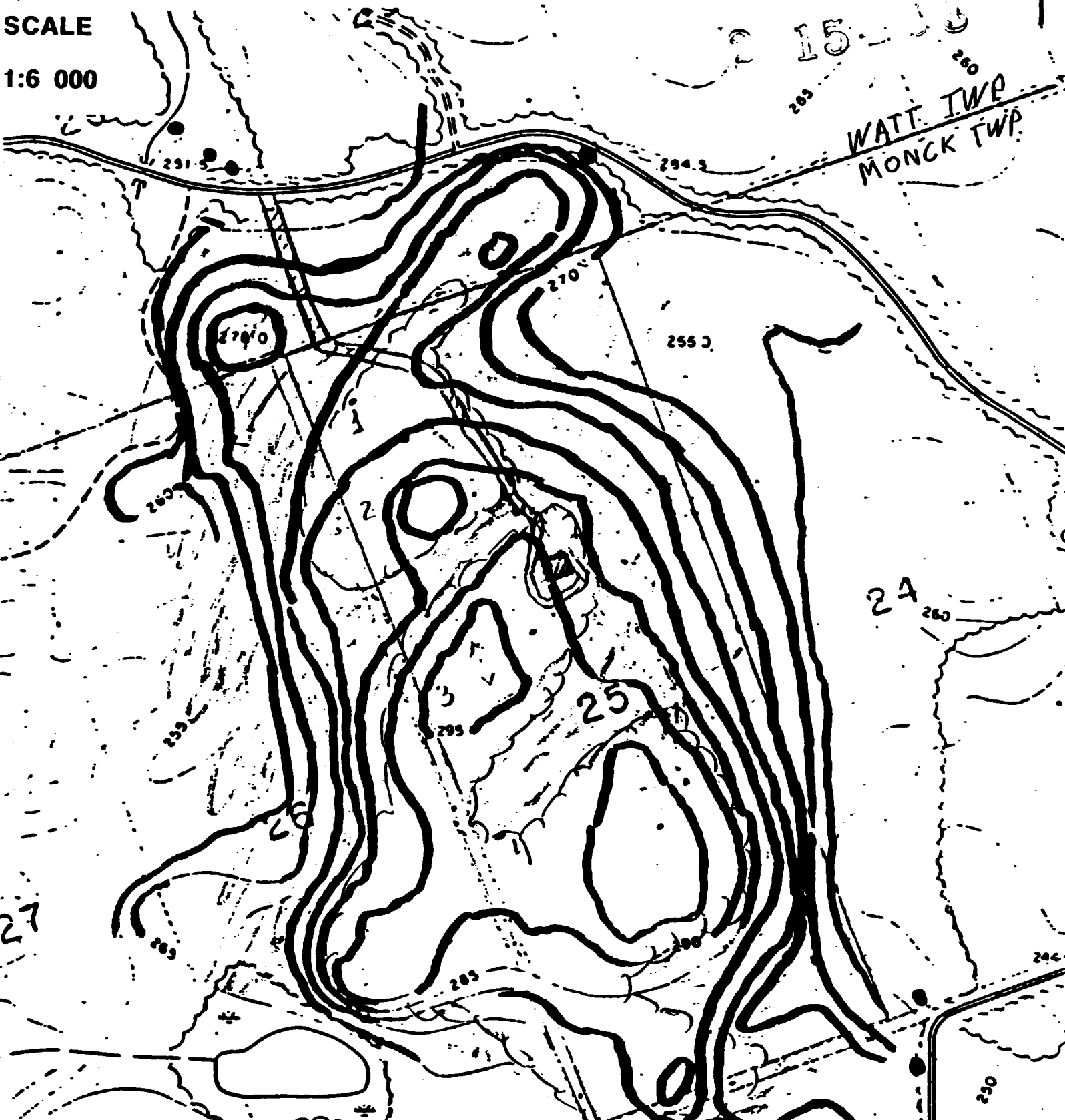
