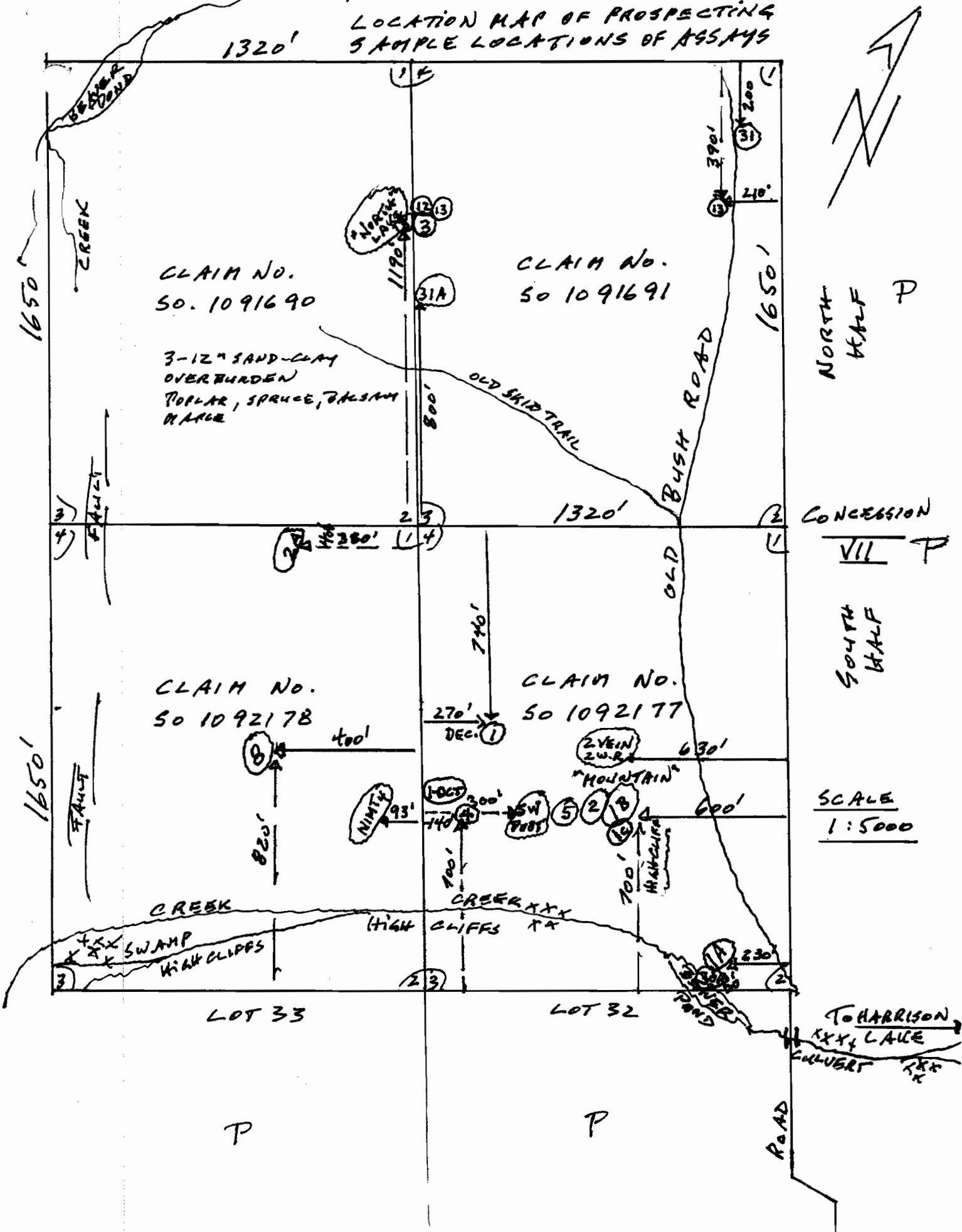

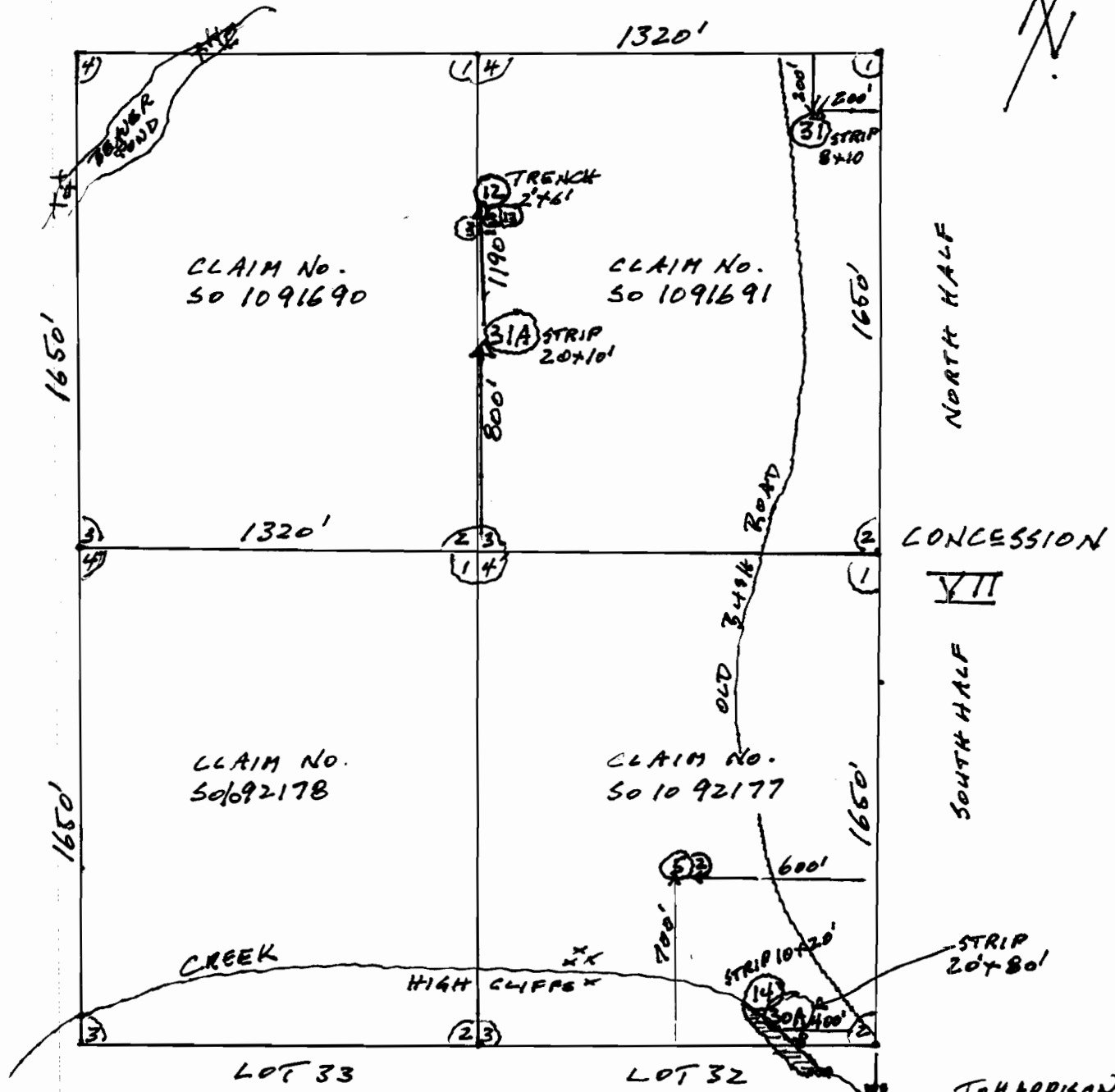
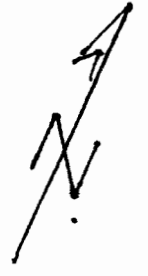

SAMPLE LOCATIONS OF ASSAYS

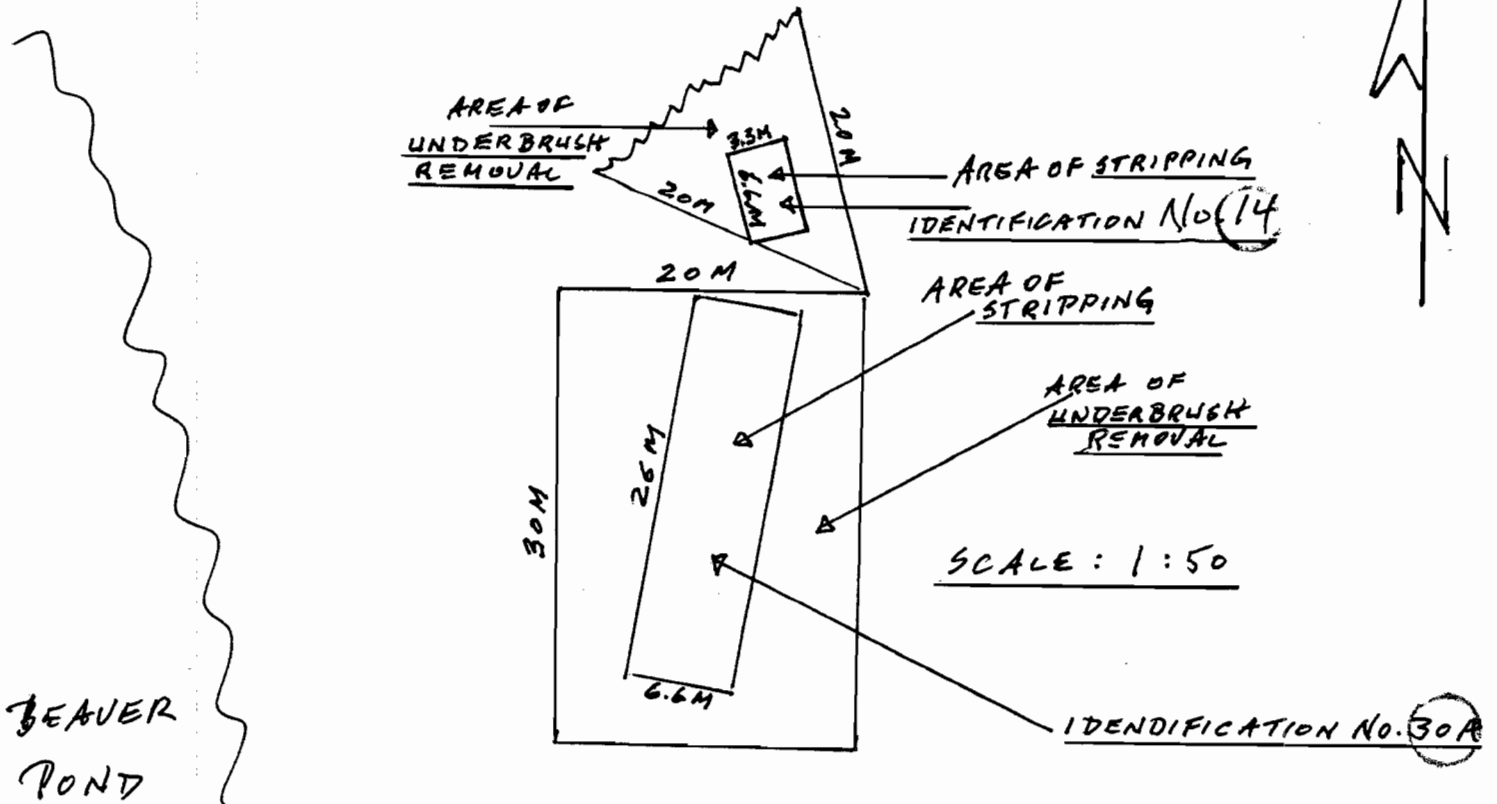


RYERSON TOWNSHIP  
LOCATION MAP OF STRIPPING



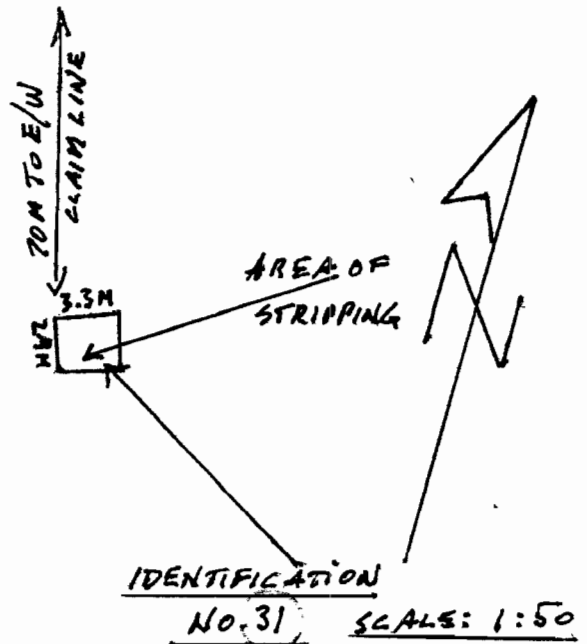

SKETCH OF STRIPPING AND UNDERGROWTH REMOVAL

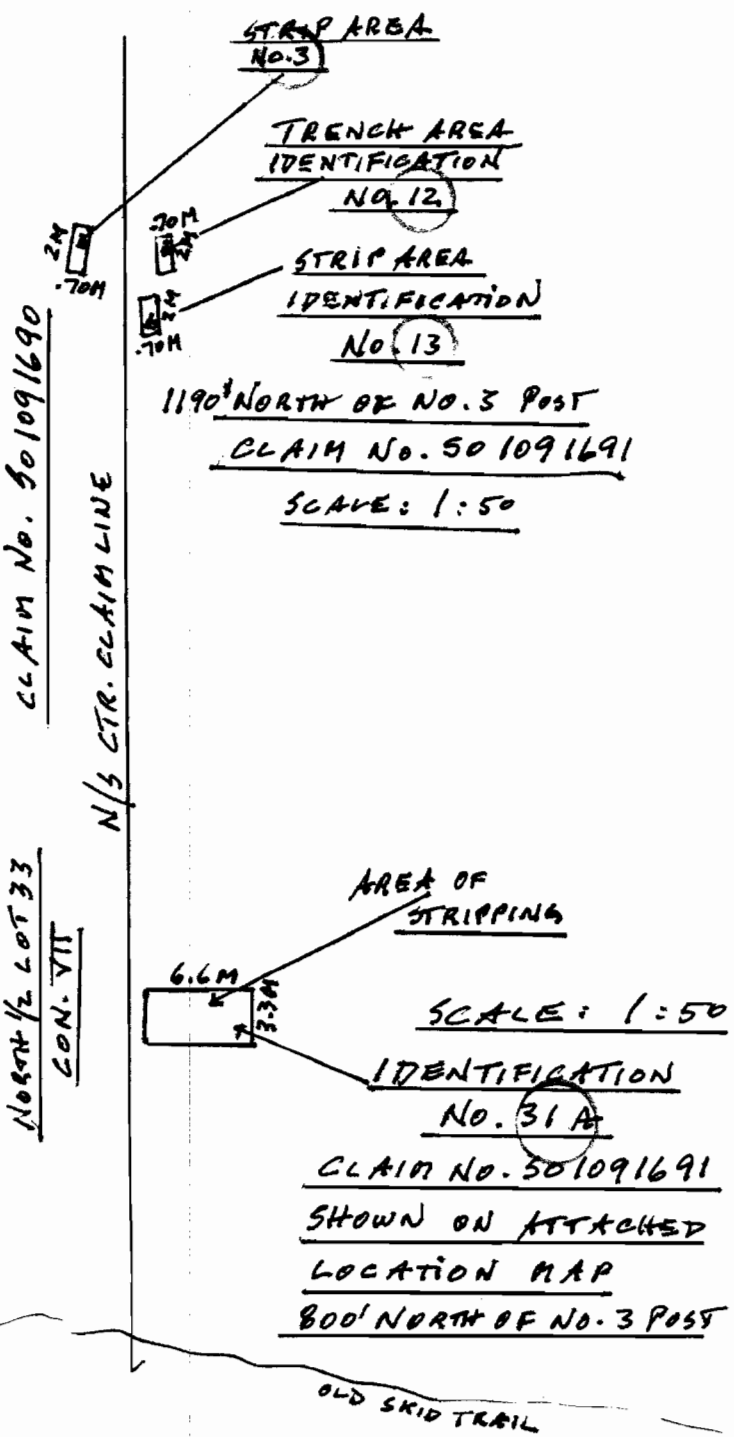

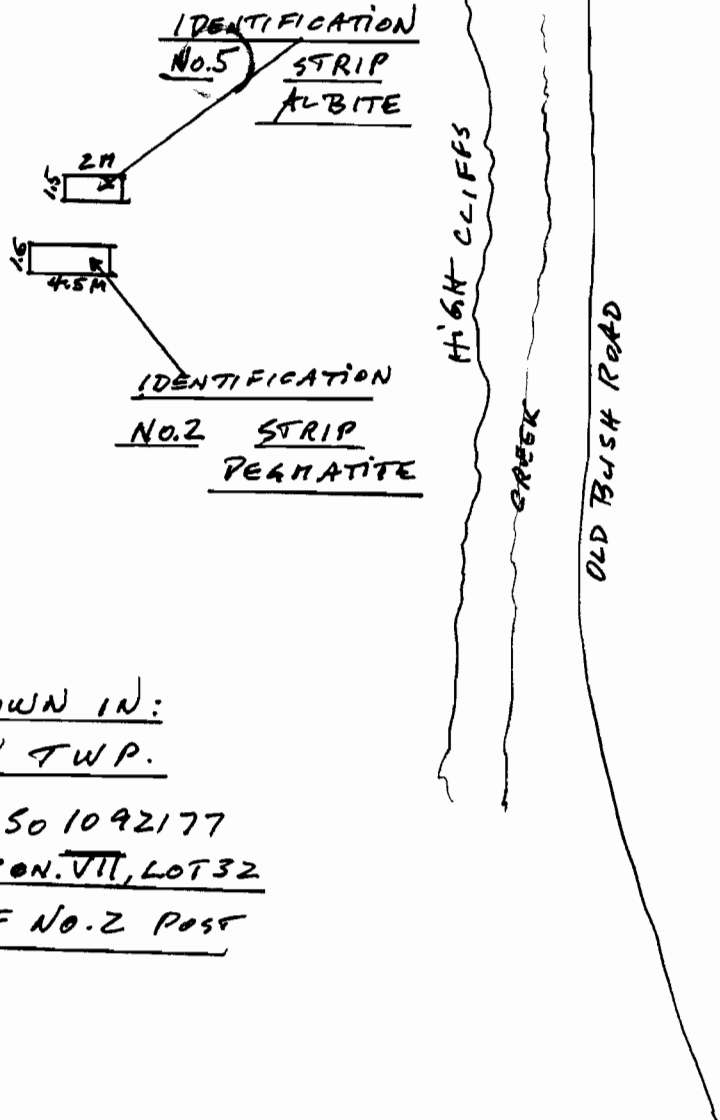
SKETCH OF STRIPPING AND UNDERGROWTH REMOVAL + TRENCHING


