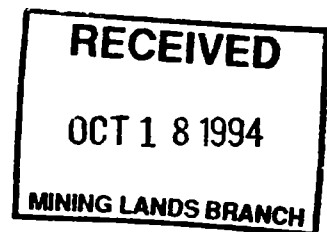

On Sept. 9/94 following recommendations of a preliminary report on a combined, induced Polarization, Magnetic and V.T.F. Survey performed on Mining Claims # 1179631 recorded in my name, this survey was performed on a 3 Km. grid in early Aug. 1994 prior to Mining Claim # 1118537 being recorded in my name and therefore is not being submitted at this time, and any reference is for background information only.

This survey indicated the possibility of an apparent anomaly showing on surface to the East of Pit #3 a reference point on all maps and sketches previously submitted, this pit with its mineralized showing had been previously mechanically stripped and has been reported for Assessment Credits.

Site #1 as shown on the accompanying sketch is a trench I dug, after referring to the data on the colored pseudosections however after being unable to definitely determine a contact between the Huronian and the Keewatin and no sign of any anomalous mineralization I moved some 15^m North and started to strip at Site #2 where I could see the Felsic Volcanics with disseminated Sulphides, I did some trenching to the South trying to locate a definite location of the contact, however the overburden became deeper and I abandoned it on hopes that I could locate it easier further East. At site #3 some 140^m E of Pit #3, I stripped an area that was a Mafic Volcanic with some minor pyrite mineralization, it appears that the Felsic Volcanics are resting on top of the Mafic at this site. I then moved over to Site #4 this is 200^m East and 50^m North of Pit #3 the rock here being Felsic and showing disseminated Sulphides. Moving easterly just past the #1 Post some 10^m approx I stripped an area again showing the Felsic Volcanics with

some disseminated Sulphides. At this site⁵ I could see the Huronian so I dug three pits, the visual distance

between the Keewatin on the North to the Huronian on the South is 9^m. one pit is at the Keewatin Volcanics the other is at the Huronian and the third one is halfway between.

In the center pit I broke off a piece but again it was difficult to determine exactly what type as the Huronian is made up of the underlying Keewatin. I brought a sample back and took it to the Resident Geologists Office, however the staff was out on assignments, however a member of the office staff had it put under the Microscope for me, and it is obviously either at the contact or very close to it, I could not definitely determine which. As there was mineralization I took a sample from the center pit and another from the ledge at the Keewatin. I then moved further East where I stripped an area, at this Site #6 there is the felsic Volcanics with considerable quartz but little or no sign of Sulphides. On going Southerly uphill a little East of Site #6 I found where the Huronian was resting on the Felsic Volcanics on the edge of the cliff, there is approximately 4.5^m of Huronian sediments (Conglomerate) on top of the Keewatin, the strike of the cliff at this site is an azimuth of 60°, this is site #7. Going back downhill, northerly I stripped near the base of the hill at site #8 showing felsic Volcanics no apparent mineralization, moving 25^m or so Northwesterly I stripped a ledge of mafic Volcanics with quartz veins showing some pyrites I sampled this for a Gold Assay. The three samples referred to, have been delivered to the Swastika Laboratories

as they were delivered on Fri. Oct. 7/94 the results are not available in time for this report and they will be included in a future report, the numbers of these assays for reference purposes, are #15725 - #15726 and #15727.

Sample #15725 was taken at site #9 which is in the bottom of a topographical depression which after some reconnaissance appears to be a fault, I will know more later this month around Oct. 26/94 when the Resident Geologist Mr. Jim Ireland, along with O. P. A. P. staff will be making an examination of the area referred to in this report.

Sketch Showing Contiguous Claims:

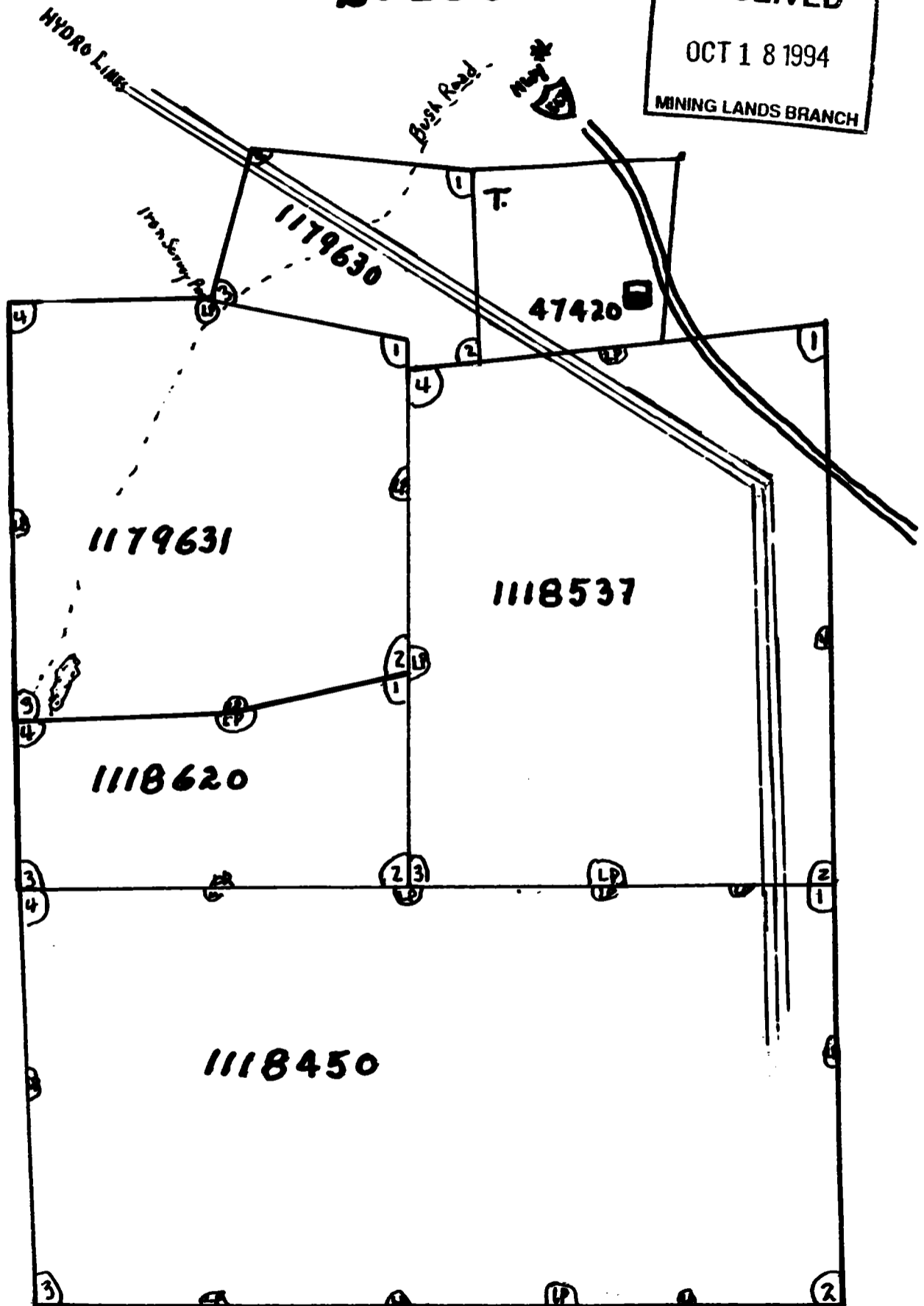
