Drill Hole No. 4-B (Continuation of 4 & 4-A).

347 -360.5	Greywacke, well bedded, bedding at 50 degrees.
360.5-365.5	Ditto, but broken core.
365.5-404	Greywacke, dark gray with bedding at 45-50 deg.
404 -420	Greywacke, paler and with less bedding than above.
420 -428.2	Ditto, but has a few threads of quartz-carbonate vein matter, both parallel to and diagonal to the bedding. Veinlets are mineralized with pyrite plus a little
428.2	chalcopyrite. Bedding angle changes to 40 deg.
428.2-456	Greywacke, massive and less fractured than above; very little veining; small veinlet at 443.5 shows pyrite and chalcopyrite.
109	End of hole.

Note

The hole was drilled in the period of January-April, 1955. The total footage is 109' and the core diameter is 7/8".
