## INTRODUCTION

In the fall of 1994, Transpacific Resources Inc. conducted a program of mechanical stripping of overburden on their large property in McGarry Twp., Kirkland Lake area, Ontario.

The stripping was performed on a zone of gold mineralization previously outlined by diamond drilling.

The mineralized zone was incompletely but adequately exposed. Freezing conditions prevented the washing of the exposed rock surface to permit detailed mapping and sampling. As a result, the balance of the program is being deferred until the spring of 1995, after temperatures have warmed enough to allow its efficient completion.

LOCATION AND ACCESS

The McGarry Project of Transpacific Resources Inc. is situated in the northwest quarter of McGarry Twp., Larder Lake Mining Division, Ontario. The community of Virginiatown is located approximately 2 kilometers to the south.

The property is easily reached by old pulp haulage roads leading north from Virginiatown and Kearns on Highway 66. These roads provide convenient access to the northern and eastern portions of the property. The southern portion of the property can be reached by foot along the Ontario Northland right-of-way.

PROPERTY

The McGarry property consists of Mining Lease CLM 298 and mining claims L 1193121, L 1193122, L 1193123, L 1202670, and L 1202672. All of the mining claims except L 1202670 are contiguous to the Mining Lease.

STRIPPING PROGRAM

The overburden was stripped with a Link Belt excavator, C Series II, model LS2800. This unit has a bucket size of 1 yd<sup>3</sup>. It was contracted from Wayne Phippen Construction Ltd. of King Kirkland, and operated by Wayne Phippen. Field supervision was provided by E. A. Gallo. A total of approximately 40 hours were spent stripping overburden, on November 5, 6, 12, and 13, 1994.

The hourly rate for the excavator together with the operator was \$100., including fuel and oil.

A total area of approximately 0.17 hectare was exposed. Overburden thickness ranged from 0-3 meters. Approximately 1,200 m<sup>3</sup> of material was removed.

A thin film of soil debris was left sitting on top of the exposed rock surface. It was intended to remove this film by washing with water, however freezing conditions prevented this from being done. The washing will be undertaken in the spring of 1995, after the weather has warmed enough to allow it.


Because the rocks were not cleanly exposed only a cursory examination was performed. Archean andesites and basalts are the predominant rock types, with lesser amounts of Temiskaming type sediments. The contact of the volcanics and the sediments is sheared and altered, and intruded by syenite bodies. The alteration consists of both silicification and carbonatization, and carries 1-2% disseminated pyrite and variable amounts of gold. The mineralization appears to occur mainly in the sediments and syenite intrusives, but also occurs to a lesser extent in the volcanics.

#### SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS

A program of overburden stripping was undertaken on the McGarry Property of Transpacific Resources Inc. A zone of gold mineralization was exposed, and found to occur mainly in sediments and syenite intrusives at the contact of the sediments with volcanics. Freezing weather conditions prevented the removal by washing of a thin film of debris from the exposed rock surface, and therefore detailed mapping and sampling of the zone has been deferred to the spring of 1995.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

The stripped area should be washed of debris to permit detailed geological mapping and sampling of the mineralized zone. This work should be undertaken in the spring of 1995 after temperatures have warmed to above freezing.

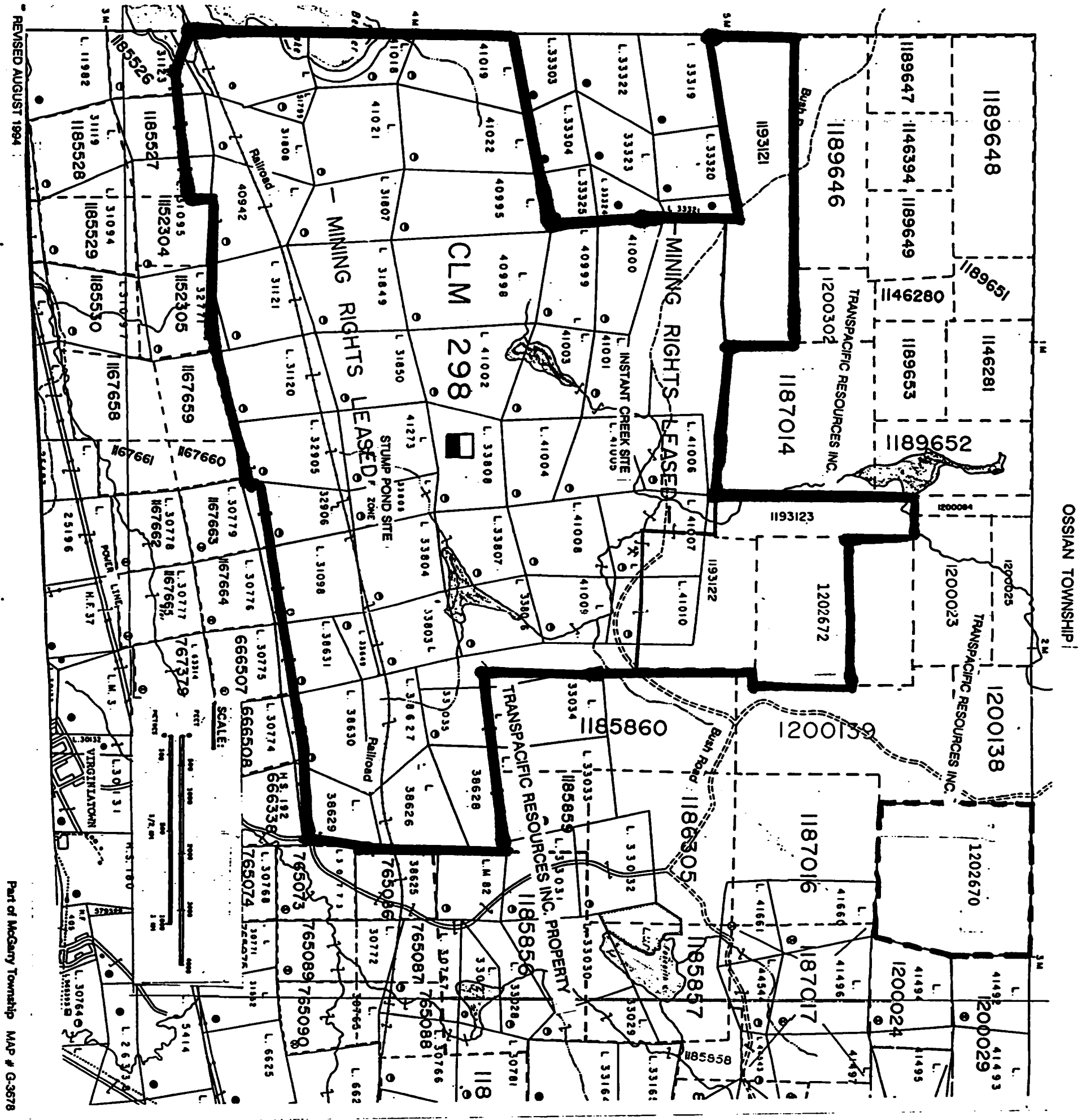

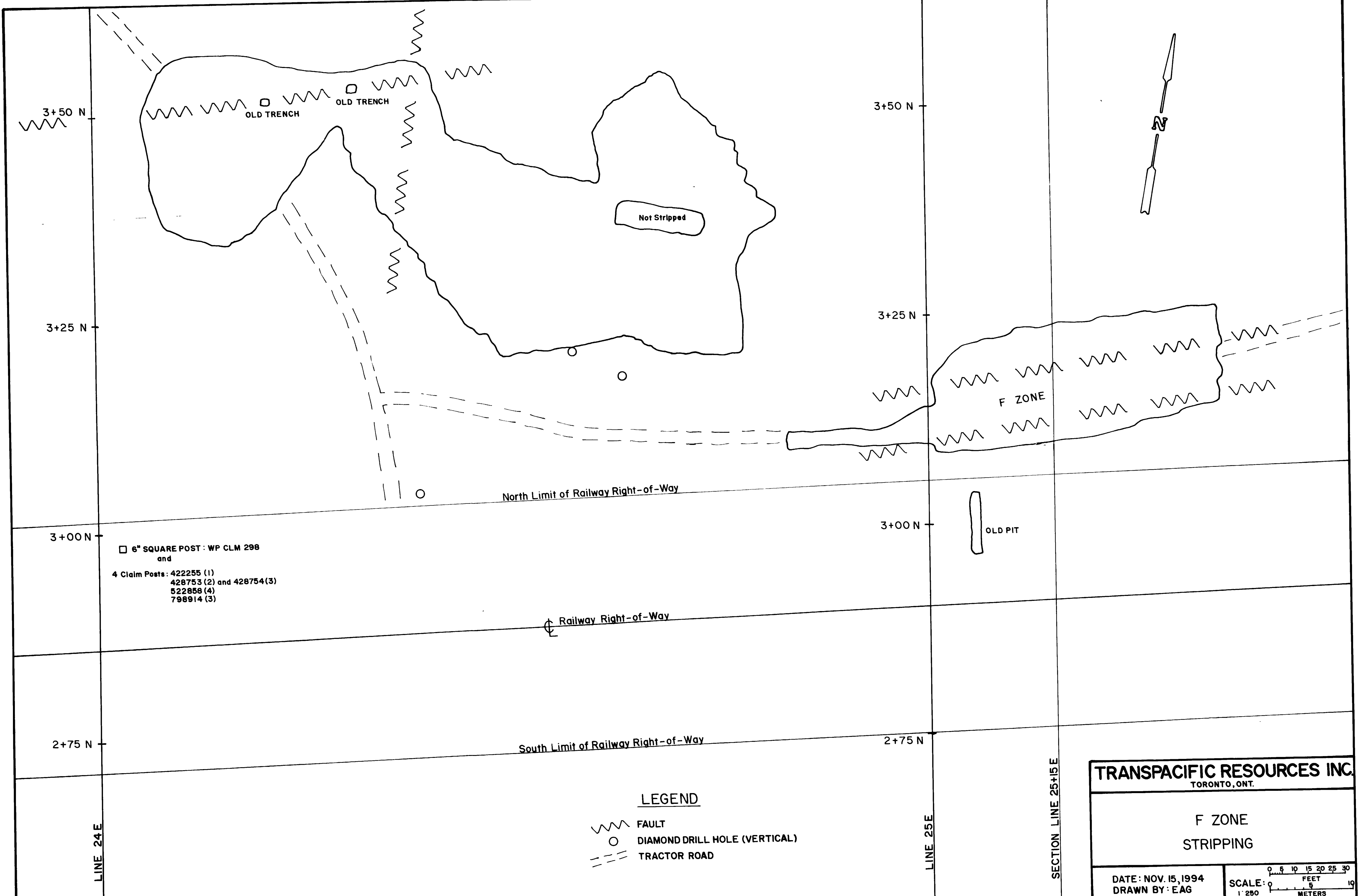
