

Report on L 532643, 532644, 531315, 532642,

544536, 544537, 531319, and 531317

In recent years this ground has remained open, although some
35 years ago fairly extensive prospecting had been carried out by
former stakers. The old work comprised trenching and test pits
mainly on Claims 532642 and 531319 where a vein was located in S.E.
corner of 531319 and is shown on Ontario Department of Mines map
No. 53a (accompanying Bulletin No. 150). This map was prepared for
Dept. of Mines Annual Report 1944, and published some years later.

It will be noted that an improved bush road is shown on the Lebel Twp. M.N.R. claims map. This improved road is shown as running from Hwy. 66 northerly to N. E. corner of Claim L 7798 (approx. 7/8 of a mile). Since then, this road has been improved by the present Quarry Pit operator for a further mile and now extends to claim 531317.

Access to and equipment float transportation of the portable mechanical equipment used in this assessment work was by means of this road where it was off loaded at North end (Mining Claim - 531315) and then proceeded underits own power to L532642 where the work was performed in Sept. - Oct. 1980.

This work comprised stripping, drilling and blasting fifteen 2½" holes each 15 feet deep in the rock outcroping showing gossan and quartz veins -- see sketch map attached. Examination of blasted samples secured from below surface and inspection of the rock wall was carried out. A sample was assayed for gold and silver but the result was negative. Further work is planned on all eight claims this spring and summer.
