Thanking you for the corrections on our assessment work reported, as per your letter of October 3rd./74.

As discussed at your office on September 30th./74, I am submitting the surface power stripping dozer work done on zone #2 of the pegmatites. As I explained then, this work was recommended by our consultant (Mr. R. Guillet) for two reasons; to eliminate unnecessary diamond drilling costs and to determine the zoning of the pegmatites. Once the pegmatites were exposed the rock blast trenching would be sampled and assayed for possible ore values.

We first used a TD-5 crawler-dozer to strip the light overburden and boulders from the rock ledge but found this terrain rendered the steel tracks useless in no time. We then replaced the crawler-dozer with a rubber-tired blade diesel machine that has a cost (used) of \$ 9,000.00 and an hourly rental charge of \$ 15.00 per hour. Being that we purchased the machine we have allowed a cost charge of \$ 10.00 per hour to cover wage and other operating expenses for this work.

The work done revealed that this zone(#2) is severely zoned and the none Feldspar and Spodumene sections do contain white mica (phlogopite) which could render this zone commercial.



The chemical analysis from the blast trenching samples indicate that unless we can recover this mica without the aid of reagents this zone would not be economical to mine.

We are now having mill tests done for specific gravity (dry) separation methods to economically produce this marketable mica. We are informed that this type of mica is now being imported into Canada by the paint and electrical industry. We are hopeful of becoming a supplier of this product.


