S1197397, LOCATED IN THE SUDBURY MINING DIVISION RECEIVED
PERMISSION FROM O.M.N.D.M. ON NOVEMBER 8, 95 FOR ENVIRONMENTAL
CLEAN UP AND THE REMOVAL OF A 14,500 M.T. OF MINERALIZED ROCK AS
A BULK SAMPLE.

PRIOR TO COMMENCEMENT OF WORK ON THE BULK SAMPLE PROJECT D. & H. CONSULTING SERVICES INC. DESIGNATED CONTRACTOR SOUTHBAY DESIGN & CONSTRUCTION LTD. TOGETHER WITH REPRESENTATIVES OF O.M.N.D.M. VISITED THE PROJECT SITE TO DETERMINE THE LOCATIONS FOR THE BULK SAMPLE AND TO COLLECT WATER SAMPLES FOR ANALYSIS.

SUBSEQUENT TO THIS AND BEFORE WORK ON THE BULK SAMPLE COMMENCED SOUTHBAY DESIGN ON BEHALF OF D. & H. CONSULTING COLLECTED, PACKAGED AND DELIVERED TO FALCONBRIDGE FOR CHEMICAL ANALYSIS ROCK FROM THE PROPERTY. (RESULTS ATTACHED)

SOUTHBAY 'S BULK SAMPLE WORK WAS CARRIED OUT BETWEEN MAY 31, 95 AND JULY 28, 95. DURING THIS PERIOD A TOTAL OF FIFTEEN DAYS WERE SPENT ON ENVIRONMENTAL CLEANUP. THE FIFTEEN DAYS SPENT ON ENVIRONMENTAL CLEANUP ARE NOT LISTED FOR ASSESSMENT WORK CREDIT.

## **LOCATION & ACCESS (** SEE ATTACHED MAP )

THE PROPERTY IS LOCATED ON THE NORTH SHORE OF AGNEW LAKE. IT IS REACHED BY TRAVELING WEST ON HWY. # 17 FROM SUDBURY TO THE VILLAGE OF MC KERROW, A DISTANCE OF 42 MILES, THENCE NORTH, NORTH EAST ON HARDWOOD ROAD FOR A DISTANCE OF SOME THREE MILES TO THE LAKE LANDING, THEN BY BOAT/BARGE FOR A DISTANCE OF APPROXIMATELY 700 FT..

### **BULK SAMPLE PROJECT / BACK GROUND**

WORK WAS CARRIED OUT FOR A TOTAL OF FORTY ONE DAYS BETWEEN MAY 29, 95 AND JULY 27, 95.

SOUTH BAY DESIGN & CONSTRUCTION LTD. WAS DESIGNATED BY D. & H. CONSULTING INC. TO CARRY OUT THE TOTAL PROGRAM.

FROM 1969 TO 1970 THE FORMER SPANISH RIVER MINES LTD. REMOVED 146.316 TONS OF ORE FROM ITS WORKINGS ON THE PROPERTY. THE AREA WAS LEFT WITH WASTE ROCK, ORE, STEEL, TIN, OLD VEHICLES, PIPES AND OTHER DEBRIS SCATTERED OVER THE ENTIRE WORK SITE. TO DATE SOME NINETY PERCENT OF THE DEBRIS IS CLEARED AND REMOVED FROM THE PROPERTY. STRIPPING BED ROCK TRENCHING WAS CARRIED OUT BY A CREW OF SIX WORKING WITH A 2.5 YD. AND A 8 YD. LOADERS. SLEDGES. ROCK HAMMERS AND WHEEL BARROWS, COBBED SELECT AND STOCKPILED MINERALIZED ROCKS FOR THE BULK SAMPLE. AS WALLS AROUND AN EXCAVATED AREA LEFT OPEN BY SPANISH RIVER MINES WERE STEEP AND DANGEROUS TO WORK AROUND A ROCK TRENCH 40 FT. X 60 FT. X 30 FT. DEEP WAS ESTABLISHED (LAYOUT, DRILLED, BLASTED AND MUCKED SKETCH # 4 ) FOR ACCESS TO MINERALIZED ROCKS IN AND AROUND THE OLD EXCAVATED AREA. ONCE BROKEN COBBED AND PILED, THE BULK SAMPLE PRODUCT WAS APPROVED AND LOADED FOR DELIVERY TO THE MAIN STOCK PILE AREA. FROM THIS AREA THE PRODUCT WAS LOADED ON TO 20 TON TRUCKS THAN ONTO A BARGE FOR DELIVERY TO THE MAIN LOADOUT STOCKPILE ESTABLISHED ON THE MAINLAND. THIS MAINLAND STOCKPILE AREA 75 FT. X 75 FT. WAS CLEARED AND COVERED WITH GEOTEXTILE FABRIC TO AVOID CONTAMINATION.

### MINERALIZATION OF BULK SAMPLE PRODUCT

CHALCOPYRITE PYRITES AND PYRRHOTITE OCCURS AS MASSIVE BLEBS, STRINGERS AND DISSEMINATED IN SILICIFIED QUARTZ AND IN GREYWACKE AND CONGLOMERATE. TOTAL SULFIDES CONTENT RANGES FROM 60 - 20 PERCENT.

### **SURVEYING**

A TRANSIT WAS USED TO LAYOUT THE BOUNDARY FOR THE TRENCH AREA; WHILE A DUMPY LEVEL AND STADIA ROD WERE USED TO ESTABLISH LEVELS AROUND THE OLD EXCAVATED AREA.

A TOTAL OF SOME 200 TONS OF BULK SAMPLE MATERIAL WAS DELIVERED TO MAIN LOADOUT STOCKPILE AREA WHILE SOME 5,000 TONNES COBBED AND UNCOBBED REMAIN AT THE PROJECT SITE. THE RATIO OF MINERALIZED ROCK SUITABLE AS BULK SAMPLE PRODUCT, TO WASTE ROCK WAS DETERMINED TO BE IN THE ORDER OF 1-20. WORK WAS SUSPENDED ON JULY 25, 95 TO BE CONTINUED AT A LATER DATE.




