Introduction:

This report covers prospecting work carried out on the Fortune Lake Gold Property located in Davis Township Sudbury Mining Division, Ontario. The principle purpose of this work was to maintain the prospect in good standing. A total of 16 samples were taken during the course of the visit to the property. Of these, 7 were submitted to be assayed for gold. Originally, a more comprehensive work program was planned for this summer. However, owing to a 200- foot section of road being flooded by a beaver dam, the comprehensiveness of the program had to be modified. Prospecting was carried out on one day, August 13th 2003.

Property, Location and Access:

NTS map 41-I/9 Latitude 46 41'N Longitude 80 34'W

Claims 1140885, 3010714, 3010715 are located in N.W. Davis Twp. G-3182 near the Scadding/Davis Township boundary approximately 25 air miles northeast of the city of Sudbury.

Access to the property is by Highway #535 departing north from the Trans Canada Highway (Highway #17) approximately 50 kilometers east of Sudbury, at the village of Hagar. Some 23 kilometers north of the village of Hagar, the road crosses the Kabikotitwia River at Washagami. At this point, travel is in a northwest direction for some 7.1 kilometers, then branching left onto an old logging road for a further 4.6 kilometers, again branching left approximately 2 kilometers to the property.


Property Description:


The Fortune Lake Gold Property consists of three claims numbered 1140885, 3010714, and 3010715, approximately 80 ha.

1140885 staked: June 4, 1998, recorded June 5th, 1998. 3010714 staked: November 23, 2002, recorded December 20, 2002. 3010715 staked: November 23, 2002, recorded December 17, 2002.


Prospecting Targets:

- 1. Old trenches, test-pits and shafts
- 2. Zone of gold-bearing quartz veins
- 3. Recovery of old drill core

Flooded Roadway:

On Tuesday, August 12, 2003, while driving to the Fortune Lake Gold Property, the truck was passed by an ATV. About a kilometer ahead the journey was abruptly terminated by a 200 foot section of road having been flooded by a large beaver dam. The ATV, by this time, had already crossed the water and was stopped on the other side. I called over and asked the driver the depth of the water. He estimated it to be 3 feet deep. The fact that we were driving a new rented 4-wheel drive truck factored into the decision to not attempt crossing the water by this means. It was thought the risk of becoming stuck or perhaps damaging the vehicle was too great. The ATV driver crossed back to where we were standing. I explained to him where I wanted to go and what I was planning to do. He asked if I would be prepared to pay him for transportation by his ATV to the property. A financial arrangement was reached.

General Geology:

The geology of the Wanapitei Lake Gold Area has been described in Ontario Department of Mines publications dated 1932 and 1983 as well as in an Ontario Geological Survey report dated 1982.

The rocks of the Wanapitei area were formed during the Early, Middle and Late Precambrian period. The eastern part of the area (Davis Twp.) is underlain mainly by sedimentary rocks of the Huronian Age Supergroup and by Nipissing Gabbro. The rocks of the Huronian Supergroup were deposited in the Middle Precambrian period after the Early Precambrian felsic plutonic rocks and before the Nipissing intrusive. A large part of Davis Township and adjacent parts of Scadding Township located to the west are underlain by Cobalt Group sediments which formed the upper part of the Huronian Supergroup. The Fortune Lake Gold Property is underlain by unlaminated, wacke conglomerates argillite with minor interbedded quartzite of the Gowganda Formation which is the basal formation of the Cobalt Group.

Claim Geology:

The claim is located along a gentle slope on the north side of Fortune Lake in an area of drift cover with outcrop exposures of only about 5-10 %. The host rock is Gowganda Formation (greywacke, siltstone, laminated siltstone and possible arkose). Irregular narrow quartz veins which strike the 330 and dip 50 SW were observed to carry free gold.

From report, Gates, B. I. 1991 Sudbury Mineral Occurrence Study, Ontario Geological Survey, Open File Report 5771 235p (Fortune Lake Property page 150). Gates goes on to say that erratic gold-bearing quartz veins are located within strongly potassium-altered siltstones. Gold-bearing quartz veins are also located within an altered grey arkosic-quartzite and cutting Sudbury-type breccia. Ankerite rhombs were seen within Sudbury Breccia and within the Gowganda Formation.

Prospecting:

On Wednesday, August 13, 2003, we arrived by ATV at the property at 8:30 AM. As this was the first visit to the claims by the owner, G. Jackson, it was decided to visit the main showing (shaft area) on Claim 1140885. The most easterly shaft (#2) is 100 feet deep and was sunk to test the gold-bearing quartz structure originally discovered in the late 1800's. There is a large muck pile located here and 4 grab samples were obtained. Trench #2 is located next to the main shaft. It is 44 metres long and is overgrown at this time. Host of the veins in Trench #2 is massive to thick- bedded greywacke. The greywackes are fresh except in the vicinity of some of the veins where minor sulphide and silica introduction occurs. Four samples were taken in a section of 6 gold-bearing quartz veins being the main vein system. Pelangio Larder Mines Limited did a VLF-EM survey on what is now Claim #1140885 and reported finding 2 drill collars of unknown age 100 and 200 feet southwest of the #1 shaft. No records of these holes and/or the results obtained appear to exist. This drill core was located and examined. Some was discovered on surface but the majority was found buried. Five pieces were kept for analysis.

The second half of the day was spent on Claim #3010714 systematically run traverses were made to locate any old test-pits or trenches or areas that might indicate past prospecting and/or development activity. Old records state that the vein system has been traced and exposed through trenching across the boundary lines on the adjoining west and east claims. Today this represents Claim #3010714 to the west and Claim #3010715 to the east. The claims were staked in November of 2002 to cover the extension of the gold-bearing quartz vein system along the strike. The north portion of this claim was prospected, exposure of outcrops is very limited, perhaps less than 5%. Only 1 old trench was located and 3 samples were taken at this site.

Prospecting Daily Log:

Claim# 1140885 Davis Township

Date: Wednesday August 13, 2003.

Started the day at #1 claimpost, followed claim-line south to old trail which leads to #2 shaft area and muck pile. Four grab samples were obtained at this location. Adjacent to shaft area is Trench #2. Four samples were taken from the main vein system found here. Following an old trail which is covered by large fern growth, the drill core was found. Some of the drill core was located on surface but it was necessary to dig for 80% which was recovered. It is likely that some drill core is still to be found in the area. The core was stored safely to be recovered at another time.

Claim #3010714 Davis Township

Date: Wednesday August 13, 2003.

The second half of the day was spent on the north portion of this claim. The purpose of this work was to locate old test-pits or trenches. Traverses were run (east – west). Only one trench was located. Three rock samples were taken from Gowganda Fm.

Rock and Drill Core Sampling:

Sample Descriptions
Sample Number

#1 grab- dump site Greywacke - Gowganda Fm. Quartz vein 2% pyrite.

#2 grab- dump site dirty gray quartz vein material 4-5% pyrite.

* #3 grab – dump site white and gray quartz material stain carbonate 1% pyrite.

#4 grab- dump site greywacke - Gowganda Fm. Sheared staining 1% pyrite.

* #5 chip – trench #2 white to gray quartz vein material some stain 3-4% pyrite.

#6 chip – trench #2 smoky quartz vein material 2-3% pyrite.

* #7 chip – trench #2 vein material white-gray quartz carbonate with staining 2% pyrite.

#8 chip - trench #2 greywacke Gowganda Fm. Mostly white-gray quartz 5% pyrite.

#9 drill core – 5 inches – greywacke relatively unaltered with trace pyrite.

* #10 drill core – 3.5 inches greywacke dark stain chlorite with trace pyrite.

* #11 drill core – 4 inches gray unaltered banded fine-grained greywacke chlorite hematite trace pyrite.

#12 drill core – 4 inches greywacke medium gray chlorite alteration.

#13 drill core – 3 inches greywacke unaltered fine-grained some chlorite tr. pyrite.

- * #14 chip trench 714 Gowganda Fm. off white gray quartzite fine-grained clastics some breccia.
- * #15 chip trench 714 Gowganda Fm. white gray quartzite minor breccia.

#16 chip- trench 714 Gowganda Fm. dark gray – black quartz vein clasts, breccia.

* Sample #'s 3,5,7,10,11,14, 15 were sent for gold analysis August 14, 2003.

Summary and Conclusions:

Originally a more comprehensive work program of establishing a grid and a geochemical survey (soil sampling) was envisioned for this summer. The 200 foot section of flooded roadway 6.5 kilometers from the property compromised the plan in terms of cost but more importantly, in safety. In November 2002, claims were staked on the east and west sides of Claim #1140885 (Fortune Lake Property). Old records indicate tracing the main vein system on what is now Claim #3010714 a sample from a trench assayed over 1 oz./ton. Prospecting and sampling was carried out on Wednesday, August 13, 2003 to maintain the prospect in good standing and to locate the target quartz vein system. The overall objective was to determine the extent and grade of the gold bearing quartz veins. Past work on the property has shown it to be highly prospective for the discovery of economic gold deposits. With the addition of the two new claims, a priority for all future work is a proper control grid to be established on the entire property so that all of the past exploration can be accurately located and interpreted collectively. An inquiry to the Ministry of Natural Resources will be made to reach a solution in dealing with the flooded portion of the road which prevents easy access to the property.






