

SUMMARY AND CONCLUSION

The SUDBERY NORTHRIM EXPLORATION COMPANY LIMITED holds 231 Claims (approximately 9,240 acres) in various blocks along the vest end and the north sides of the central part of the Sudbury Basin area. These groups of Claims are located to cover the slate-tuff contact in a similar manner to those properties on the south contact which contain lead-zinc-copper ore adjacent to this same contact. Similar structural conditions also appear to be present near this contact on both the north and the south sides of the central basin area. Mineralization like that on the south side is reported from mineral showings on the north side. Consequently, on the basis of similar rocks, similar structural conditions in part, and seemingly similar mineralization, a program is desirable for the exploration and evaluation of the extensive holdings of the Sudbury Northrim Exploration Co. Ltd.

The exploration program suggested would be one of geological mapping on such a scale, along with some prospecting, as to give information on where detailed work right be done to advantage. Such detailed work would take form of trenching, drilling where indicated by other results, and the usual sampling of snowings known or which might be located.

PROPERTY AND OWNERSHIP

LOCATION AND ACCESS

The Claims held by Sudbury Northrim Exploration Company Limited are located in the central portion of the Sudbury Basin area in Harmer, Lumsden, Morgan, Fairbunk and Trill Townships. The largest block of contiguous Claims stretches across Lumsden Twp. and part of Harmer Twp. Other blocks are in Harmer Twp. to the north and east of the large block. Some ground is located in Fairbank and Trill Twps., west of Ontario Pyrites Ltd. (Sudbury Hasin) holdings. These blocks cover a portion of the slate-tuff contact on the western part of the basin.

LOCATION AND ACCESS (cont'd)

In general the central Sudbury basin area is well serviced by secondary roads, off the main Sudbury-Cartier highway which crosses the central part of the basin, as does the main line of the C. P. R. Sudbury is the commercial centre for the district, and adequate power is available, should it be required.

GEOLOGY

The Sudbury Northrim Exploration Company Limited holdings were acquired, in part, on the basis of their location in relation to the Omaping Formation (agglomerate and tuffs) - Omwatin Formation (slate) contact. In Creighton and Fairbanks Townships, on the south side of the Sudbury Basin, lead-zinc-copper ore was found near this contact under certain structural conditions, on what is now Ontario Pyrites Ltd. ground. The details of reasons are not fully determined as yet as to why the localization, near this contact, of ore found to date. This contact is variably folded and crenulated as a result of regional and local stresses related to thrust faulting from the south-west in the basin area.

There are carbonate rich beds or bands in many places near the slate-tuff contact, and widespread introduced mineralization of a quartz-carbonate type with some local accompanying pyrite, pyrrhotite, chalcopyrite, sphalerite, and galena. A number of these showings require re-evaluation and further exploration. It is not unreasonable to expect that similar ore conditions to those on the south rim area, as at Ontario Pyrites Ltd., may be encountered under similar geological and mineralized conditions on the north and west sides of the basin.

EXPLORATION

Exploration has been done in the past on showings on some of the more accessible claims and where concerned with good exposures. Changed base metal economics related to prices and metallurgy indicate a new evaluation is merited. More recent information on the geology of the area, and specifically with possible reasons for localization of lead-zinc-copper sulphides values, also suggests renewed exploration is required.

The program of exploration recommended would be:

- (a) Preparation of adequate geological and other maps for direction of later work.
- (b) Evaluation of known showings.
- (c) Prospecting, trenching, and sumpling as indicated by stages (a) and (b).
- (d) Diamond drilling as required.

REASONS FOR WORK RECOMMENDED

There is attached, as an appendix to this report, a review of the Holdings, group by group, with comments.

It is relevant to note here that the contact of the Onaping "Tuffs" and the Onwatin "Slates" on its southern boundary, under certain conditions, has shown itself favorable to the deposition of Lead and Zino mineralization.

To date, however, no values have been found at the contact on the north side of the Basin, possibly due to topographic features.

Some exploratory diamond drilling, however, is justified on groups that straddle this contact, in areas that show some change in strike (buckle) or where the contact is out by a known shearing.


