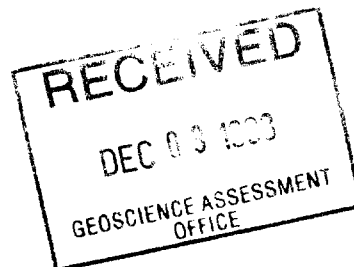

ASSESSMENT WORK--HUTTON TWP.

Work was performed in the southern portion of claim S1179574 in Hutton Twp. The work site is located approximately 50m north and 60 m. west of the #4 post of claim S1179575 which is also the location of a line post for claim S 1179574.

An area 30 m x 20m was brushed and stripped. Two existing pits were drilled and blasted and trenches were enlarged to sizes of 11m x 8m (Pit B) and 9m x 5m (Pit A). A third existing pit was further stripped and cleaned. Samples were taken.

GEOLOGY:

The property is underlain by massive mafic metavolcanic rocks (pillow basalts), poorly banded mafic to intermediate metavolcanic rocks, small pods of rhyolite breccia, and felsic pyroclastic rocks. These units are in contact with pink Algoman granites to the south. The metavolcanic units have been intruded by two fairly small diabase dykes. In previous diamond drilling, iron formation has been encountered.

Massive and strongly disseminated sulphides are present within the metavolcanic rocks at surface. Common sulphide minerals are pyrite, galena and sphalerite.

The property is immediately south of the formerly producing Moose Mountain iron mine. The mine hosted a sulphide horizon that contained appreciable zinc with some lead. This property is most likely a continuation of that same sulphide horizon. 1
