Reconnaissance Report
Temagami Area

February 15th, 1956.

Examined the 17 claim group owned by E. <u>Parozanin</u> of Temagami. These claims are situated on the southern boundary of Briggs Twp. and runs from Amphibolite Bay to the west boundary of Briggs and Yates. They run into the northwest corner of Yates down to Shiningwood Bay.

Access to the claims by way of motor road over the ice from Temagami.

Heavy snow covered the area and very few outcrops could be seen. One small quarts carbonate veinlet about 6 inches wide carried sparse sulphides. Strike of vein N. 85° W. Dip 25° N. This vein cut massive andesite.

The rocks covered by these claims are essentially Keewatins. Temagami Mining ore bodies are found on or in close proximity to the Keewatin acid-basic volcanic contact. Portions of the claims examined contain a similar but reversed contact. Two drills are at work directly north of Mr. Parosanin's ground probing for the extension of the Temagami Island contact.

Another 5 claims owned by Mr. Parosanin lie on an island 2 miles northwest of Temagami Island. Three small quartz stringers were seen. All strike essentially Fast - . West. These veinlets were barren. Some shearing was evident along a 2.5 ft. bull quartz vein but little sulphides were exident.
