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### **REPORT ON PHYSICAL WORK**

GEOSCIENCE ASSESSMEN Gordon Salo Claim # S 1198473 on Meteor Lake in Beulah Township. OFFICE

#### **Digging Pits**

In an effort to confirm the presents of placer gold within the gravel deposits of Meteor lake it was necessary to excavate sample material from the reported mining location of the Onaping mining companies operations of 1899 to 1901.

### Nature of rocks and mineralization exposed

No bedrock was observed on the claim as the gold bearing deposit would appear to be a glacial Esker composed of sand, gravel and boulders within the center of Meteor lake running in a more or less southerly direction. The sample material was excavated from a large old trench on the south end of the Esker in the center of the lake. The sample pitting covered an area approximately 1 meter wide extending from the top ridge of the workings down its face and into the bottom for a distance of about 10 meters with depths of no more than .25 meters. It was found that only extremely fine gold particles visible only with a hand lens could be found in the finer sands on the top of the excavation. More abundant and larger gold particles were found at depth in the courser gravel and sand materials at the bottom of the excavation. The gravel and sand materials were screened, panned and sluiced on site. Black sand and gold concentrate were carefully examined on site and recovered for future microscopic study work.

#### Assays

No material was collected for assay purposes.




