## INTRODUCTION

Asquith Resources Inc., 907 - 110 Erskine Avenue, Toronto, Ontario M4P 1Y4 is the registered owner of some 72 contiguous claims located in east central Asquith Township, Shining Tree Area of Ontario. During the summer of 1990 several areas were prospected to locate old workings and gold showings, one of which is described in the following. The area under discussion is located east of the Buckingham Mine and work was designed to determine if an on strike extension or mineralization of similar character could be located.

## WORK CARRIED OUT

The writer, a geologist, accompanied by Roy Annett, a prospector, traversed claims 980040 and 979554 on August 3 and 4, 1990 and located a number of old pits and trenches. These were badly caved or filled with debris necessitating cleanout with grubhoes and shovels to permit examination of the vein structures and host rocks. Two of the areas are described in the following with assay results:

a) Claim 980040 - 29+00E, 20+00S "A" Grid.

A series of trenches follow a east-west striking 24" wide white quartz vein for approximately 80 feet. The vein is poorly mineralized and returned only trace Au value upon chip sample. Approximately 50 feet east of the trench a shallow ( $\pm 1$  foot) pit exposes green carbonate rich mafic volcanic rock, well sheared and injected with  $\frac{1}{4}$  -  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch blue-grey quartz veins. Intensity of shearing and style of veining is reminiscent of the Buckingham Mine Area. Samples 148832-33, 4 foot chips across the zone returned 300 ppb and 46 ppb Au suggesting elevated gold values in the shear.

b) Claim 979554 - 2+80E, 8+00N "C" Grid.

Grubhoe cleanout along a series of east-west striking trenches and pits, over a lateral distance of 100 feet, exposed a strong series of blue-grey quartz veins with highly sheared, heavily carbonated mafic volcanics. Pyrite and minor chalcopyrite are common accessory minerals. The best exposure was cleaned out of a shallow open cut at the east end of the structure at the edge of a swamp. The zone was exposed across ten feet and chip sampled results as follows:

This showing is a strong example of the type of shearing and veining that carries gold values in the area. The exposure enters deep overburden to the west and the swamp to the east. Stripping and washing of the occurrence are recommended.

#### CONCLUSION


Both showings are of interest and carry elevated gold values. As mentioned above the 979554 claim occurrence is the most promising with intense shearing, heavy carbonate alteration, strong veining and elevated gold values. Stripping, washing and channel sampling are warranted to better evaluate this showing.

The northerly showing on 980040 while close to being on strike with the Buckingham does not appear to be of sufficient strength to warrant further expenditure.

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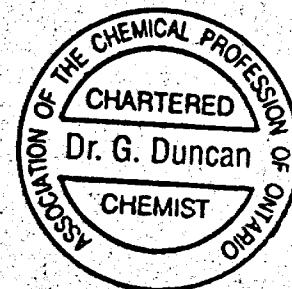

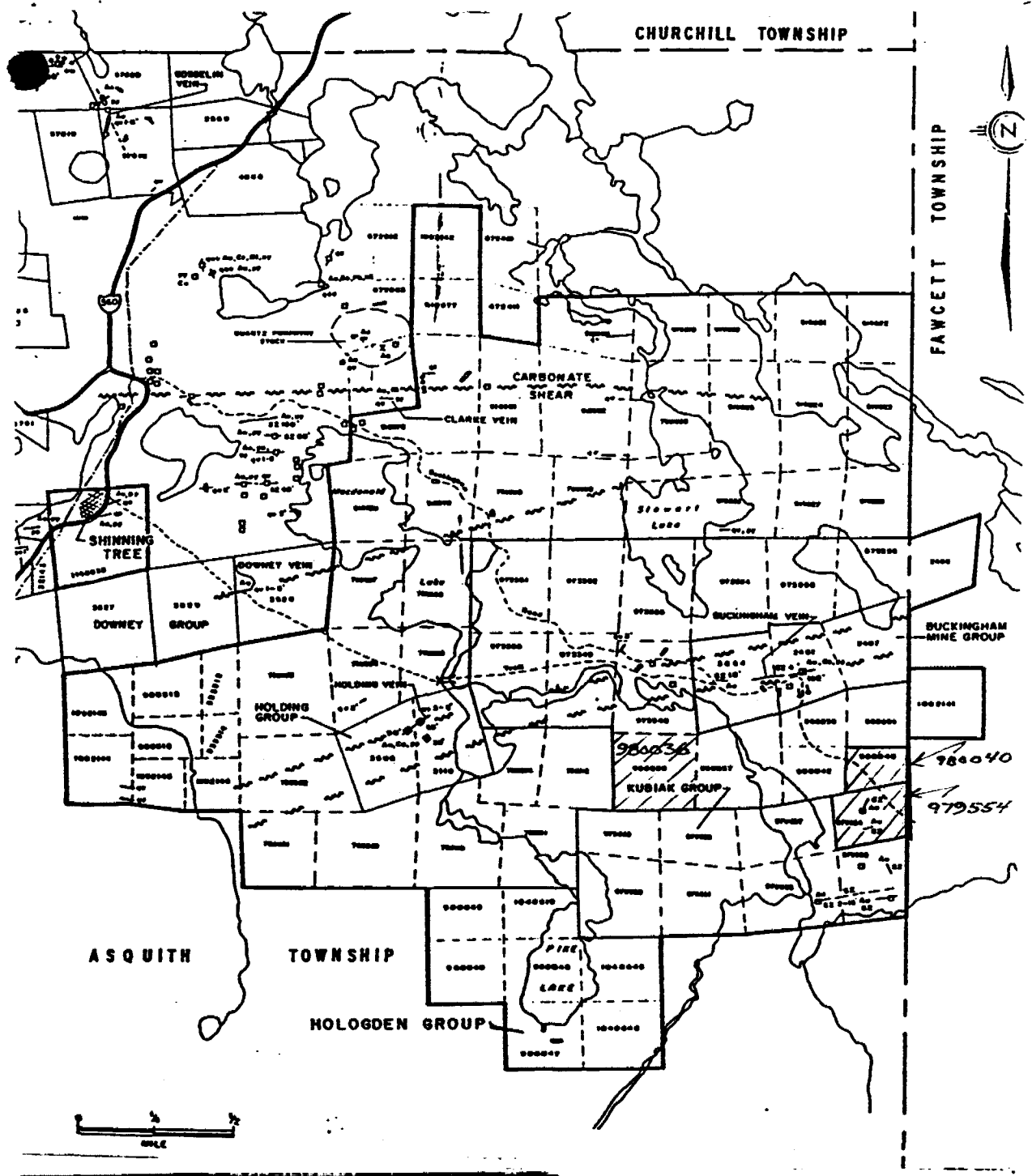

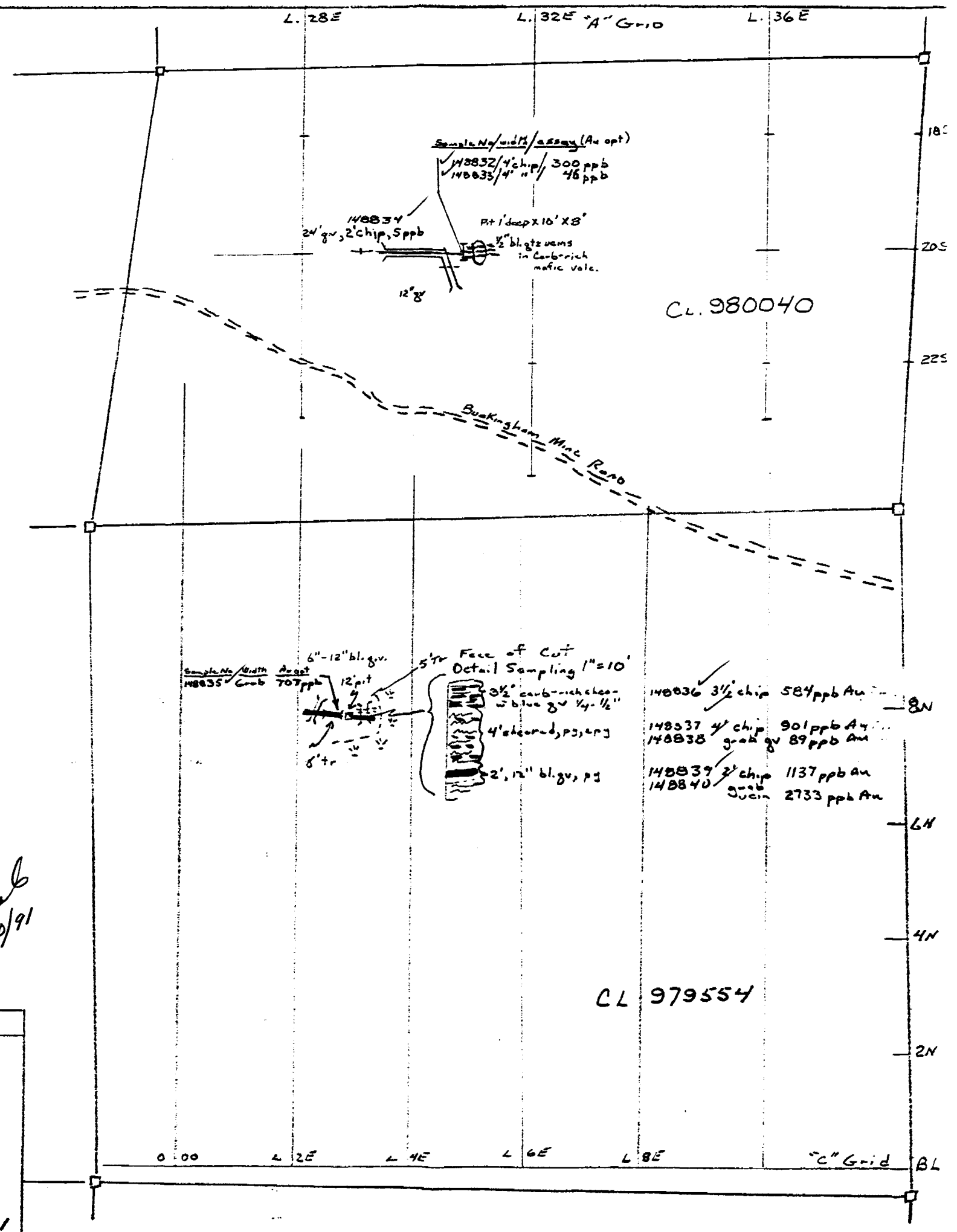
