
Please find enclosed a revised report of work form concerning our back-hoe, powerstripping program in Chester Township within your jurisdiction. Invoice #73 from Bobex Resources Inc. is included, along with Bobex's bid to do the services requested. The all inclusive rate of \$1,000.00 per day based on 10 hours per day including camp costs and float charges was the rate Blue Falcon Mines was billed. I have at your request asked Bobex for copies of all float charges and camp costs for this project so as to deduct them from the total billing. Please find enclosed a copy of an invoice dated October 17 at Camp C.G.M.. This invoice includes camp charges as well as use of a boat for the men to get to and from the work site, plus miscellaneous fuel charges and O.S.T. totalling \$1,104.36. It can be seen from this invoice that the cottage rate of \$25.00 per day applied to the men. They supplied their own food during this period the cost of which would have been included in the "all inclusive bid". I don't have access to the cost of this food, but I'll assume it was in the order of \$25.00 per day per man. The camp costs would therefore total \$75.00 per day equalling \$7.50 per hour, which should be deducted from the overall cost of the project.


I have also enclosed a copy of a portion of Chester Township indicating the point of origin of the powerstripping equipment, and the route taken to the work site and the work site location. The route taken consisted of roads and a surveyed township boundary to alleviate bushwacking with the equipment. The operator Vital Larche informed me that it took approximately 2 or 3 hours to get the equipment to the site and also to return it to the point of origin, totalling 6 hours. I don't believe Blue Falcon Mines was charged for this mobilization and demobilization time, but I'll deduct this 6 hours from the overall cost as well.

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Therefore out of a work program of 99.6 hours, Blue Falcon Mines is submitting 93.6 hours of equipment usage at the rate of \$100.00 per hour less the camp costs of \$7.50 per hour equalling 93.6 hours times \$32.50/hour totals \$3,658.00. Powerstripping work credits are calculated at a rate of 1 day for every \$10.00 spent, this totals 365.8 work day credits which we are applying for. I trust all is in order with respect to this report of work.
