5 -- 21.0	Conglomerate		Greyish to light green, coarse bedded, up to 1" occasional rusty fragments of magnetite, pyrite, No values.
21.0 -- 361.5	Conglomerate		Buff with pebbles from 1" to 1 1/2" diam. Occasional quartz stringers through section. Pebble size appears to be decreasing at depth. The pebbles appear to be mostly quartzite but have been greatly altered through silicification.
	Quartz	117.4 -- 117.6	Small shear vein with minor pyrite.
	Quartz	200.5 -- 200.9	White with rust contact, no mineralization, probably leach out, contact at 15° to 20° dip axis.
	Shear Zone	276.4 -- 278.6	Tight silicified mineralized shear with 1/8 dia. pyrite, with occasional minor stringer cutting this section, indicating an area of tight shearing through the conglomerate. Centre of shear consists of quartz which contains no mineralization.

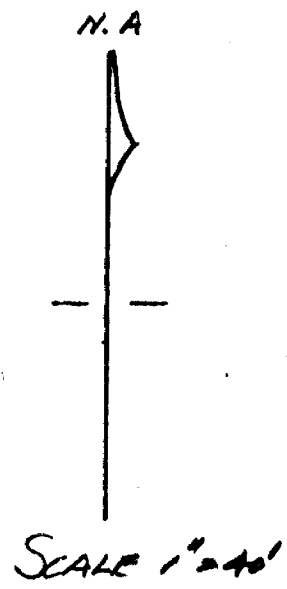

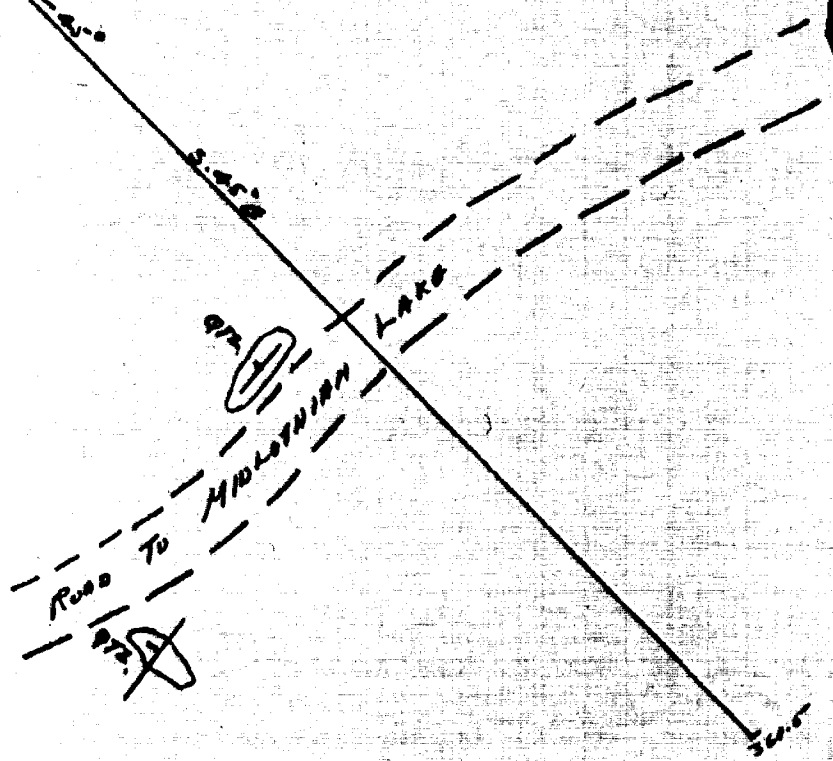
