

1.0 INTRODUCTION

Mining Claim 1202490 consisting of 4 contiguous units belonging to G. Kosy was investigated during 1996 as part of a joint venture between G. Kosy and Crowley Groundwater Limited. The claim group is situated in Cairo Township within the Larder Lake Mining Division. Figure 1 shows the location of the group.

Ian D. Wilson Associates Limited, consulting geologists, was retained by the joint venture to investigate the property along with Mr. H. Lovell, the retired Resident Geologist for the Larder Lake Mining Division, Kirkland Lake. The property was visited during June and again in September, 1996. Mr. D. Crowley of Crowley Groundwater Limited organized and co-ordinated the project. Figure 2 shows the claim group in relation to other claims in the area.

2.0 LOCATION AND ACCESS

The property is located north of Highway 66 approximately 3.3 kilometres northeast of the Matachewan Townsite. The property is reached via the road to the north to the Matachewan Indian Reservation No. 72 which leaves Highway 66 immediately east of the junction of Highways 65 and 66. A logging road leaves the road to the Indian Reserve approximately 0.6 km north of the intersection with Highway 66, crosses Whiskeyjack Creek and travels generally west to the claim group. The location of the access road is shown on Figure 1.

3.0 PREVIOUS WORK ON CLAIMS

In 1966 Midrim Mining Company Limited drilled eleven diamond drill holes based on geophysical and geochemical surveys for a total of 1143 metres (3,749 feet). It is understood that the prime target was copper and molybdenum. Bulldozing and trenching were undertaken as part of the exploration program.

During 1973 a Mr. R. Newman drilled two diamond drill holes for a combined length of 97 metres (317 feet) on the property. It is assumed that the targets were the same as those of Midrim Mining.

In April 1981 Minorex Limited carried out fluxgate magnetometer and VLF-EM surveys of the claims which resulted in a recommendation for the drilling of five diamond drill holes to investigate the central of three conductors located during the geophysical surveys. A total of six diamond drill holes (KL-HW-81-1 to KL-HW-81-6, inclusive) were drilled on the claims for a total of 598.6 metres (1964 feet). KL-HW-81-1 was drilled at an angle of minus 52° while KL-HW-81-2 & 3 were at minus 41.5° and KL-HW-81-4, 5 & 6 were at minus 42°.

No assays were available for drill hole KL-HW-81-1, however, the balance of the holes showed low gold values with some significant intersections assaying up to 1993 parts per billion (one 1.4cm quartz vein assayed 3112 ppb gold). Lead values were shown in drill hole KL-HW-81-5.

4.0 TOPOGRAPHY AND VEGETATION COVER

The 1202490 Group covers an area of dense secondary growth alders, evergreens, poplars and birch with the more accessible lands being the central sector of the group where the rock outcrops or is close to the landsurface. Muskeg surrounds the small lake towards the north end of the claim group.

The lands slope gently upwards from Webb Lake (320 metres above sea level) at the south to a central highland area at approximately 364m asl, then slopes downward to the small lake at the northend (340m asl) and westward to about the same elevation. The small northern lake is shown to drain to the north with a small creek joining the Whiskeyjack Creek system near the northern road to the Indian reservation.

Two predominant ridges of Matachewan age diabase dikes cross the property in a roughly north-south direction. The majority of the rock outcrop on the site occurs between the two diabase dikes.

5.0 GEOLOGIC SURVEY

5.1 General Geology:

Old mineral exploration trails, completely grown in, used by Midrim and Minorex in their exploration programs were cleared by hand over a distance of approximately 1.84 kilometres in order to gain access to the site and to clear vegetation for two exploration trenches and the rehabilitation of an old Midrim trench. A tractor-mounted backhoe was used to remove overburden

at the trench sites and to clear the old trench.

Ian D. Wilson, P.Eng. and Howard Lovell traversed the central and northwestern section of the claim group noting the geology and previous work (trenching and drilling) carried out by others. Mr. Lovell spent a day traversing the southern sectors of the claim group and an additional day in the eastern and northeastern sections. The following rock types were identified.

The above rocks have been described in detail in previous reports on the property and area and in reports by the Ontario Department of Mines.

5.2 Economic Geology:

A total of two trenches were excavated on site (see Figure 3 taken from the drawing by Minorex Limited) during September 1996; Trench 1 being 37.2m (122.2 ft.) in length while Trench 2 is 70.7m (232 ft.) in length. Trench 1 runs approximately north, northwest-south, southeast and Trench 2 runs about north-south. Both trenches were channel sampled using a diamond circular saw. An old Midrim trench (see Figure 3) was rehabilitated and "bulk" sampled over its 21.6-metre (71 ft.) length. The samples taken were entirely within the Timiskaming sediments and all samples showed sulphide (pyrite) mineralization. A detailed map showing the locations of the trenching (stripping) appears in the map pocket.

The trenches (stripping) were excavated by backhoe equipped with a one-foot bucket to the bedrock surface where rock samples were taken by diamond saw, \pm 8 ins. wide by \pm 2 ins. deep. The following information pertains to the new trenches and the old trench which existed prior to the current fieldwork. The old trench was cleared and bulk sampled. Trenches (stripping) 1 and 2 are the new trenches excavated in 1996.



A total of 51 samples were taken from Trenches 1 and 2. One bulk sample weighing 221 lbs. was taken from the old trench after it was cleared out. Four assays were undertaken by Swastika Laboratories on the bulk sample (see appendix).

Rock samples were taken at intervals shown on the Swastika Laboratories' assay sheet (report appendix), starting at the south ends of Trenches 1 and 2 and across the entire length of the old trench.

The sample lengths are shown on the accompanying drawing as follows and were measured from the south ends of the trenches.

The 100.2 kilogram (221 lbs) "bulk" sample showed 0.001 oz/ton gold and 0.001 oz/ton silver. Trench 1 showed varying values from no gold to 0.001 to 0.02 oz/ton. Trench 2 showed gold values of nil to 0.028 oz/ton. (over 0.12m - 0.4 ft., 69.98 to 70.10m - 229.6 to 230.0 ft.). An I.C.A.P. plasma scan of the "bulk" sample showed low concentrations of a number of elements but no potential economic minerals. Copies of the analyses undertaken by Swastika Laboratories appear in the appendix. Figures 4 and 5 show the assay results graphically for Trench 1, while Figures 6 and 7 show the results for Trench 2.


6.0 CONCLUSIONS

The Claim Group 1202490 shows sulphide mineralization (largely pyrite) throughout the sediments and within the syenite with copper, molybdenum, and to a lesser degree fluorite, occurring in quartz-carbonate veinlets.

Although no economic deposits have been found on the property to-date, the area is highly mineralized and with the Cairo syenite stock being present and the syenite porphyry mapped on the claim group, the chances of economic mineralization exist. The drilling by Minorex Limited in 1981 showed encouraging results within the central of three conductive zones delineated.

7.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

1. The eastern and western extensions of the east-west trending "porphyry" (central conductive zone) should be examined further by means of, at least, two additional diamond drill holes.
2. The northern VLF-EM conductor below the northern lake shown on the Minorex Limited drawing (April 1981) should be explored by, at least, two diamond drill holes drilled from the southern shore.
3. The 1.8 metre (6 foot) section from 68.9 to 70.7 metres (226 to 232 feet) in Trench 2 should be opened up for possible additional sampling.



TRENCH 1 : GOLD ASSAY



TRENCH 2 : GOLD ASSAY



TRENCH 2 : GOLD ASSAY





With regards to the Browning Lake claims (1202488 and 1202489), the only rock type seen was barren syenite with a quartz vein showing mineralization (pyrite and chalcopyrite) located at the site of the east trench. No visible mineralization was seen at the sites of the island trenches and the drawing is, therefore, simple. In the case of the Webb Lake claim (1202490), sulphide (largely pyrite) mineralization was common throughout but no economic values were seen in trenches during the 1996 field season.

The sample locations are shown at the bottoms of the drawings so that they can be easily read rather than clutter up the drawings. I hope this is acceptable.





