


<u>Type of equipment used:</u> Portable rock drill, front end loader, and dump truck.

### Summary of exploration work and development on claim:

Prospect was drilled and blasted for bulk sample collection. Approximately 900 tons of material were removed by truck and shipped by train car for testing. Material tested for uniformity of color and purity for decorative crushed aggregate use only.

- <u>Regional Geology:</u> The claim lies within a large body of massive pink granite, as observed during prospecting and shown on map listed as reference.
- <u>Site Geology:</u> Most of the claim, based on exposed rock, consists of massive pink granite. A variably thick quartz vein, dimensions approximately 7 m thick by 40 meters strike length, trending roughly 270 degrees, is exposed within the claim. This quartz vein had been stripped of overburden by prior claimholders. The granite is weakly sheared along the margins of the vein.

Rock type descriptions: Massive pink granite and white bull quartz (see above).

<u>Drill Holes:</u> No exploratory drilling was done as part of this study, and it is not known to the claimholder what types of rocks were intersected by the old drilling, although presumably this hole would have intersected only the pink granite and the quartz vein.

Assays: None

<u>Dimensions of deposit</u>: Quartz vein approximately 7m or less in width over 40 meter strike length. Estimated reserves of 2,100 tons.

Amount of material extracted: 900 tons.

Amount of material stockpiled: none

<u>Method of processing sample:</u> crushing <u>Proposed uses of sample:</u> decorative stone for exposed aggregate building facing material

Samples were not tested for strength or fracture density, only for final color and purity of crushed product. Testing was done by Kafka Granite Company from Stratford, Wisconsin, USA. The results of this testing showed that the sample is suitable for the above purpose, despite the small size of the deposit. The product will be most likely be mixed with crushed quartz from other locations, and hence has a limited market.

This material is suitable for the use described above because of its relative purity, i.e. it is very white in color and lack of fragments of country rock or other dark minerals.







The requested revisions for this submission, as outlined in the 45 Day Notification dated October 4, 1999, have not been received within the time period specified.

Accordingly, assessment work credit for this submission has been reduced to 50% of the amount eligible. We have allowed for the removal of 10 tonnes, as a bulk sample, which is the maximum amount of material allowed without obtaining a bulk sampling permit. The following costs have been allowed:

1 day of equipment, labour, materials = \$3,240 loading into rail cars = \$150 report = \$250

Total = \$3,640 x 50% (lacking a detailed map and results of testing) = \$1,820

The assessment credit is being reduced by \$10,227.00. The TOTAL VALUE of assessment credit that will be allowed, based on the information provided in this submission, is \$1,820.00.




