INTRODUCTION

The following report describes the results of a ground magnetometer survey for Cliff MacKenzie, 446 Poplar Avenue, Timmins, Ontario, Douglas Lalonde, 53 Way Avenue, Timmins, Ontario and Dennis LaForest, 730 McClinton Drive, Timmins, Ontario.

The field work was carried out under a OPAP Government Grant and was completed October 2, 1991 and the report was completed on October 3, 1991.

PROPERTY LOCATION AND ACCESS

The property is located in Whitesides and Massey Townships, Porcupine Mining Division, Ontario.

The property is accessible by four-wheel drive vehicles. The claim group can be reached by driving west along Highway 101 for a distance of 30 kilometres, then turning north along the Whitesides gravel road for a distance of 15 kilometres to the end of a bush road at a point 400 metres east of the Kamiskotia River and the west boundary of the present claim group. The baseline lies a short distance west of the river and a boat or canoe is necessary to cross the river at this location where a 400 metre trail has been cut west to the river.

PROPERTY DESCRIPTION

The property consists of 25 contiguous claims in the northeast corner of Whitesides Township extending north into Massey Townships. The claims are numbered as follows:

LINECUTTING

A north-south baseline starting on the Don Warren patented claims in Whitesides Township was continued to the north boundary of the claim group under discussion.

Lines were cut east-west from the baseline at 100 metre intervals and stations were established at 25 metre intervals. A total of 30.1 kilometres were cut over 23 claims by M.C. Explorations Ltd. of Timmins, Ontario. 21 claims were completely covered and 2 were partially covered by grid lines.

GROUND MAGNETOMETER SURVEY

The ground magnetometer survey was completed utilizing a proton magnetometer Geometrics Model G-816 capable of reading total field values to a accuracy of ± 1 gamma. Base stations were established at 100 metre intervals along the baseline. Diurnal variation was corrected by tieing into the base stations every 60 minutes.

A total of 1,274 readings were read. The operators were Glen Coyne, 527 Mountjoy South, Timmins, Ontario and Dennis LaForest, 730 McClinton Drive, Timmins, Ontario.

PROPERTY GEOLOGY

The property is underlain by Precambrian formations, the oldest being the sedimentary gneisses striking north-south throughout the claim group. These rocks are intruded by a complex gabbro intrusive ranging from white anorthosite to a pyroxenite gabbro.

This intrusive is cut by granite towards the western boundary of the property and the western side of the property is underlain mainly by red granite and paragneiss. For this reason lines were not cut over this portion of the claim group.

Representing the late Precambrian, north-south striking diabases intrude all of the formations including the granite.

Nickel, cobalt and copper mineralization are present south of the claim group and a trench near Line 10N at a point immediately west of the baseline shows nearly massive pyrrhotite over a 1 metre width in a black pyroxenite. Values in nickel-copper and cobalt were obtained from this trench with nickel assaying .7%.

Three airborne EM anomalies, circa 1988, are located on and near the township line at the south boundary of Massey Township.

The only record of drilling on the property was a short x-ray diamond drill hole by Inco in the vicinity of the Massey Township line, circa 1970. This hole intersected sulfides in a grey garnetiferous para-gneiss.

At present, a zone of nickeliferous pyrrhotite in gabbro and pyroxenite is being traced by magnetometer work from XL10N north to the vicinity of 3 airborne EM anomalies near the Massey Township line. The "showing" is located just west of the baseline on the Don Warren claims in Whitesides Township.

RESULTS OF THE MAGNETOMETER SURVEY

The results of the magnetometer survey are shown on a map located in the back pocket of this report on a scale of 1:2,500.

The magnetic anomalies are designated on the map by the letters A, A-1, B, C, D, E, F, G, H and I.

ANOMALY A appears to be a narrow north-south diabase striking north across the claim group. At XL27N it appears to cross a east-west feature designated as Anomaly A-1. Anomaly A-1 appears to be possibly a mineralized shear zone containing magnetic pyrrhotite.

ANOMALY B is approximately 500 metres in length striking north-south direction and may be due to a mineralized zone in gabbro.

ANOMALIES C and D have a total combined length of 1,000 metres striking northeasterly and are believed due to disseminated to massive pyrrhotite lenses in the gabbro and lie in the vicinity of 3 airborne conductors, circa 1988.

ANOMALIES E and F are believed to be caused by north-south striking diabase dykes.

ANOMALY G is a series of lenses of pyrrhotite in pyroxene gabbro.

ANOMALIES H and I appear to be north-south striking mineralized zones within the gabbro. Anomaly I lies east of a known nickeliferous zone lying in a shear striking 60° and dipping steeply south. However, Anomaly J continues north for at least 900 metres and is probably part of the G anomaly and since no magnetite was observed in the gabbro outcrops all magnetic highs in this area appear to be due to magnetic pyrrhotite mineralization.

RECOMMENDATIONS AND CONCLUSIONS

This magnetometer map should be redone by computer, color coded to separate the magnetic diabases and the mineralized zones.

Prospecting, mapping and sampling over the entire property should be completed.

A Max-Min survey should be carried out on all lines presently cut and additional north-south lines cut over Anomaly A-1 and read with a Max-Min unit.

Anomalies C and D which lie in the vicinity of the airborne EM anomalies obtained in 1988 should be drilled if the Max-Min shows strong anomalies beneath the overburden in this area. No outcrop has been found to date in the vicinity of the C and D anomalies.
