### Introduction

During the period of June 8 to June 16, 1989, stripping, trenching and sampling was carried out on a contract basis by All Terrain Track Sales & Service of Timmins on the Cripple Creek property in Denton Township. The operation was organized and supervised by the writer and the work was carried out by Andy Beaudry, Robin Beaudry and other staff of All Terrain.

#### Work Done

Stripping of outcrops over possibly mineralized zones was done in seven areas by backhoe, where the previous winter, the trees had been cleared by bulldozer (Fig. 1). Trenches were blasted into four of these areas (figures 2 to 5) and composite samples collected over 5 ft. intervals. As well, mixed composite samples were taken from areas 1, 2 and 5. The samples were sent to Bell White laboratories for gold analysis.

## Results

The gold values obtained are listed on the enclosed assay certificate as well as plotted in parts per million on the trench maps. All samples had disappointly low gold values, with the highest being in trench 4 where three samples were >100ppb, the highest being 606ppb.


# Conclusions

Trench area 4, which is the outcrop where Hollinger reported a grab sample assay of 0.14 oz/t in 1961 (Timmins Assessment Files), is the only one of the seven where anomalously high gold values were found of the five areas sampled. Further work should be directed towards the green carbonate/porphyry environment in that area.








Location Map







Location Map of Stripped and Trenched Outcrops Cripple Creek Property, Denton Township
