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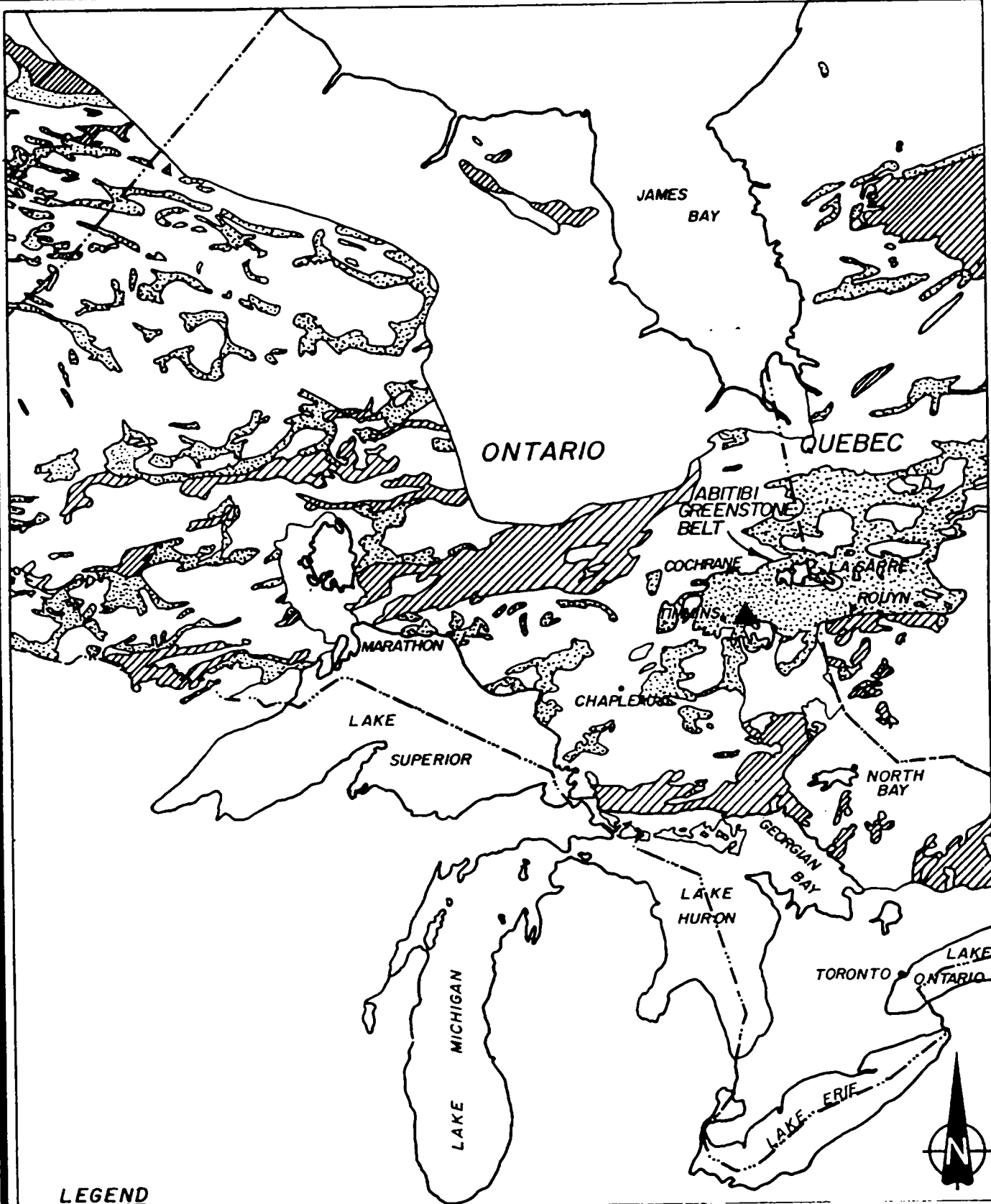

INTRODUCTION

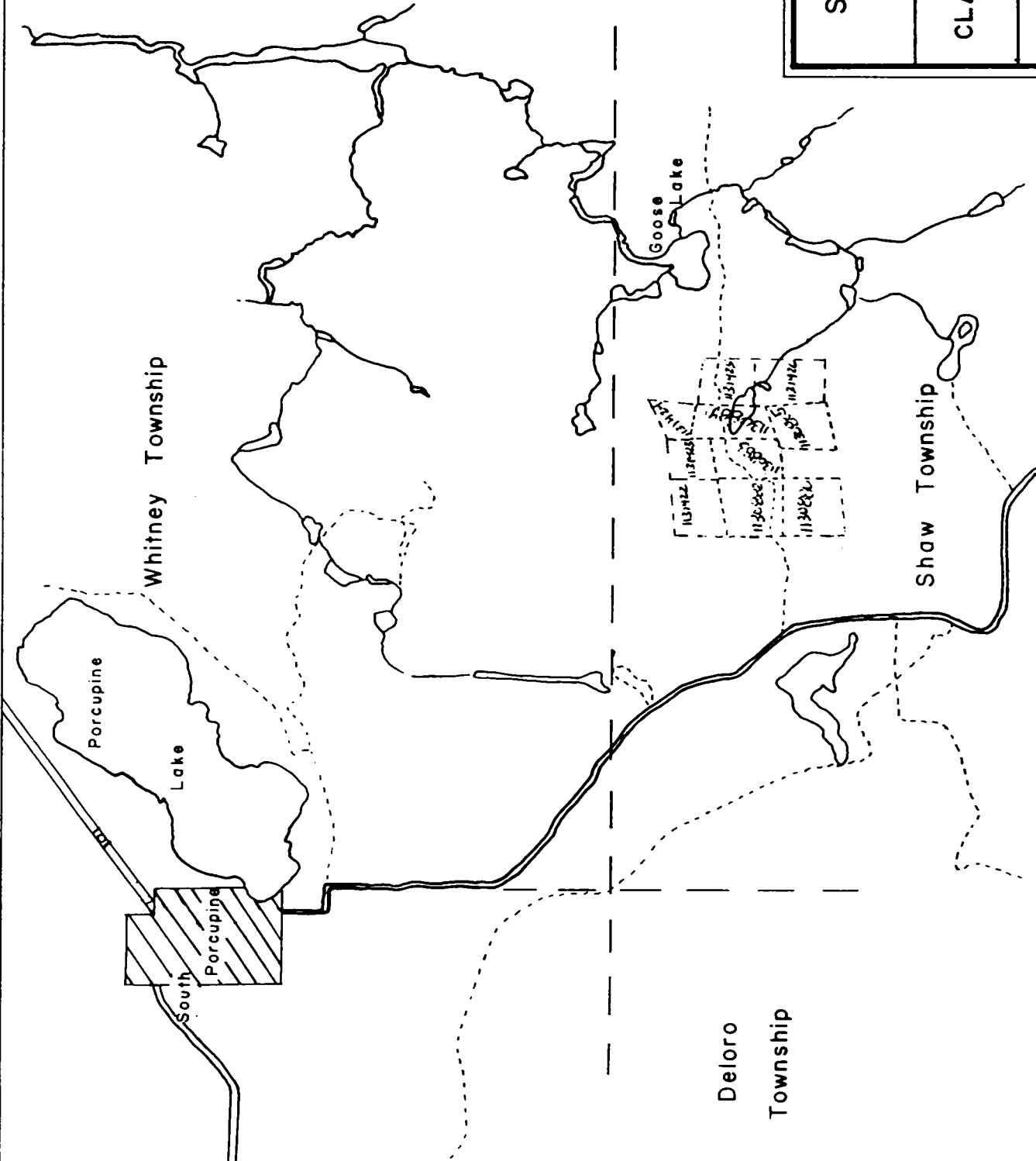

1880: Aerial photo interpretation of a portion of the district belonging to Flint Rock Mines Limited. A geologic survey was completed on the district and a total of 21 diamond drill holes were sunk.
