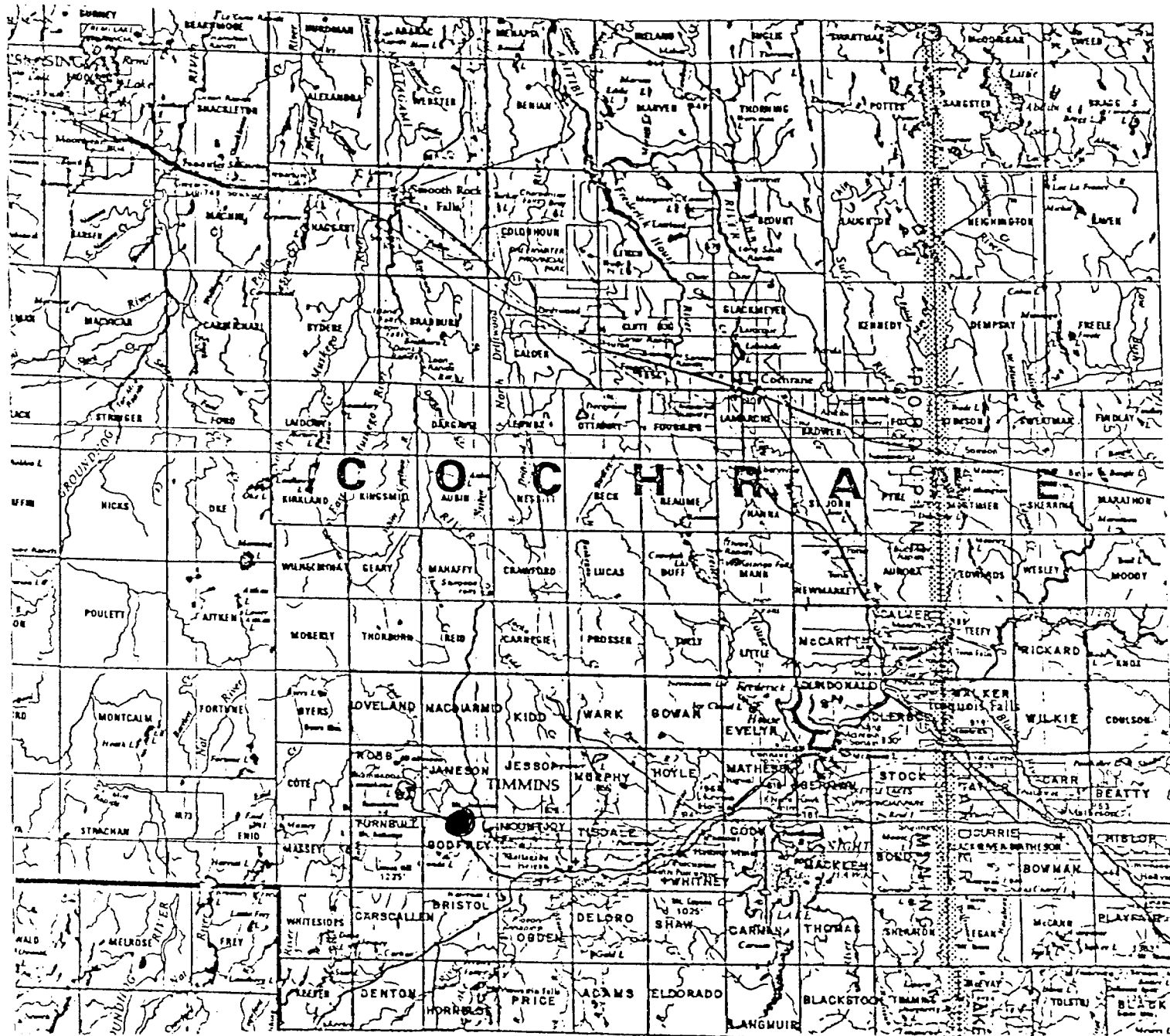


FIG 1: GENERAL LOCATION MAP

INTRODUCTION

During the summer of 1991 Mr. C. Harrington attempted to drill a short pack sack drill hole through a quartz vein recently discovered by C. Harrington. (See File Report MAR 92). Unfortunately, a number of slips were encountered along with blocky ground and the bit and rods seized in the hole, thus the hole could not be completed & the hole did not come close to the target zone.

This report will document the work carried out to date on this area with respect to drilling for assessment purposes.

PROPERTY LOCATION & ACCESS

The property presently consists of three contiguous claims numbered 1155087, 1132988 and 1132989 located in the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of 6078, con VI Godfrey Twp. (See Fig 142)

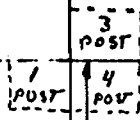

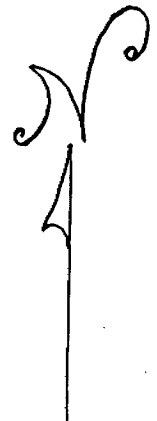

 COLLAR LOCATION

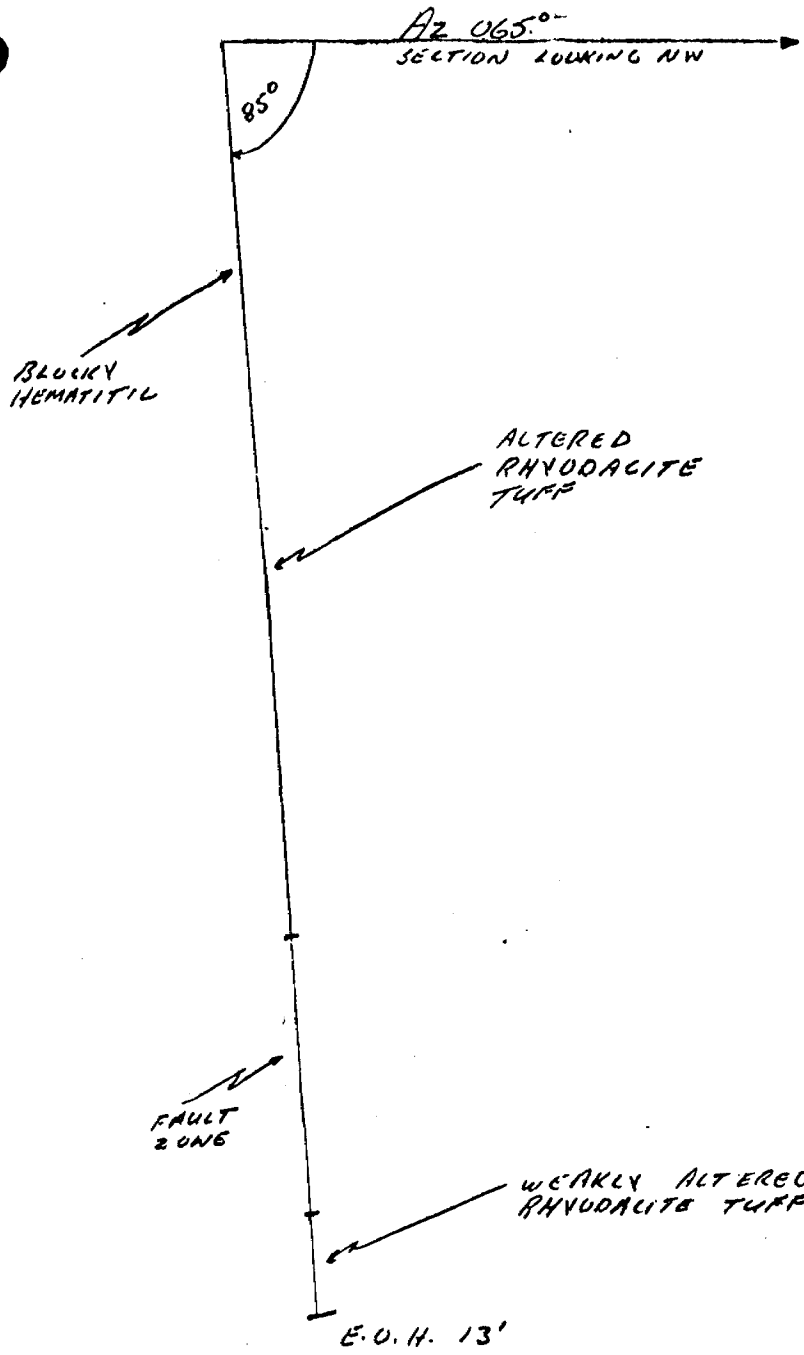

DRILLING RESULTS

The drilling carried out intersected badly fractured and brecciated chydacite tuff on the hanging wall side of the vein. The initial 9 ft. of this hole was altered (hematite) extensively but no mineralization was noted. Alteration & fracturing & brecciation may be related to faults and slips noted within this hole.

A more detailed account of what was intersected is presented in the accompanying log.

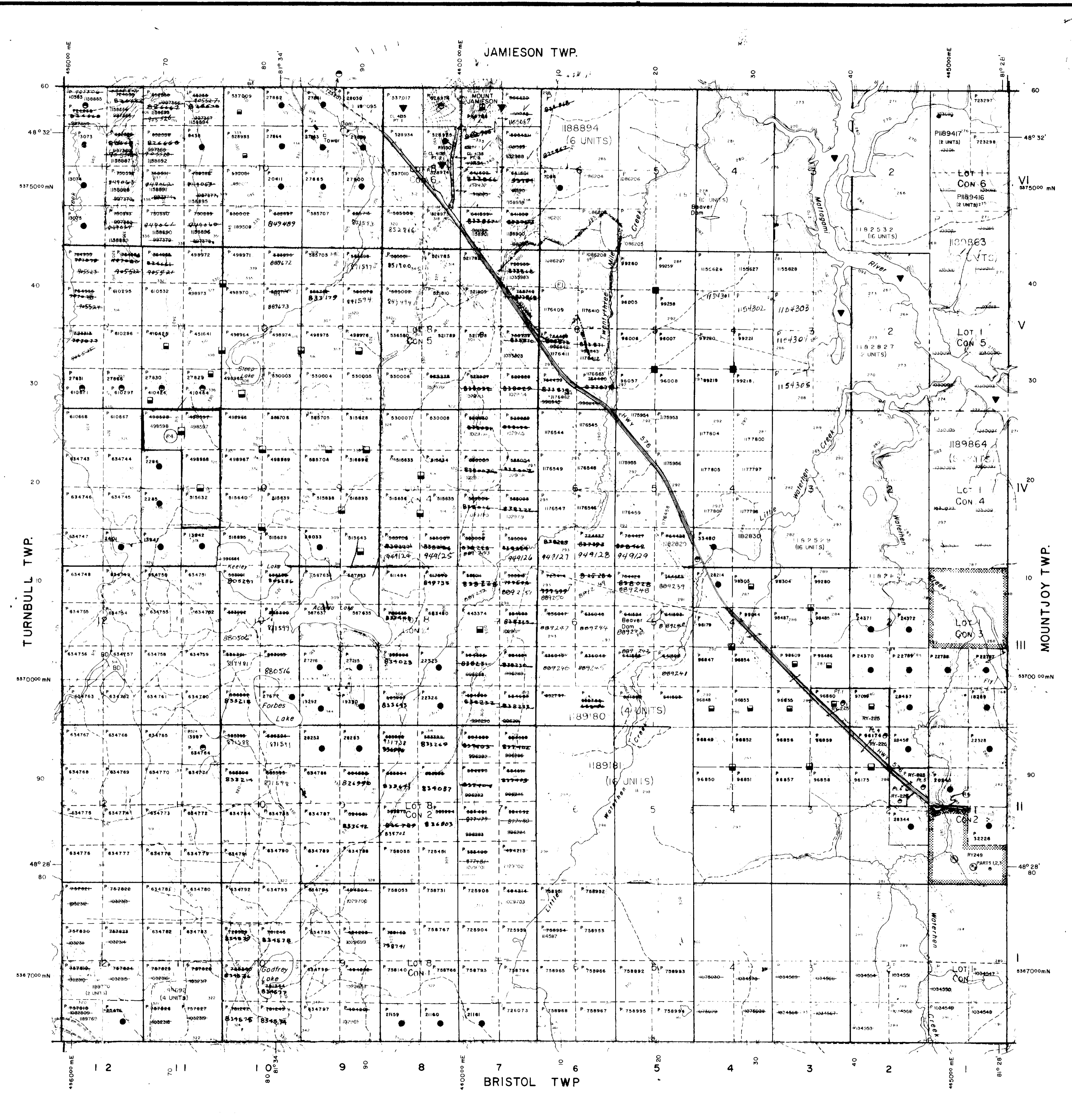

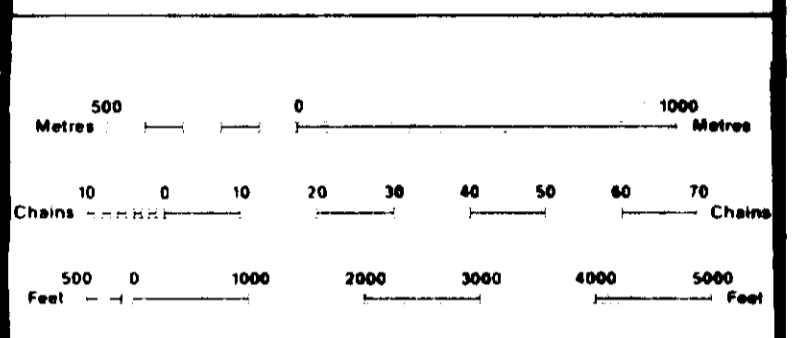
