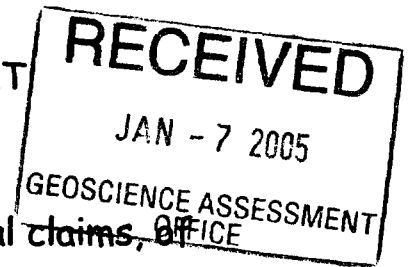


YEAR 2004 ASSESSMENT WORK REPORT  
ON THE MAKI CLAIM GROUP



Our claim group consists of twenty-three (23) mineral claims, of which five (5) are leased, all in good standing and situated in Vincent Township (map G163) Thunder Bay Mining Division.

A portion of our work was repetition of clearing debris and blow downs from severe wind storm earlier in the year. Some of the showings were obstructed by high swamp water and beaver dams. We were hopeful to get a back-hoe to clean up these areas but that did not materialize. However, we did manage to cover most of the claims. We did additional trenching on the east end of Rachels Showing which showed good gold values previously. The same work was done on the NRM Showing which showed high gold values previously although no visible gold was noted. Samples were sent out for assaying and the results are on the assay sheet.

We took samples from the north end of Byrons Vein which we trenched and grubbed to bedrock. These assay result are on the assay sheet. The C1 Eagle showing is a new area of interest on which we did considerable work to locate. It is explained on the C1 Eagle report and the assay results are on the assay sheet.

Roxmark Mines has a gold producing custom mill situated about 10 miles west of our property in the town of Beardmore, Ontario which could be a benefit to us.

All in all, previous work and this summers work could prove to be well justified and hopefully a positive reaction from some mining companies, especially with a gold mill now in the area.



**C1 EAGLE VEIN**  
**Assessment Work 2004**

We prospected along creek bed as shown and finally located a mineralized zone in shallow water in creek. We broke off rock for crushing, panning and assaying. We then prospected and cut a picket line west of creek and located the same mineralized zone which we trenched and grubbed to bedrock exposing a zone of quartz veining in chlorite schist in iron formation with 5% pyrrhotite and pyrite . We broke off rock from the 10' exposure and took chip and grab samples from north portion and south portion for crushing, panning and assaying.

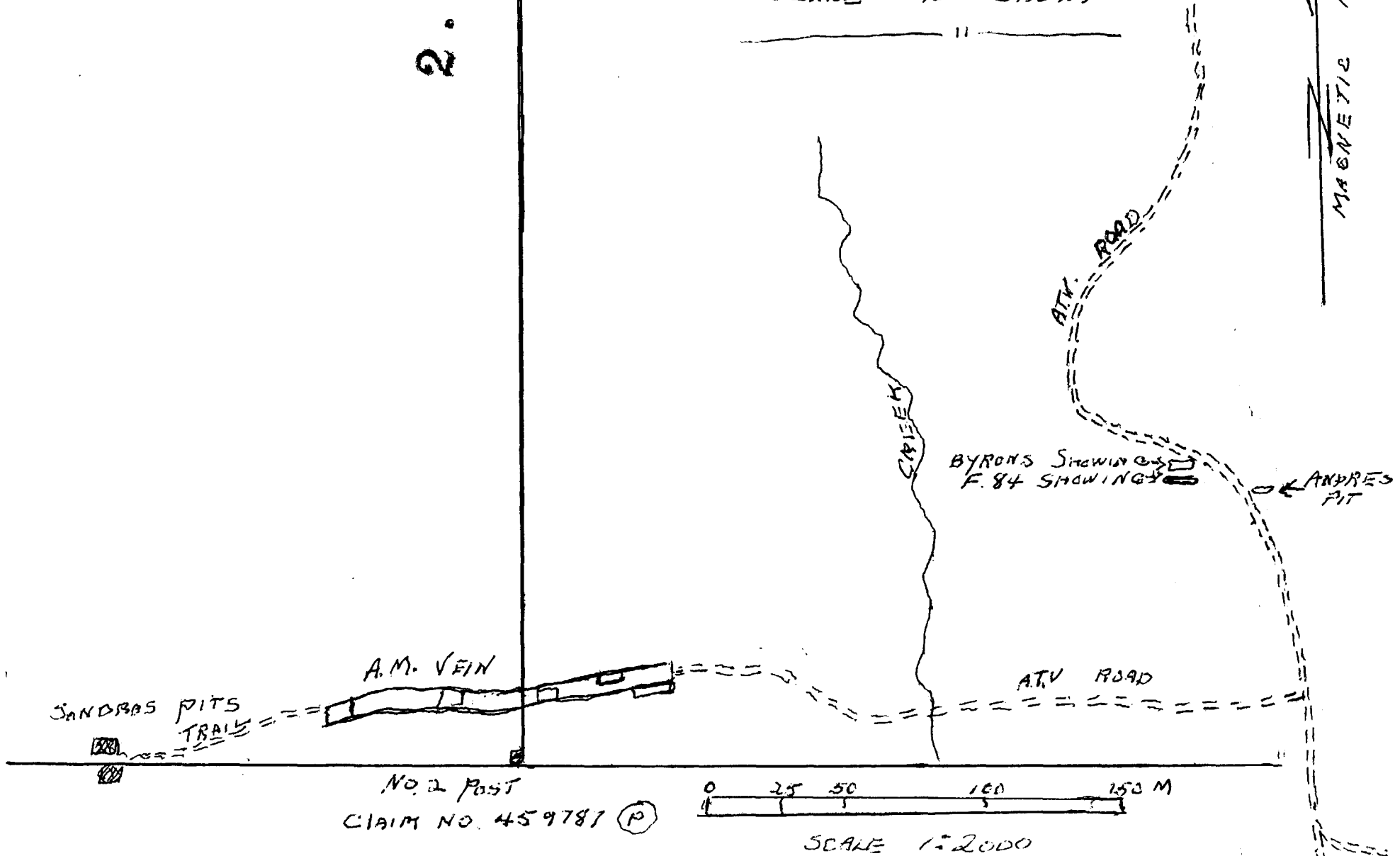
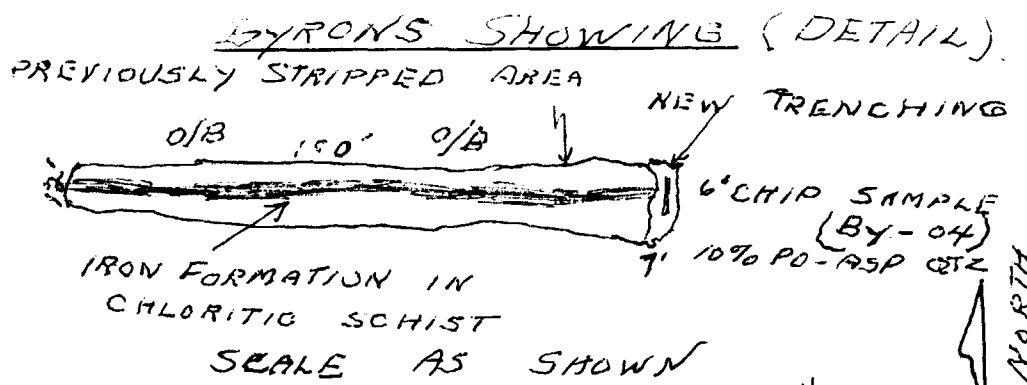
BYRONS MAIN SHOWING, F84 SHOWING, ANDRES PIT, A.M.

We cleaned up all showings above of winters debris. We trenched and mucked out overburden from Byron's north end of showing previously under water. We broke off rock for sampling (grab) showing arsenopyrite in quartz veining in andesite. The F84 showing just south of Byrons Vein is 4m wide with quartz veining in greenstone. We took samples for panning which showed a fair to good amount of gold. Andres pit is a 1.5m wide quartz vein with minor galena and gold in panning. More work needed.
