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Location & Access

The property is located approximately 6 miles east of Mine Centre, .75 miles north of Highway No. 11. From Highway No. 11 an all weather road passes through the claims and ends at the C.N.R. previously known as Turtle Tank, approximately .5 miles north of the claims.

Line Cutting


A base line was cut at N 25 degrees east through claim for 1750 feeth with picket lines at 100 foot intervals 400 ft on each side of base line.

Geology

The claim is located in a felsic volcanic band. the felsic volcanics are interbedded with intermediate volcanics and some local basic volcanics and some minor bands of intermediate tuffs. The general strike is NE - SW with almost vertical dip. Numerous quartz veins 1 inch to 3 ft. run through the stripped areas along strike with some pyrite and chalcopyrite visible. Stringers of chalcopyrite up to ½ inch wide were noted in the trenches.
