

Prospecting Report on Bennett Lake Claims



Trip to Bennett on Oct. 26/03

Kim Davis and myself made a one day trip to the Red Cedar area on Oct. 26/03. The primary purpose of the trip was recutting of a line established by Minescape in 1997. This line runs parallel to the original baseline and 200 metres south of it. The line was recut from L 9+00 E to L 17+00 E. Chaining of the line will be completed on a future trip. This line was used as a control line for prospecting to be carried out on later trips. Some short traverses were taken north and south of the line later in the day.

One sample from a trench at GPS location 553253E, 5403402N was taken. Fine disseminated sulphide was evident as well as some stringers of sulphide mineralization. The host rock is a mafic volcanic with some silicification. An additional sample from an outcrop at 552950E, 5403389N was also taken. It is mainly quartz with some feldspar. Very little sulphide is present. Only the first sample will likely be sent for assay.

The other target that I had intended to prospect was a gold occurrence found by Royal Crest at L9+00 E, 1+25 S. Time did not allow us to locate this occurrence.

Trip of November 02/2003

Kim Davis and myself made a one day trip to the Red Cedar property on Nov. 2/2003. The primary purpose of the trip was continuing to reestablish the grid between L9+00 E to L16+00E and from 2+00 S to 4+50N. Work was completed on L13 E from 2+00S to 4+50N, L12 E from 2+00S to 2+00N and L11 from 2+75S to 1+50N. No time was spent as yet cutting pickets because we wanted to spend some time prospecting. Chaining and pickets will be completed in the winter.

An area between L12 and L14 and roughly 3+00N to 4+00N was prospected. Two items of some significance were found and will be sent for assay. A narrow rusty quartz vein was discovered at GPS location 553136E, 5403843N. The vein is mineralized with some sulphides, pyrite and chalcopyrite. This would be about 200 metres north of the Red Cedar trenches. Some very rusty soil was located at GPS location 553296E, 5403925N. In 1984 a new gold occurrence was discovered by Lynx Canada through a soil sample. Heavily rusted soil contained .04 Oz/ton gold.



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This is on strike and about 800 metres east of my sample location. Rock in the area contained 2 to 3 percent sulphides, mainly pyrite. Two samples of the rock from the area were taken for possible assay. The rock is probably a well silicified felsic to intermediate volcanic. Similar rock exists about 650 metres away, west of the Lynx trench and was found to contain up to 15 Oz/ton gold (Royal Crest, 1988). Two additional samples were picked up from the Red Cedar trench. Trip to Bennett Nov.16/03


The purpose of the trip was to complete a trail that would be used next year to bring equipment in for stripping. The trail crosses the south portion of K989656 and follows L11 north to L2 south. Roughly following L2 south it ends at L12. It will be completed to the Red Cedar prospect, which lies about 125 metres north, on our next trip. No prospecting was done and no samples taken.




