57.2 - 78.0	Dark, fine grained graphitic slate ? Poorly banded with minor light coloured bands. Appears to be flows with amygdules of pyrite.

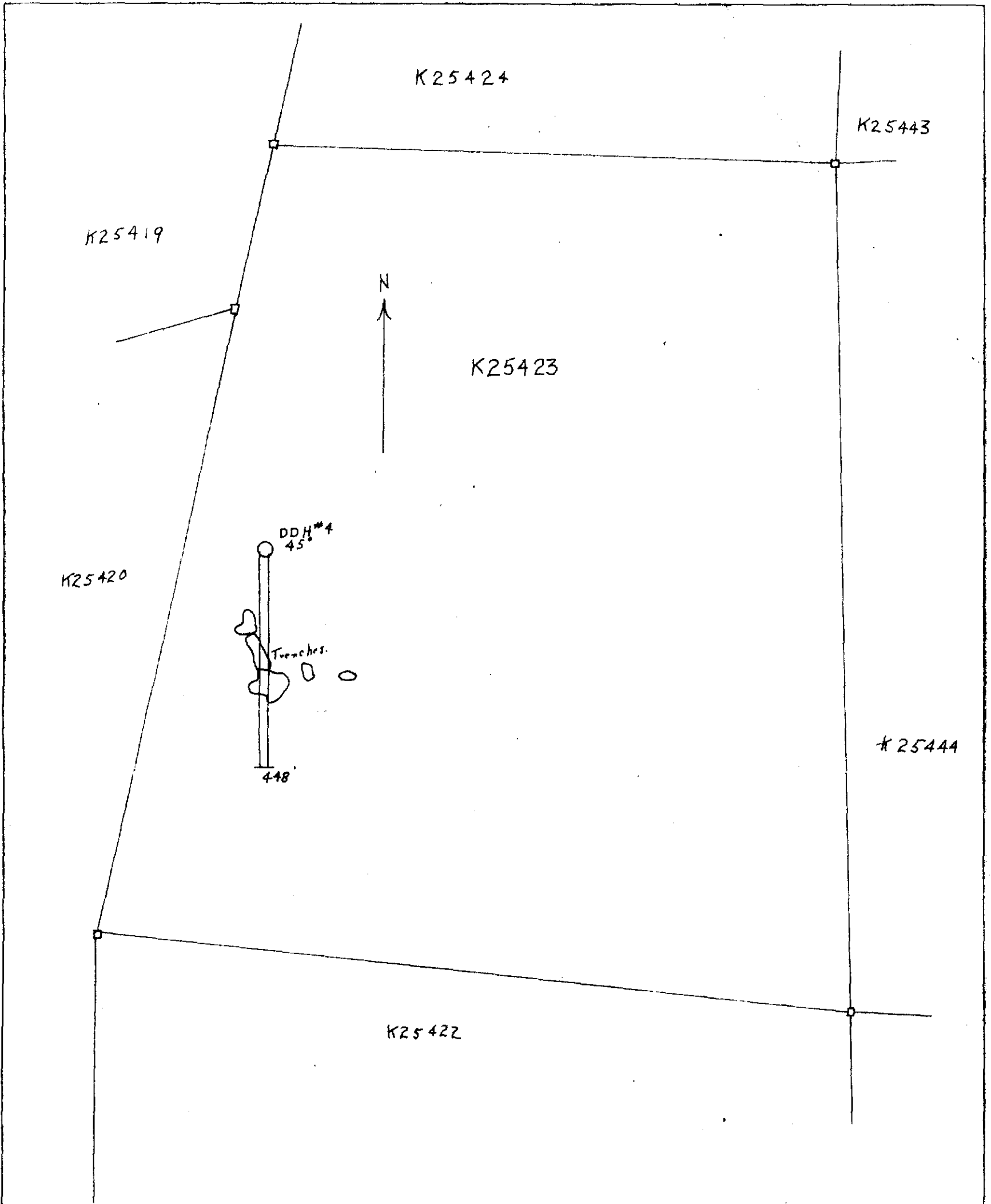
