_LOCATION

The property is located approximately 0.6 miles east north east of Highway 502 about 35 miles from Dryden. Peak Lake is about 1/8 mile east of the main showing.

Access is achieved by walking from the highway along claim lines directly behind E. Starr's showing on the highway. Another access route is by cance along Peak Lake which can be reached by a short portage from the highway.

The occurrence is located on claim map M 2663 in the District of Kenora. The claim (589502) is owned by Wm. J. Sovereign.

HISTORY

wm. J. Sovereign staked this claim January 11, 1981, covering to a large degree formerly patented claim K.624. No records of past work apparently exist due to the fact work was done back in 1914 to 1917. An overgrown trench and pits were discovered on the property.

_GEOLOGY

The following is close to a facsimile of a section from the report "Peak Lake Property Preliminary Geological Report" by Peter Hannigan, a geologist who examined the showing.

The claim is underlain by mafic tuffs with felsite porphyr dikes scattered randomly. The property is located on the northwest flank of an anticline known generally as the Manitou Anticline.


The showing is on a cliff face about 300 feet east of a small lake directly west of Peak Lake. It consists of a north-south general trending quartz vein that pinches and swells. The vein occurs within a well-foliated greenstone that is altered in parts. A porphyr dike is associated with the showing. Chalcopyrite is present in trace amounts, principally in the quartz.

PRESENT WORK

Wm. J. Sovereign did some stripping and cleaning of the overgrown trench and pits this summer. Numerous grap and chip samples were taken. Some assays were quite empressive: 4.85, 3.28, 3.42, 6.8, 2.3, .55, .37, and .17 oz./ton gold. Two samples were also submitted for spectographic analysis for 30 elements; no significant values were reported.

On October 27, 1981, a geologist, Peter Hannigan, working out of the Dryden Office of Sherritt Gordon Mines Limited, visited the claim. Two chip samples were taken which gave low values. However, three of four grap samples gave more promising values: .556, .07, and .11 oz./ton gold. These samples contained low silver values: respectively .07, .03, .08 oz./ton.

Mr. Hannigan recommended that further chip sampling should be performed and that substantial stripping should be attempted to the south.



BRUSHED TRAIL:



AERIAL SKETCH OF MAIN SHOWING






FIGURE 1:

An examination of your survey report indicates that the requirements of The Ontario Mining Act have not been fully met to warrant maximum assessment work credits. This notice is merely a warning that you will not be allowed the number of assessment work days credits that you expected and also that in approximately 15 days from the above date, the mining recorder will be authorized to change the entries on his record sheets to agree with the enclosed statement. Please note that until such time as the recorder actually changes the entry on the record sheet, the status of the claim remains unchanged.

If you are of the opinion that these changes by the mining recorder will jeopardize your claims, you may during the next fifteen days apply to the Mining and Lands Commissioner for an extension of time. Abstracts should be sent with your application.

If the reduced rate of credits does not jeopardize the status of the claims then you need not seek relief from the Mining and Lands Commissioner and this Notice of Intent may be disregarded.


