Previous Work

Rock has been quarried from this deposit since 1948 by various companies. Today Nelson Granite is the sole owner and quarry operator. Previous work carried out by Nelson Granite consisted of power stripping over numerous locations on this group of claims since 1983. Channeling and other preparatory work to quarrying was also carried out at some locations.

Purpose of this program

The purpose of this stripping project was to determine the quality of the granite over two new areas.

Area 1 west of Aaron Lake straddles two leased claims numbered 851455 and 882483 and covers an area of 2.68 hectares as per attached map Fig. 1.

Area 2 is situated on leased claim 594148 in the southwest corner of Aaron Lake and abuts the workings of the old GQI quarry. The excavated area is .16 hectares in size as per attached map Fig. 2.

The equipment used consisted of a Cat 215 Backhoe owned by Nelson Granite and a rented gravel truck.

Results

The granite at Area 1 has proven to be high quality material and is the site of current quarry production.

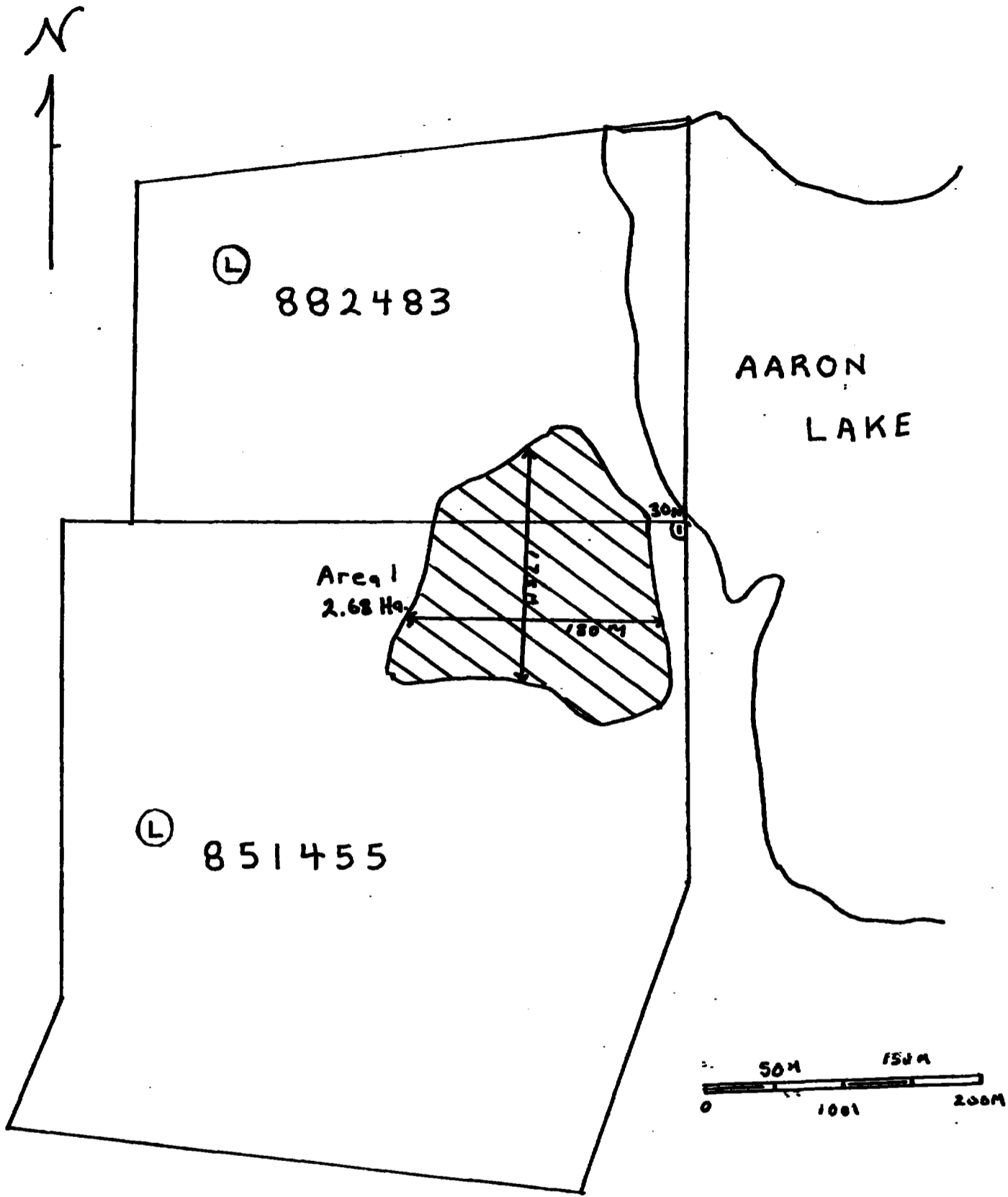
The granite at Area 2 is streaked and of lower quality. At present there is no production planned at this site.

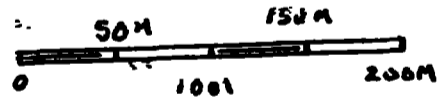

LAKE

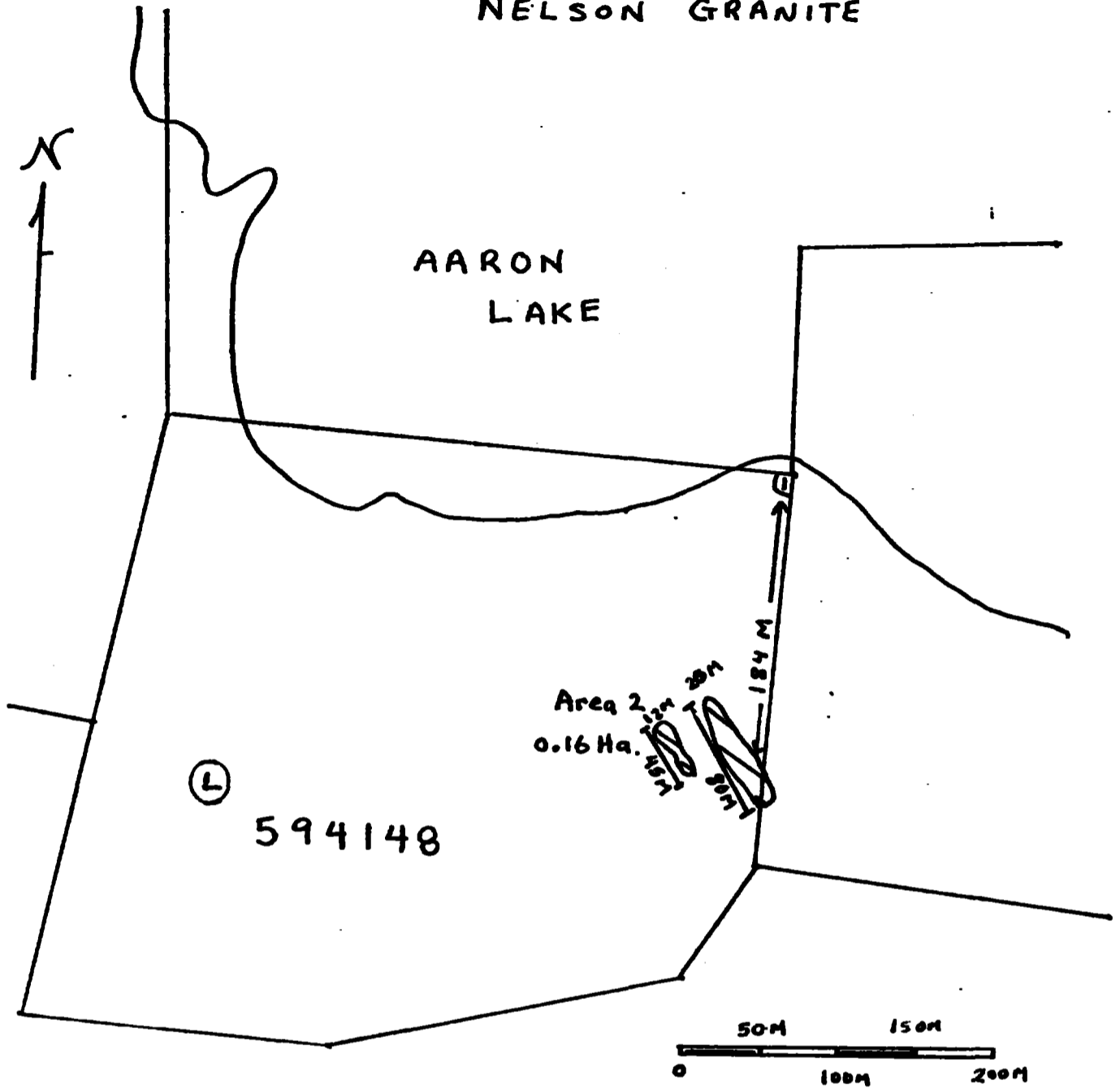

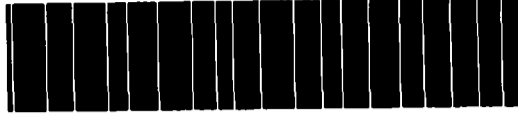

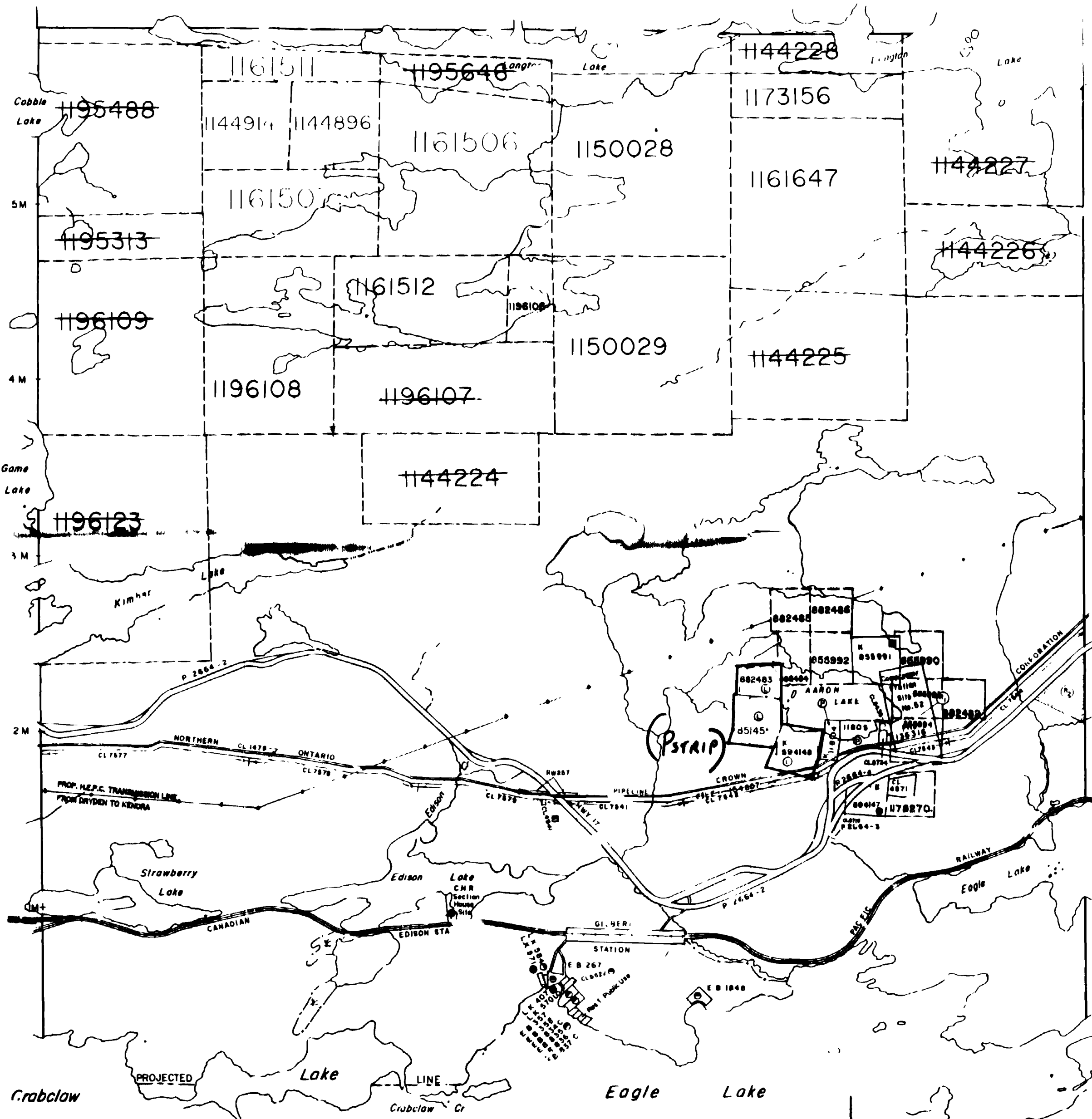
