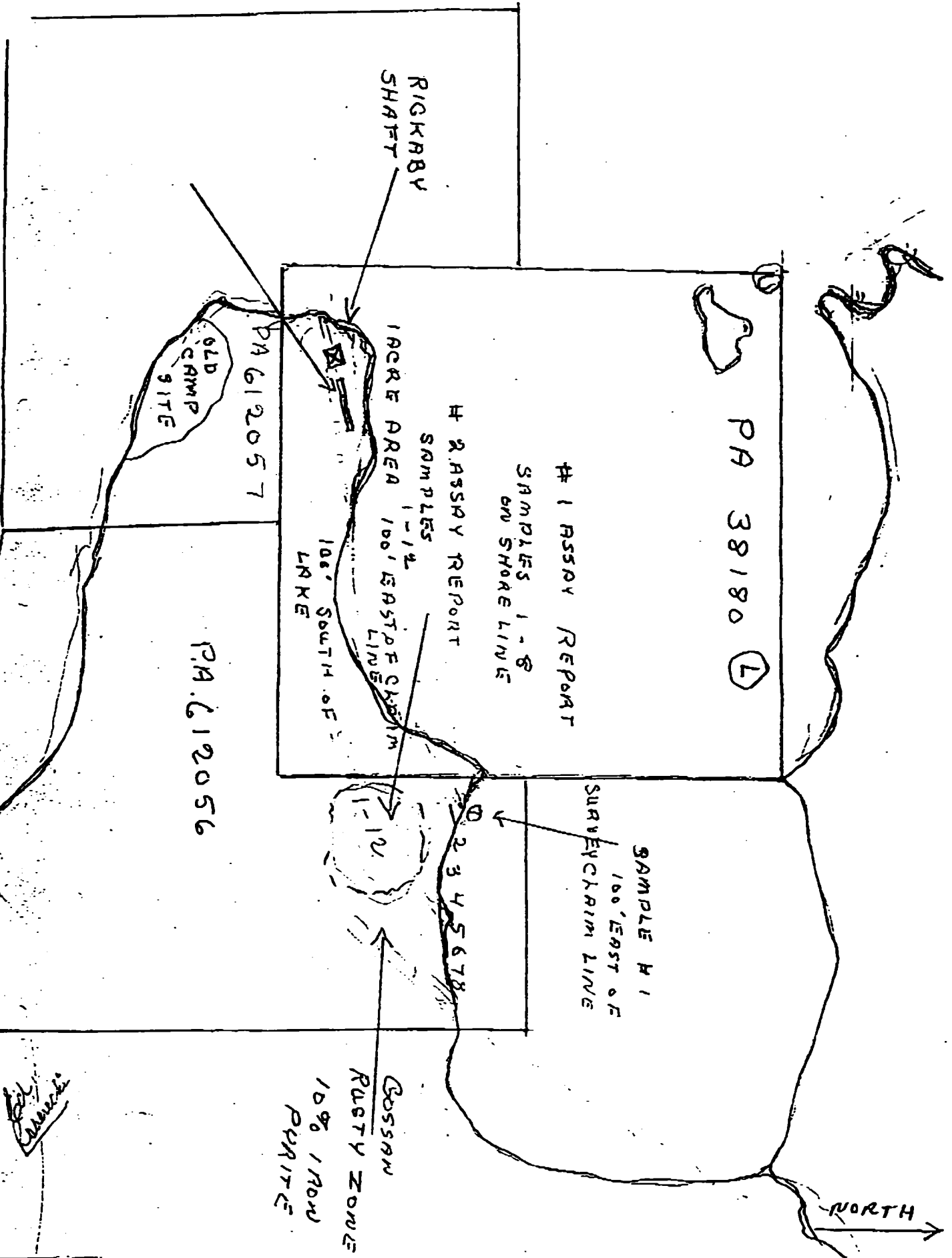

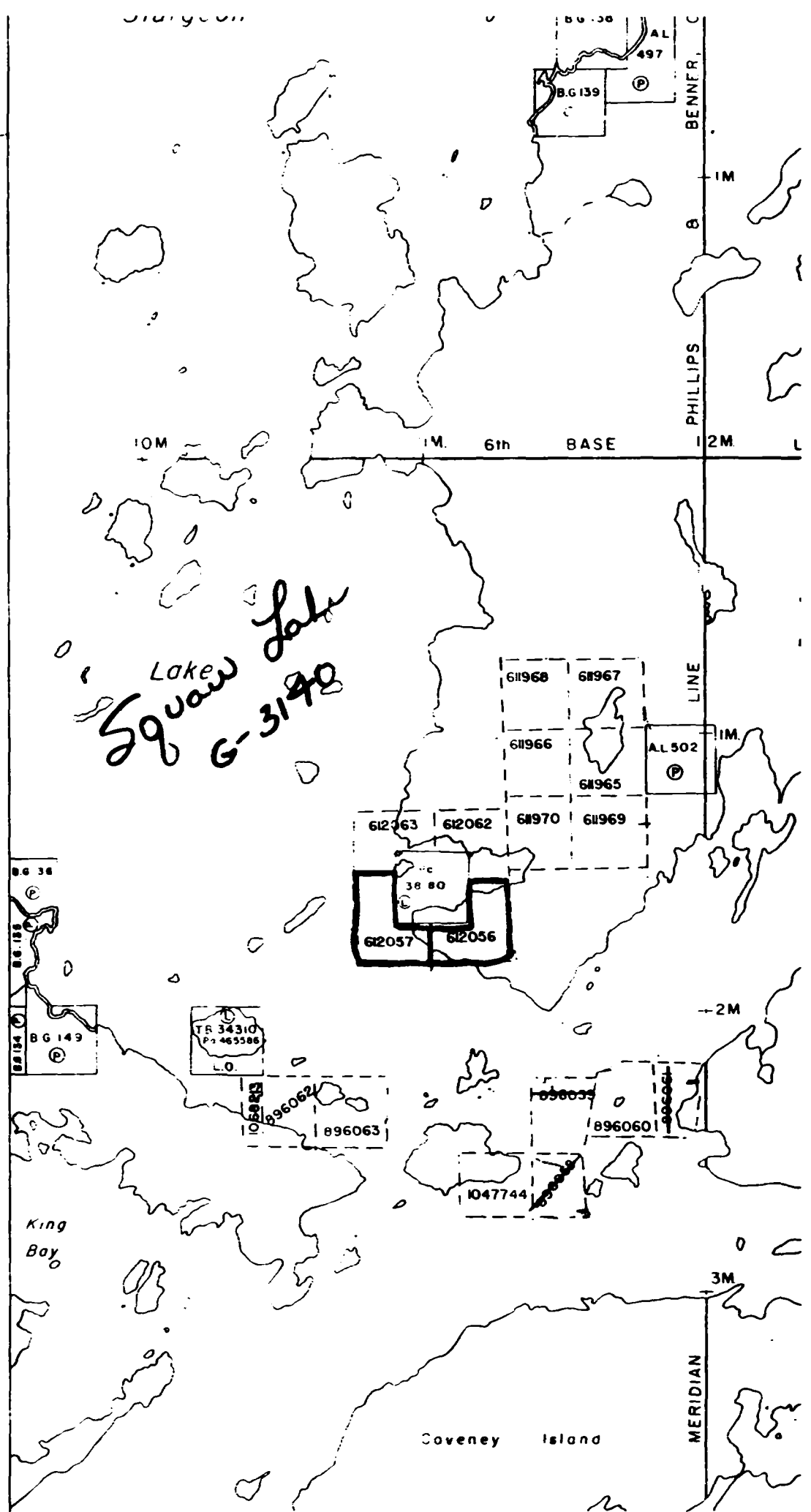

Conclusions

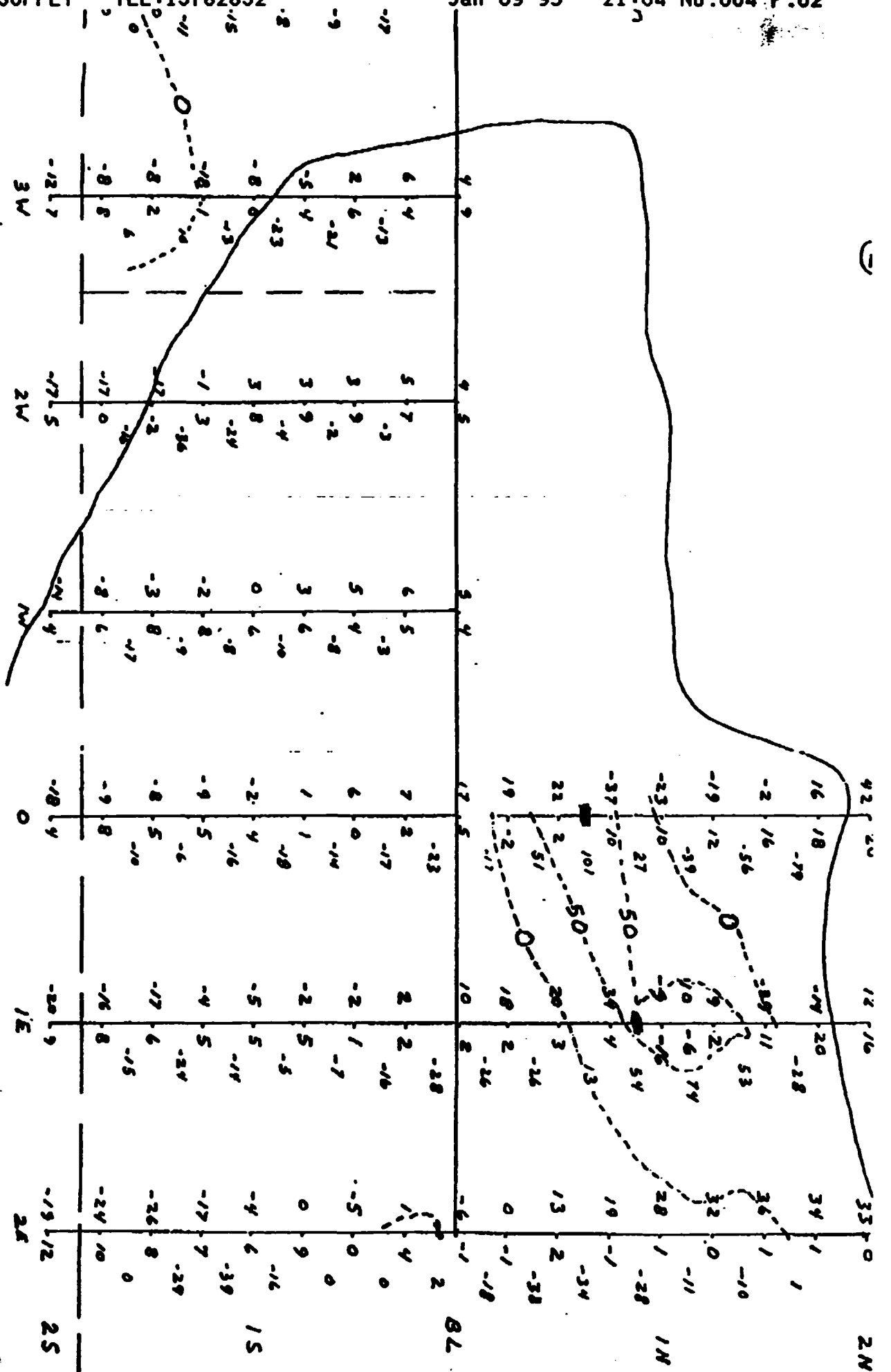
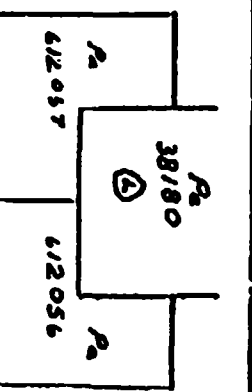
1. The geophysics located a major anomaly in the northeast part of the property. This appears to represent the continuation of the mineralized zone on Pt. 38130.
2. The magnetics indicate the portion of the property covered by water is underlain by granite.
3. The geophysics did not pick up the zone in the centre of the claims.

Recommendations

1. Detailed prospecting and geological mapping are warranted both to better define the source of the northeast anomaly and to discover other mineralization which does not respond to geophysics.
2. Several VLF lines are warranted to clarify the location and character of the assumed conductor adjacent to the south boundary.
3. Stripping of the northeast anomaly should be done, followed by sampling and assaying. A trench on 1F from 1+75 to 1+50M will expose the entire width of the anomalous zone.

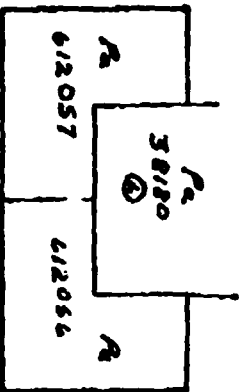

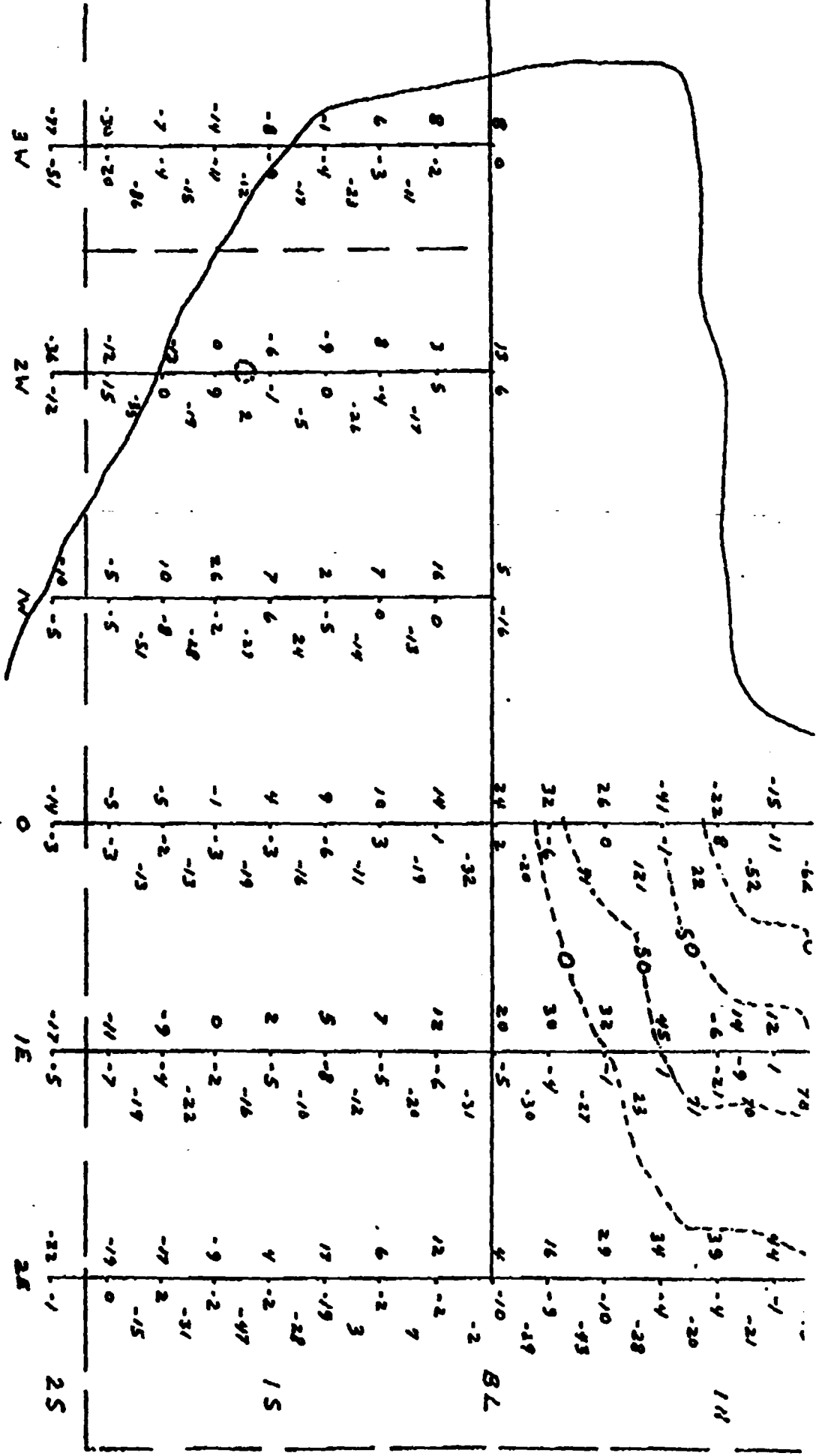

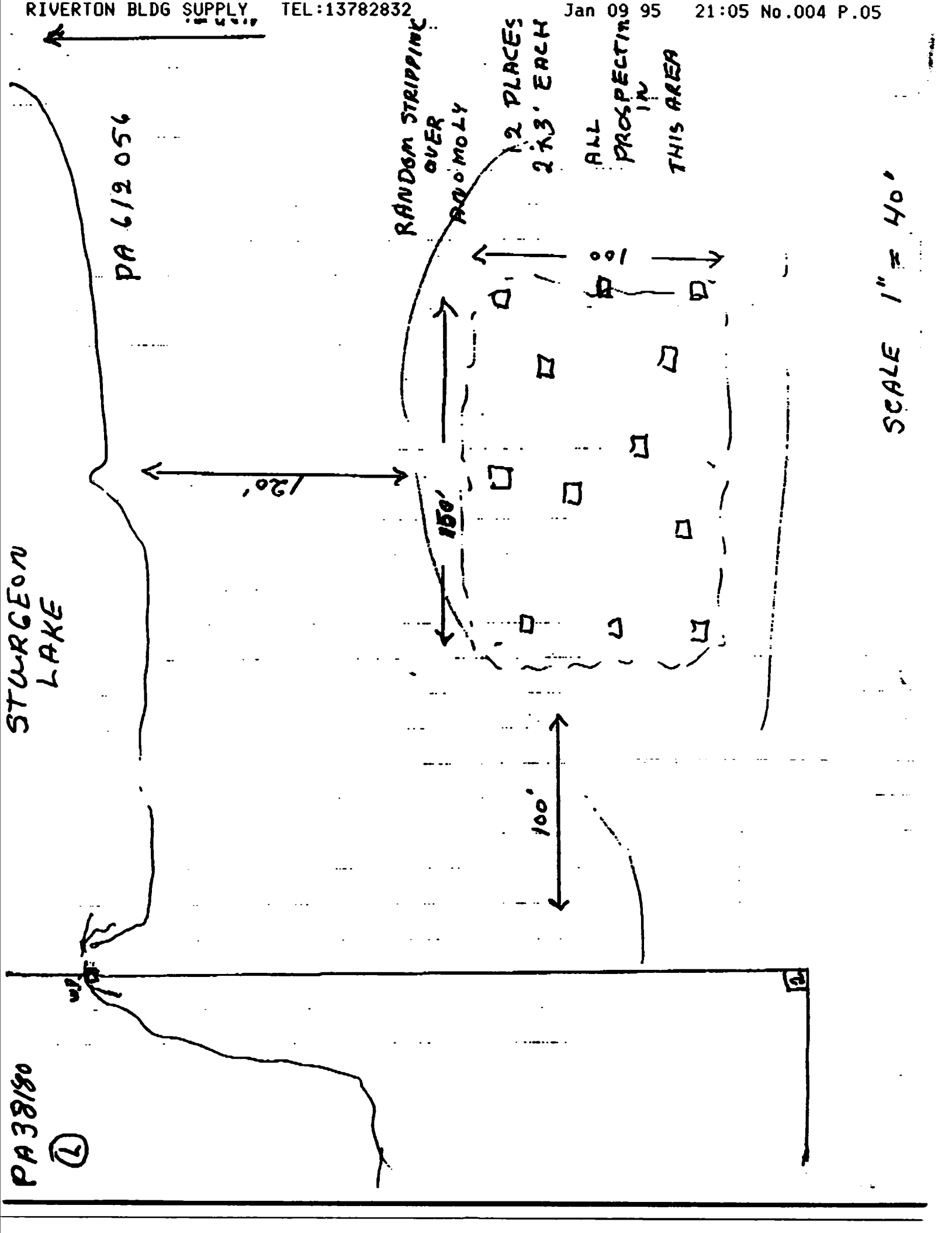
