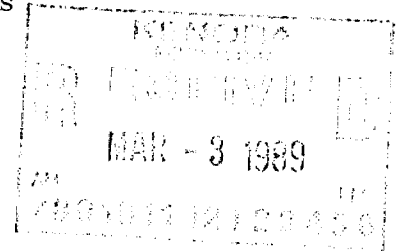

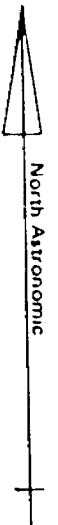
Please find enclosed assessment work on claim numbers 1017865,1017866,1017867, and 1017868.

We had two chunks of this granite that we decided to saw into samples. I do not like to do samples this way as it is very time consuming and expensive,plus ties up a man to long.

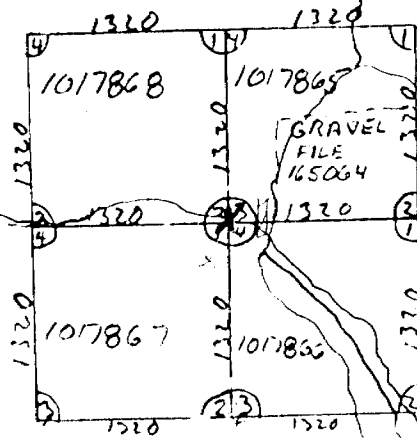
The sawing was done on the wire saw at the same time as we were sawing a large block of pink. It takes longer to set a small piece of granite at each end of block so our set up time was long and had to reset after each cut. The pieces were about 10" x 10" x 10", there were two of these so I got got about 5 sample per piece, 10 samples each.

We did the polishing with a small air hand held polisher using the same type of supplies normally used to polish. The polish was good doing it this way, granite closed good.

To cut these pieces, we used a skill saw with a dry diamond blade, caused the granite to break where it was cracked, time consuming as skill saw would over heat. I got about 5 usable samples which I send two to Sussex,NB and two to Kitchener ON to view. Other pieces are here and will enclose a small piece for you. Most people thought it looked likes one of the granites south of us. This would help us in the US market if we get to develop: this formation.

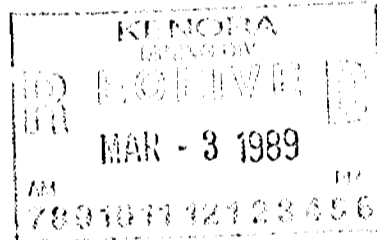

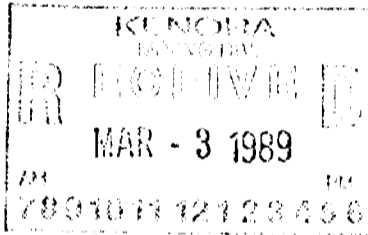

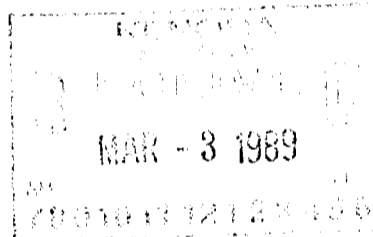
