Recutting of Claim Lines for Claim KRL1143080-Red Lake Mining Division.

Access and Location

The above-mentioned claim is located in the northeast corner of Baird Township, in the St. Paul Bay area. Access to the area was achieved by using an A.T.V. and travelling west from the town of Red Lake to the Buffalo gold property and beyond to the St. Paul Bay crossing.

The last part of the journey involved following an old power line west for approximately one mile.

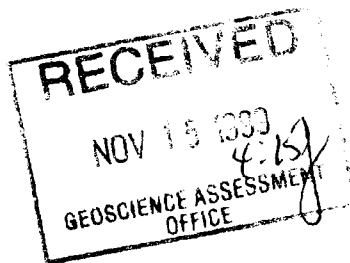
Work Performed

The south and parts of the east and west claim boundaries of Claim KRL1143080 were cut by Mr. Tony Maciejewski. All claim posts were located. The north boundary and parts of the east and west boundaries of this particular claim are occupied by the waters of St. Paul Bay.

From a geological standpoint, a small outcrop of acid to intermediate volcanics measuring 15 metres by 8 metres outcrops in the vicinity of the No. 3 post. Other outcrops contained within the property boundaries but not falling immediately on claim lines were an acid to intermediate porphyritic quartz latite and a serpentinized tremolite-talc schist occupying the central part of the claim.
