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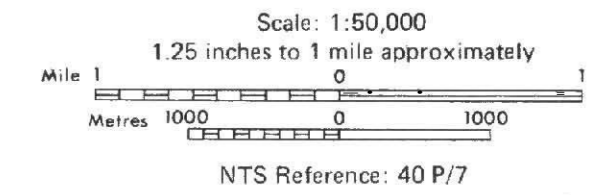
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PRELIMINARY MAP P.168 (Revised)

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**SYMBOLS**

- Well which penetrates bedrock, with elevation of bedrock surface in feet.
  - Well which does not penetrate bedrock, with elevation of base of well in feet.
  - Bedrock outcrop with elevation in feet.
  - Contours on bedrock surface (25-foot contour interval).
- Conversion Factor - 1 ft. = 0.3048 m

**EXPLANATION**

This map is based mainly on data in the files of the Hydrologic Data Branch, Ontario Ministry of the Environment, and the Ontario Division of Mines. Pre-1967 data incorporated in the map were field checked, but more recent data were not, so some possible errors in the records have not been corrected. Bedrock surface contours are approximate and interpretive. This is a revision of a previous Preliminary map by L.L. Davies and W.R. McClymont under the supervision of P.F. Karrow, 1962. Data compiled as of July 1975 by P.F. Karrow and D.J. Sprague.
